

MEISSNER ENGINEERS TEAM WITHDRAWS

It is with regret that announcement is made of the withdrawal of the Meissner Engineers team from the Chicago Industrial Chess League. Company difficulties have made it impossible to continue. The four matches played by Meissner will not be counted. Stewart-Werner relinquishes a well deserved win over the strong Meissner team but Motorola, R.R. Donnelley and Sunbeam each have a lost match that is "washed out". The remaining scheduled match dates with Meissner will become open dates.

LEAGUE BUSINESS MEETING

A League business meeting was held on November 9, 1962 with seven clubs represented. The following action was taken:

1. It was decided that a player is eligible for team play if he is on the payroll of the member company even if the amount of pay is zero. Argonne National Laboratory reports such a condition exists there.

2. The policy covering "Starting Time" was amended to read as follows: "However, if the game of the missing player is to be time-controlled, the game may be started and the missing player's clock started. If such a player then fails to arrive and make a move within the first hour on his clock, his game is forfeited. The captain of the missing player must provide clock unless opposing captain furnishes clock". Formerly both captains had to agree to this action. Now it may be taken if the captain of the missing player chooses to do so.

3. It was voted to contribute \$50 out of League funds to the U.S. Open Chess Tournament to be held in Chicago in August 1963. This amount has been sent.

ANGELO SANDRIN BECOMES MASTER

The new USCF chess ratings, as published in the December 1962 Chess Life, reveal that Angelo Sandrin, who plays first board for the Argonne National Laboratory "A" team, has now achieved the rank of Master, with a rating of 2259. Jim Warren of the Western Electric team has increased his Expert rating to 2111. Congratulations are in order to both of these fine chess players.
