(a) Usual is 3...B-N5 or 3...N-B3

(b) Better 9 O-O and R-Q1 to put pressure on Black's backward QP. 9...P-Q4 would saddle Black with an isolated pawn.

(c) The threat of 13...P-N5 causes White to weaken his pawn formation.

(d) White, while preventing N-K4-B5, gives Black the advantage of the two bishops and open B-file.

(e) 44 P-N3, Q-R6, 45 R-KN1, R-B4 is no better.
