In this Bulletin there is some bad news and a lot of good news. First we'll give you the bad news. Kraft, with 6 matches to play, has withdrawn from competition. The teams that Kraft had to play each received 4-0 forfeit victories. Bob Kaput cited the confusion of relocating the plant and the fact that they couldn't play any home games as reasons. He also said that he hoped to be back next year.

Now for the good news. There is a new team to replace Kraft. It is Encyclopedia Britannica (voted in by phone) located at 425 North Michigan. The Team Captain is Lawrence Kageman, his phone is 321-7365. They will play three of Kraft's matches on an exhibition basis only.

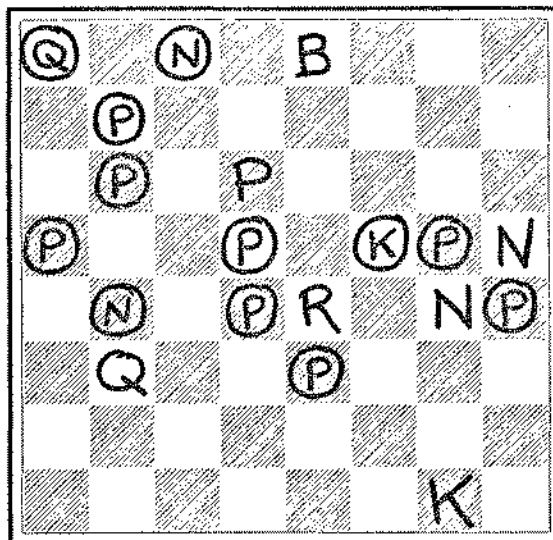

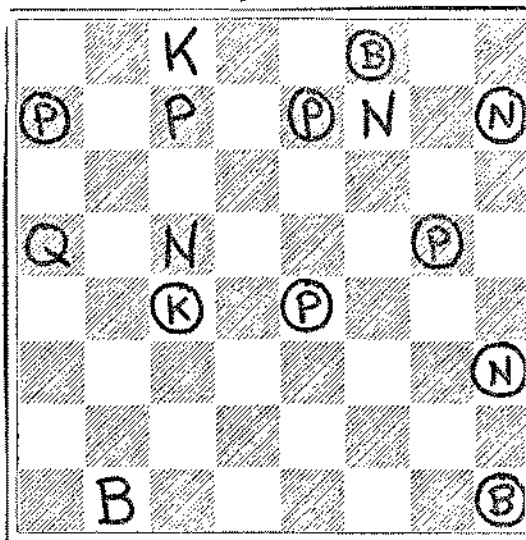
