It is known to some in the CICL that Nik Goncharoff of Motorola achieved the distinction of having beaten Bobby Fischer, during a simultaneous exhibition in Chicago in 1964. Although Fischer was playing seventy other players at the same time, it still took an exceptional player to defeat the future world champion. Bobby lost that evening to only three other players, drawing against eleven others, in a field representing the best of Chicagoland chess talent. In the interests of making this feat known to all of our League members, as well as presenting an interesting game, the score of that game is given here.

"The most I was hoping for was a draw," says Nik of his game with Fischer, "but when I saw him go after my pawns I knew I had a chance to win. What made the victory especially nice was that I was the first player in the room to beat him."

Nik adds that Fischer did not live up to his reputation as a temperamental eccentric. "Bobby was very polite to everyone," says Nik. "He shook hands and congratulated me on my victory, and stopped to autograph the score sheet before moving on to his next game."

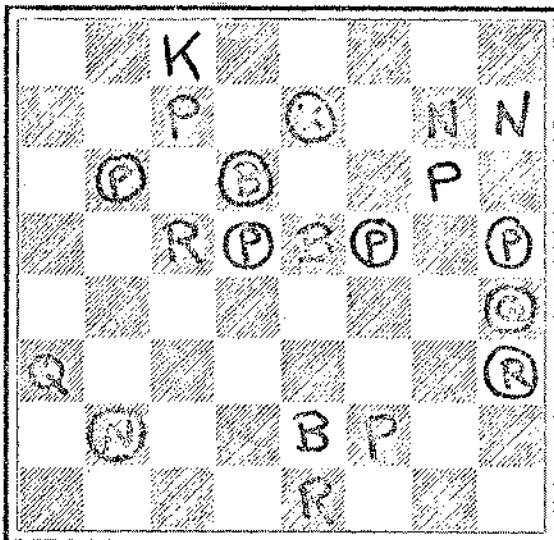

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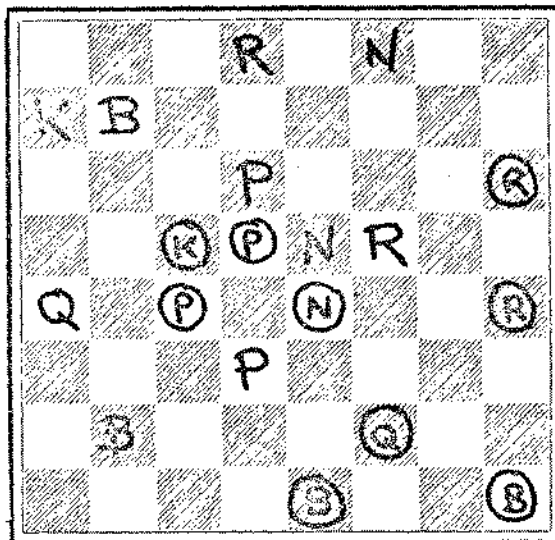


WHITE 11
