KOLTANOWSKI TO SPEAK BEFORE LEAGUE

George Koltanowski, International Master, syndicated Chess Journalist, TV Commentator, famous Tournament Director, author, and holder of the World Record for Simultaneous Blindfold Chess Play, has consented to speak before our League on Wednesday, August 15. The evening with Koltanowski will be held at 7:30 PM at Albright Gym, Western Electric, 4939 W. Cermak Rd. (22nd St.) in Cicero. "Kolty" will speak informally on his own colorful career, international chess, U.S.C.F. activities (he is the current Vice Pres.), Bobby Fischer, or other chess topics of general interest. Questions from the audience will be welcomed. Members of your teams, chess clubs, and their chess friends are invited to attend.

U.S. OPEN IN CHICAGO AUGUST 12, 1973

America's biggest and most prestigious open chess tournament will return to Chicago after an absence of 10 years. It will be held at the LaSalle Hotel from August 12 to August 24. Several International Grandmasters and dozens of Masters and Stars of Tomorrow will be on hand to compete for a piece of the \$10,000+ prize fund. A record-breaking crowd of 700 is expected. PROPOSED CHANGE TO THE BY-LAWS

The following change to the By-Laws will be voted on at the Business Meeting August 1, 1973:

I. B. 4. d. of our by-laws reads as follows:

"Treasurer - The Treasurer will be responsible to the President. He will bill each member club for dues, deposit League funds in a suitable savings account, disburse these funds as required, and publish periodic financial statements. An income-expense statement will be prepared whenever a Treasurer turns over funds to his successor. A co-signer and an alternate must be appointed each year to counter-sign with the Treasurer for all withdrawals."

I. B. 4. d. PROPOSED CHANGE will read as follows:

"Treasurer - The Treasurer will be responsible to the President. He will bill each member club for dues, deposit League funds in a suitable checking account, or if circumstances permit in a savings account, or both; disburse these funds as required, and submit to the President an annual financial statement for publication. Financial statements will be periodically furnished whenever requested by the President. A co-signer and/or an alternate will be discretionary upon the option of the President."

The results were to count for ratings purposes only. Motorola won a smashing 7-1 victory; the detailed results are given in the Senior Division results section. Such inter-divisional matches are especially suited for promoting the CIGL's objective of promoting friendly chess rivalry among member clubs. Let's hope that many more such matches take place in the future. In particular, this sort of match is ideal for maintaining interest and participation in organized chess during the summer months.

BEGINNERS CHESS INSTRUCTION

Beginning in July, Jim Brotsos will be conducting two short courses in Elementary Chess on Thursdays (on the North side) and Mondays (in the Loop). Each course will consist of six 1½ hour sessions. Students will be taught the rules of the game, principles of the openings, middle game, and end game. Ideas will be illustrated with examples from Master games. Players will be given an opportunity to play as they learn. They will also receive pass-outs on chess notation, a bibliography, a glossary of chess terms, and information on past World Chess Champions. If you have a neophyte member in your chess club or among your friends, you might suggest these classes as a means of more rapid improvement in playing skill as well as Chess appreciation. 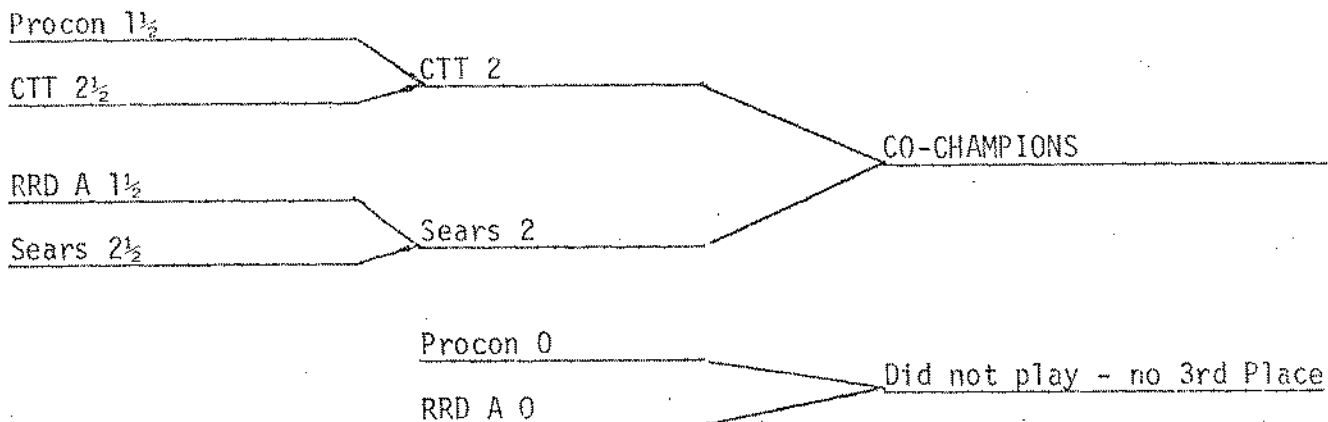

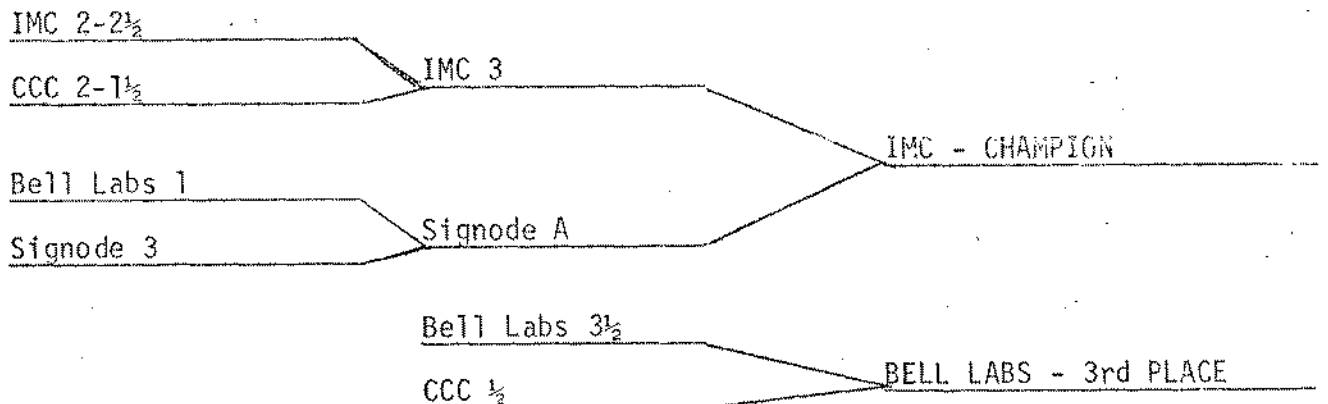
