The remaining League business covered at the April 9 meeting is summarized in the minutes of the meeting published elsewhere in this Bulletin.

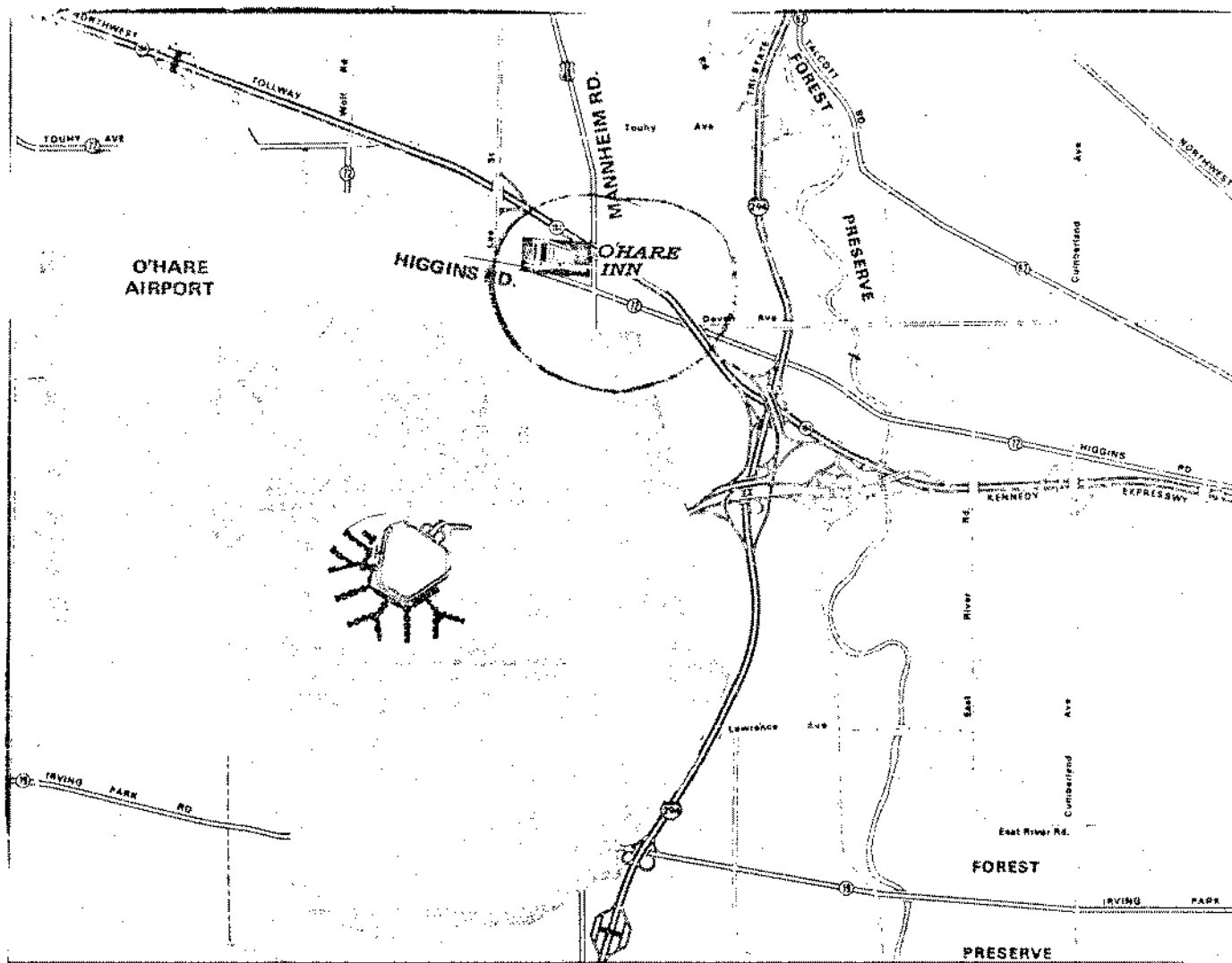
Industrial Tornado Tournament - May 25th

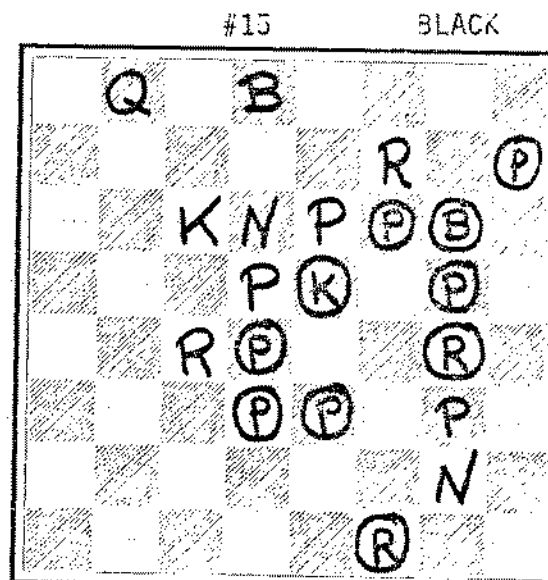
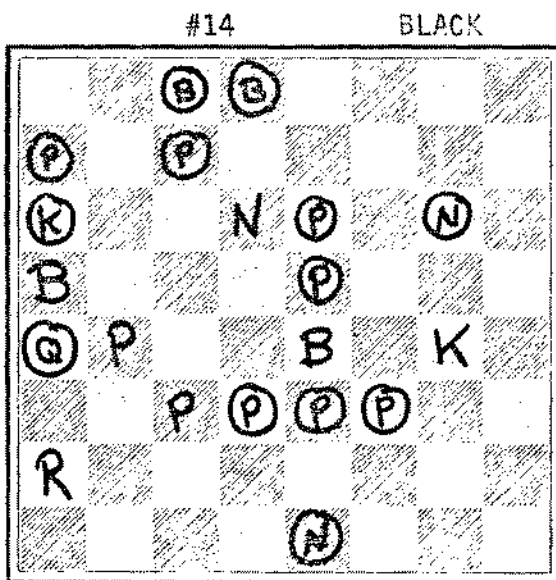

"It is proposed that, for the 1973-74 season of the Chicago Industrial Chess League, Senior Division, the tie-breaking and playoff procedure be changed as follows:"

"In case of team ties involving trophies, all such tied teams will be involved in a playoff, the method of playoff to be determined by the Senior Division Chairman. There will be no third place trophy."

The above has now been adopted by a majority of votes from the Senior Division.
