The latter usually takes so long to decide on a move that most games are played with the simpler "fast" mode, which is surprisingly sophisticated, however. Given below is a recent game played against the "fast" mode of RCHES. Readers may judge the program's performance from the game score.

- The program knows how to pile up on an object of attack.
- This inexplicable move sows the seeds of the coming defeat. RCHES is not cautious about pawn moves in the King's field, at least in the "fast" mode.
- A game-losing blunder. RCHES, being without any particular plan, decides to protect the otherwise unprotected pawn at KR4. Its emphasis on the purely material aspect of the game is evident with this move.
- The sacrifice of material is totally unanticipated by RCHES, as played both at this move and at move 18 by White.

Total playing time for RCHES was approximately 3½ minutes of PDP-10 time.

- (3) If a player makes an illegal move, and is called for it, he must, if possible, move that piece in another direction. The time to protest is then, not after the game.

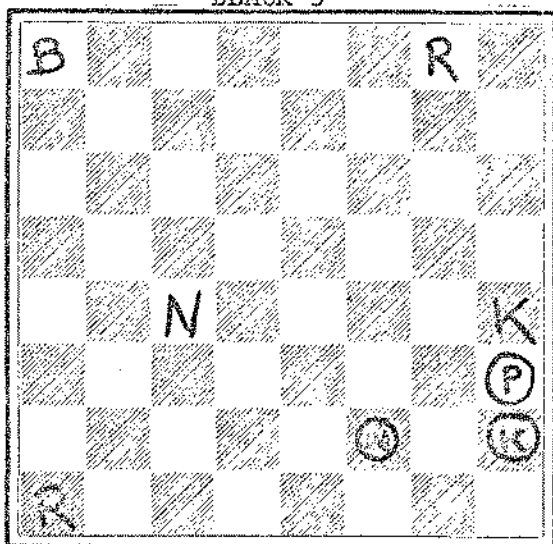

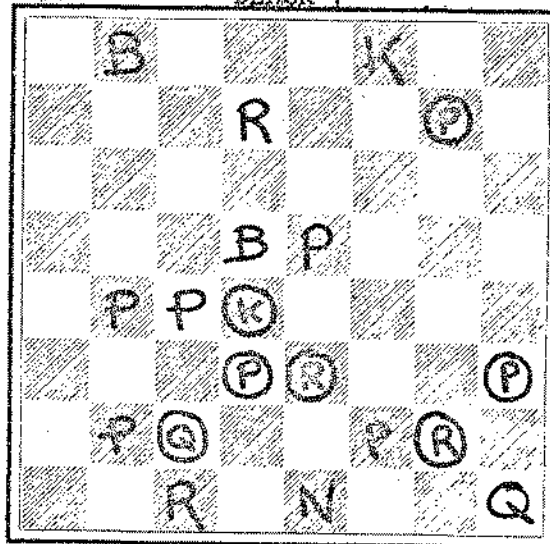
