Notes: This season ended with the match between Argonne and Western Electric last Friday night, June 16th. Going into the match either team could have ended the evening by becoming the 1960-61 season champs. The score stood as follows prior to the match;

Argonne 9 wins 1 loss 1 draw 68 game points  
 West. Elec. 10 wins no losses 1 draw 72 game points

If Argonne could win the match and get six points they would be even with West. Elec. in games and game points but since Argonne would have won the match they would have won for the season. (The previous set-to between the two teams was a 4-4 draw.) Therefore Western Electric had to get at least  $2\frac{1}{2}$  points out of the eight possible to remain top team in the league. The final results for the evening were a win for Western Electric by  $4\frac{1}{2}$  to  $3\frac{1}{2}$ . They went and done it agin'. Three times and they have retired the "travelling" trophy into their new trophy cabinet. ( Its shelves must be made of two by sixes to stand the weight.)
