SIMULTANEOUS EXHIBITION SET FOR MARCH 23RD

After some investigation into the availability of International Grandmaster Svetozar Gligorich, it was decided to pursue our original plan and have our "simultaneous" with Greg DeFotis.

The exhibition will be held at the 20th floor cafeteria of Illinois Bell Telephone Co., 208 West Washington Street. It will start at 6:15 p.m., March 23rd. Depending on how many turnout for the event, late-comers (up to 7:00 p.m.) will be given a chance to join into the event. The fee will be \$2.00 per board. All participants will be expected to bring their own (standard size Staunton pattern) chess sets.

Please notify your President of how many members of your club expect to attend. It is our wish to limit the exhibition to 35 boards so the games will end at a reasonable time. If demand is unusually great, we may have to establish some sort of quota of players from each team. Team captains should note the order in which requests for participation in this match come in so they can follow a first-come, first-served system if need be. We would also like to have a list of names of those planning to attend by noon, March 19th so we can satisfy Illinois Bell Telephone's security procedures.

Greg DeFotis, our exhibitor, is within a pawn-move of reaching the U.S.C.F. rating of 2400. This is the rating that carries the title Senior Master, the highest rank before entering the International Chess Federation's select grades of International Master and Grandmaster.

Young Greg won the U.S. Junior Championship in New York in 1968. The following year he went to Dresden, Germany with the U.S. team in the world student team championships. He has won numerous club championships and Wamsley Cup tournaments held every few months by the Chicago Chess Club.

In 1970, Greg tied with Grandmaster Robert Byrne for first place in the Greater Chicago Open. He also tied with Oreste Popovych for first place in the North Central Open in Milwaukee and placed high in the Illinois Open.

Incidentally, Greg and his older brother, Gary (who is a high Expert), are certainly the top brothers-act in midwest chess. They now rate higher than such illustrious chess-playing brothers as Albert and Angelo Sandrin and John and Valdis Tums.

Here is a rare opportunity to play against a truly outstanding chess star. We hope you attend either as player or spectator.

#### WANTED: A NOMINATING COMMITTEE & OFFICER CANDIDATES

In May we hope to hold a business meeting primarily for the election of officers for the 1971-72 season. By the end of this month we should have a nominating committee formed to develop a list of formal candidates for the five elected offices. Anyone interested in serving on this committee should call the League President. Hopefully we can get at least two members from each division.

Also, to assist the committee, it would help if Team Captains would notify the members of their clubs of possible openings in our officer structure and ask for volunteers for these offices. Naturally Team Captains, themselves, are invited to step forth as candidates. All such names should be submitted to the President until a committee chairman is appointed.

#### FISCHER WINS CHESS OSCAR

At the end of the Interzonal Tournament, Robert Fischer, America's "white hope", was named 1970's outstanding chess competitor in the world by the chess journalists present. He was awarded the chess Oscar. This is a silver statuette of Sancho Panza, Don Quixote's squire in the famous novel of Miguel Cervantes.

Last year's winner was the new world champion, Boris Spassky.

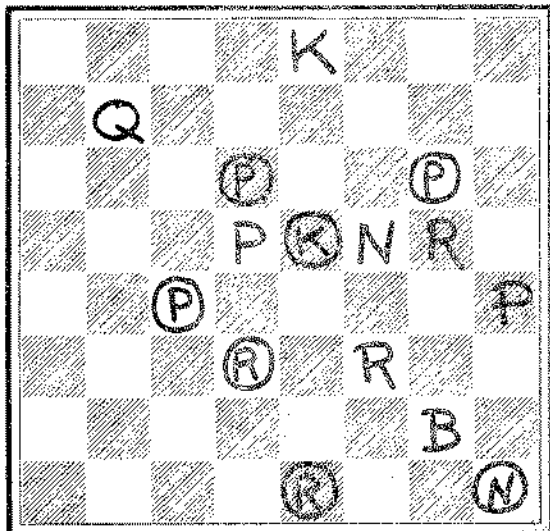

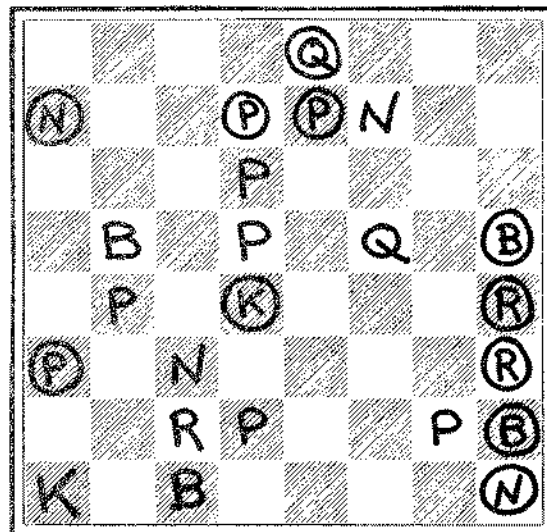


WHITE 8
