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KAVALEK SIMUL TOUR

Grandmaster Lubomir Kavalek will be in the Chicago area from September 5 to September 11, and will be available for simultaneous exhibitions.

The young Grandmaster played for his native Czechoslovakia in the Chess Olympiads of 1964 and 1966 and is one of the strongest players in the world.

Lubomir has been in the United States almost a year and already speaks English very well. His rating is second only to Fischer's in the current list of USA players.

The minimum guaranteed fee for an exhibition is \$150 and the minimum fee per board is \$4.

Anyone interested in this event should contact your Chairman before the end of May. If enough interest is generated, CICL could sponsor such an event together with local chess clubs.

MASTER PAUL TAUTVATIAS IN A SIMULTANEOUS

On Tuesday, May 4, Western Electric Chess Club hosted Chicago Master Paul Tautvatias in a simultaneous exhibition. There were ten Western Electric, seven Bell Labs, and five Teletype players trying for a victory. None succeeded; however, R. Mozockie came the closest, as he won a rook outright. Paul did not resign at this point, but kept on playing and to the surprise of everyone won the game. Only three players were fortunate enough to draw (A. Pehas from Western Electric, A. Winslow of Bell Labs and L. Aldort of Teletype). Congratulations to the three for their fine performance.

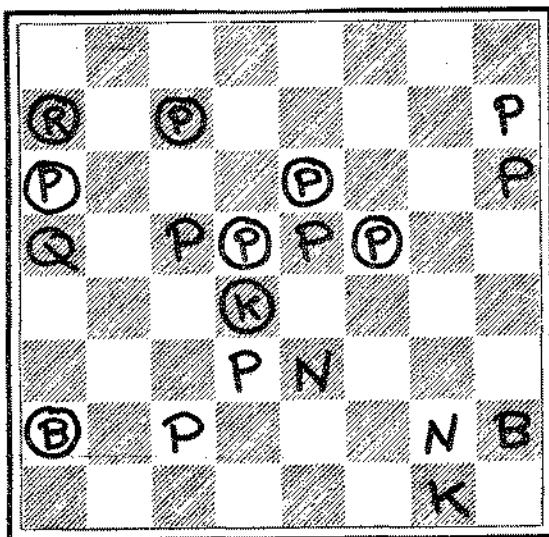

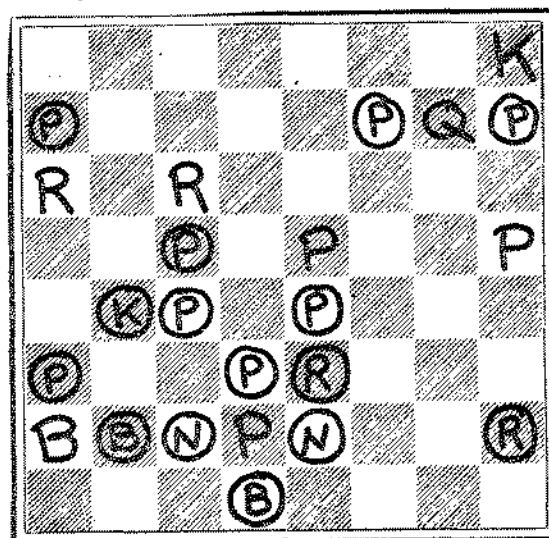
