SENIOR DIVISION NOTES

In a match played at Argonne Laboratory on April 5, the Amoco team barely defeated the ANL Bishops by a score of $4\frac{1}{2}$ - $3\frac{1}{2}$, to move into first place in the B Section of the Senior Division. They now lead the Bishops by one-half game in the loss column, and can clinch the B Section championship by winning their final match of the season against Illinois Bell.

In the A Section, Bell Labs takes a perfect 9-0 record into their climatic return match against the Western Electric Gambiteers, who now have an 8-1 record. The Gambiteers' hopes for the title depend on a victory; a drawn match would appear to virtually assure Bell Labs of the championship.

The ANL Knights have now reached the quota of two time forfeits; in their remaining match against Motorola, the latecomers' games will be forfeited 15 minutes after the scheduled match starting time, as provided by the CICL rules.

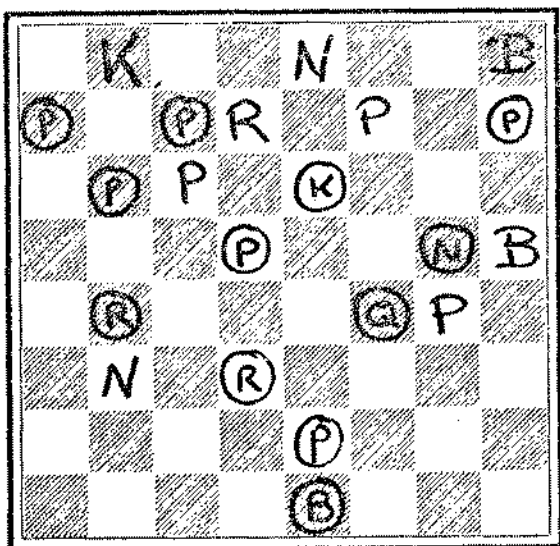

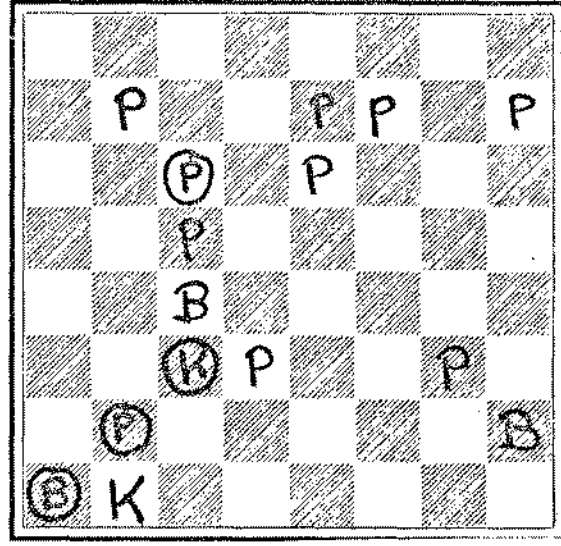
