LATE FLASH!

(There's more here than in your October Chess Life)

As we go to press we learn that Bobby Fischer has captured the Skopje Tournament with a score of 13 1/2 out of 17 ! Geller was second with 13 and the only one to beat Fischer. Bobby began with a draw and then lost to Geller. He also lost to Geller (his only loss again !) at Monaco this spring but still captured first finishing a 1/2 point ahead of Smyslov (EX-WORLD CHAMP). This time (at Skopje) his bad start was offset by seven straight wins a few draws and four more straight wins. His 16th round win put him ahead to stay, finishing 1/2 a point in front of the field.

The Geller loss was a heartbreaker. Bobby's combination proved unsound, but Geller's play was superb in proving it so.

Congratulations to Angelo Sandrin of the Argonne Bishops for tying for 2nd through 6th place with an excellent score of 6-1. Angelo's only loss was to winner, Byrne.

Congratulations to Nick Goncharoff of Motorola who had an excellent tournament and won the Class B prize. Tied with 7 other class B players with 4-3 scores, Nick had the highest tie-breaking points to win a chess clock and share in the cash prizes. Nick's fine results included a win over Expert K. Czerniecki and draws with Master Ed Formanek and Expert Larry Manter. Jim Warren tied for the Class A prize. 6 Industrial Chess League players participated finishing as follows:

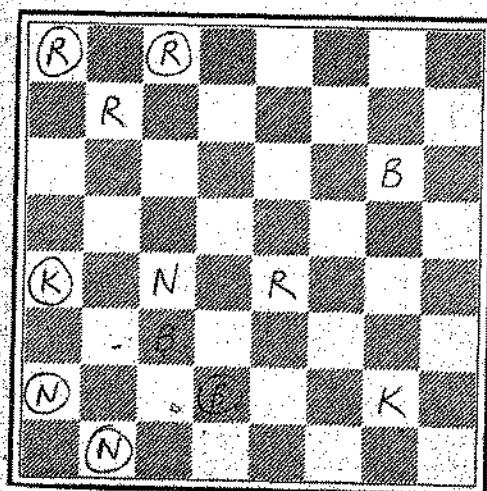
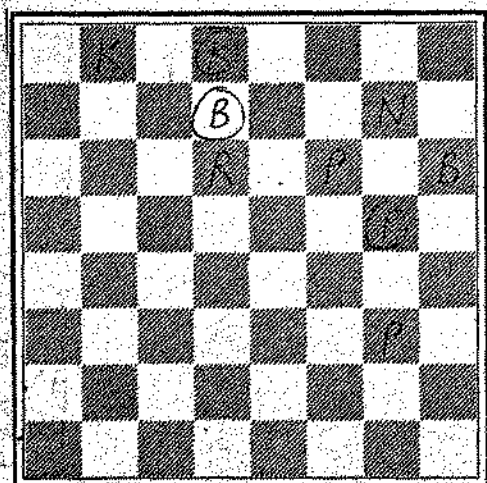
