Telephone Match With New York A Success

The CICL vs. Commercial Chess League of New York match, which has been under discussion for over three years, finally took place on March 2. The event was held at the beautiful Cafeteria of Amoco Research Center in Naperville. It began shortly after noon and was called to a halt at 7:30 PM with six of the twenty games incomplete. In three of these our worthy opponents were in deep time trouble. One of these opponents, Foote, later resigned by telephone to Greg Berry making the score $9\frac{1}{2}$ - $5\frac{1}{2}$ in New York's favor. The remaining games are to be adjudicated by a New York Master, probably Andrew Soltis.

Even though an ultimate victory for our team does not seem likely, the participants seemed to enjoy the match and our Publicity Chairman, Ken Kellogg, is making every effort to generate some worthwhile publicity from it. The Public Relations Department of Amoco took a group picture which we hope will be published in a local paper and in Chess Life & Review.

The only technical hitch occurred when we lost telephone contact and could not continue the match on the tie-line call originally planned. This created a 40 minute delay and, since we continued the match on a toll call, it is costing the League \$29 for our share of the telephone charges.

The results of the match and a couple of game scores are tabularized elsewhere in this Bulletin. Congratulations to Latimer, Pehas, and Berry - our first winners. Thanks to all the other contestants. Election & Business Meeting April 9th

Be sure to attend our annual election and Spring business meeting on Tuesday, April 9. It will be held at 6:20 PM in the CNA Employees Lounge, 2nd Floor of their building at the southeast corner of Jackson & Wabash in Chicago.

In addition to electing officers for 1974-75, we will have reports by Committee Chairmen and will clarify our position on team member eligibility. See Bulletin No. 6 for details on the affle planned for that evening.

Setting a Rating

One feature of our League program that seems to cause a lot of discussion is our individual rating system. Players like to see their names on a rating list and having this data available makes possible programs such as the James E. Warren Award. Unfortunately, some players on lower boards, especially in the Junior Division, seldom play rated players and are having a tough time establishing a rating.

In order to help these players, your President would like to establish a program to deliberately match unrated players with the more active rated players. We could arrange for Rating Weeks in May when most players will be through with their regular season and perhaps gain in July. These matches, of course, will depend on players with ratings being willing to play unrated players for the fun of it. The only extra benefit that comes to mind would be that these games would be counted toward the player's eligibility for membership in the Century Club (100 League games played). An unrated player who can play and beat one of the rated players will naturally accelerate his ability to create a CICL rating.

All players interested in participating in such extra matches should notify their Team Captains who should, in turn, pass this information along either at the Business Meeting or through their respective Division Chairman. Unrated players should be prepared to travel to the rated opponent. All respondents should indicate preferences as to where they wish to play and night of the week.

Getting a Rating - Continued

The only other way to make hastein getting a CICL rating is to join the U.S. Chess Federation play in USCF sponsored tournaments, and then notify our Rating Statistician, Dan Kumro, when you have played enough such games to get a USCF Rating. Dan will pick up an established USCF Rating as the start-up CICL rating in our system.

Those of you wishing to pursue this avenue can join the USCF through the CICL for \$8 per year. At the 2nd Annual Industrial Tornado first-time members of the USCF will be allowed to join for only \$6.

The Industrial Tornado, a USCF sanctioned Swiss Style Tournament, will be held as an encouragement for our members to take part in an official rated tournament and as a means of publicizing our League to the chess-playing public. The details follow:

Class D, E, & Unrated - Trophy
Additional prizes will depend on number and classification of entrants.

TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR: Jim Brotsos; assisted by Jim Warren.

U.S.C.F. MEMBERSHIP: All contestants must either pay their annual membership dues or present a valid membership card at the registration table.

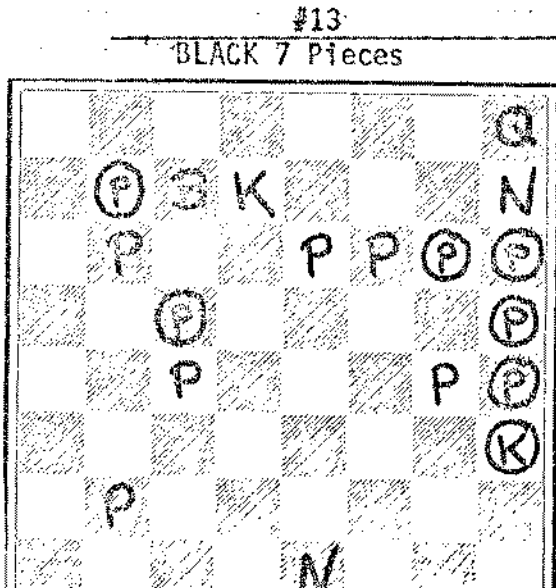
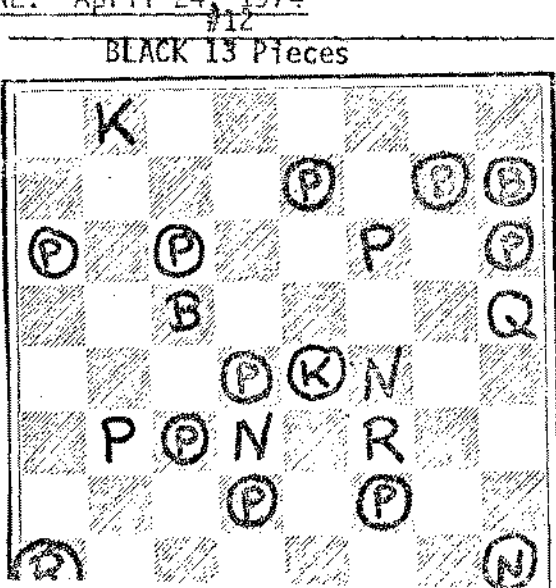
