Adjournments

Recently questions have arisen on where an adjourned game should resume. The C.I.C.L. Rules (I) do not address this question. As a guideline for this season, your Chairman and President have agreed to rule as follows:

If the adjournment is by mutual agreement, the game is to resume where it first started. If one player does not wish to adjourn and the other player insists on adjourning (provided, of course, he is in compliance with Rule II J as to minimum duration of play and first time control in clock games), the adjourning player will have to travel to his opponent's team home location to resume the game. Other arrangements on location are acceptable if mutually agreed upon.

At the next business meeting we can discuss this question more fully.

Adjourned games should be resumed or otherwise resolved. If an impasse develops, your Chairman and President must do so if the outcome is not resolved.

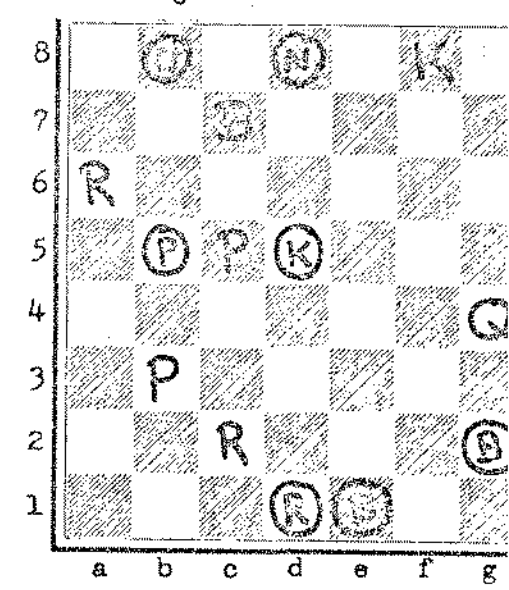
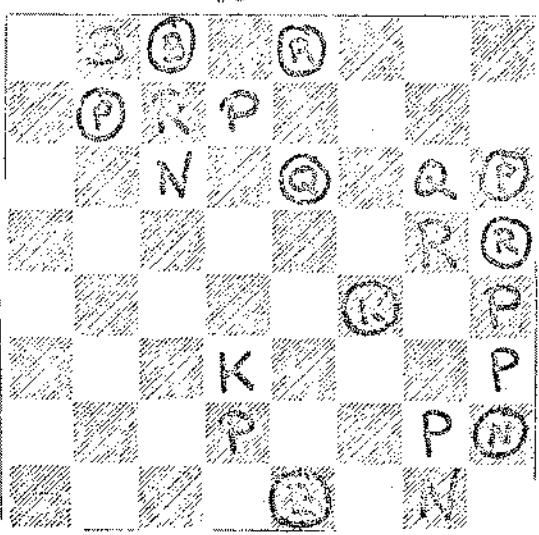
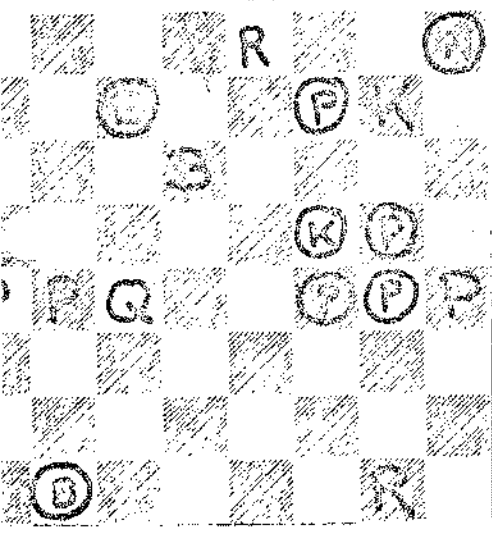

#2 (M. Segers, 1936) 1. K-R7. A potpourri of pins -- the key unpins a WN and pins the stronger WQ. In one major variation 1... Q-Q2, 2. Q-KB4, the BQ repins the N and unpins the Q which mates in the field of the newly pinned BR. In the other major variation, 1... R-B2 2. Q-N6, the Q can mate while pinned because the BR has pinned the BQ while pinning the WN.

(Molnar-Szogy, 1939) 1. R(8)-N5. Another problem with clean line openings and closings. The point is the avoidance of duals after the defenses 1... N(O)xP and 1... N(B)
