Fischer Defaults Title - John Greczek

In March, F.I.D.E. held an Extraordinary General Assembly in Bergen, Holland to consider Bobby Fischer's proposals for rule changes for the World Championship Match. They voted 37 for and 33 against Fischer's demand for an unlimited number of drawn games with the title going to the first player to achieve 10 victories. However, by a margin of 35 to 32, they rejected his demand that he retain the title if the score reaches 9-9, deciding instead to award the title to the player who wins the next game. Fischer informed F.I.D.E. that he would not accept these conditions, whereupon F.I.D.E. stripped him of his title and acclaimed A. Karpov of the USSR as the World Champion. Presumably, this is an irreversible decision; and if so, Fischer will, in the future, only try to be Karpov's challenger, with far less influence on what rules will apply. By his action, he has inflicted a great disappointment on all chess enthusiasts who were looking forward to the match. He has also given up at least 1.7 million dollars and possibly as much as 3.3 million dollars prize money depending on whether he would have lost or won.

II. E. Trophies

The League will award suitable trophies to at least the first and second place teams of each division.

II. J. Adjournments

Arrangements for adjournments may be by mutual agreement of individual opponents. After 3-1/2 hours of play, however, either player may demand an adjournment without prior arrangement, except in clock games when an adjournment cannot occur until all the moves have been completed within the framework of the first time control. The player requesting the adjournment must have the move, and may seal that move as follows:

1. Record the sealed move on paper.
2. Record the position and time consumed by each player on a separate paper.
3. Sign and obtain his opponent's signature on 2. above.
4. Give all papers to a third party who will not reveal the move until the game is resumed.

Unless both players agree to a result (win, loss, or draw), an adjourned game must be resumed, and should be completed within 10 days. For the resumption of an adjourned game, the player who requested the adjournment and sealed the move should be willing to travel to his opponent's home playing location. Any other location is satisfactory if mutually agreeable. Refusal to resume an adjourned game will result in a forfeit loss.

If unusual circumstances, such as extended illness, prevent the game from being resumed within 10 days, then the Division Chairman may, at his discretion, order an adjudication of the position by a chess expert. Any fee for this service will be shared equally by the teams of the two opponents.

Second Telephone Match Between CICL and Commercial Chess League of New York - Gary Benson

The second telephone match between CICL and CCLNY was held on March 15, 1975 at Amoco's cafeteria. The match started at 12:00 noon and lasted until 6:00 p.m. Of the 20 boards, we won 2, lost 6, drew 2 and 10 will be adjudicated, presumably by Andy Soltis.

New York has a very strong league -- last year, we lost by 11-1/2 to 8-1/2. Congratulations to Gary Wolcott and Dave Streets who provided the first two wins! Final results will be forthcoming in a future bulletin.

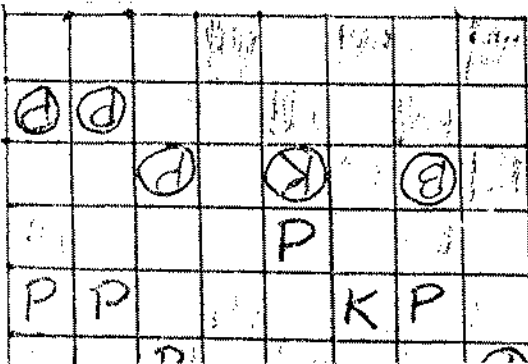

I came to this match with every expectation of playing white on board 2, but match time arrived and, since our first board was vacant, I moved up to face Adolf Brosig. Adolf and I first played chess on 1/15/70 in the Sherwin-Williams vs Signode match. Adolf quickly demonstrated his aggressive style by sacrificing a Rook and the exchange for a brilliant attack leading to checkmate about a dozen moves later. His victory was so dazzling that I submitted it to the C. I. C. L. Bulletin for publication (see no. 7 3/31/70). In the next few years we played two more games; we each won one. Now I found myself unexpectedly facing this fine tactician once more. We were even playing the same opening.

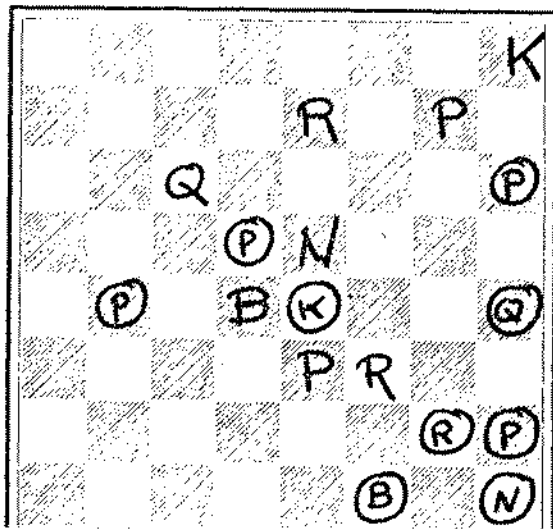

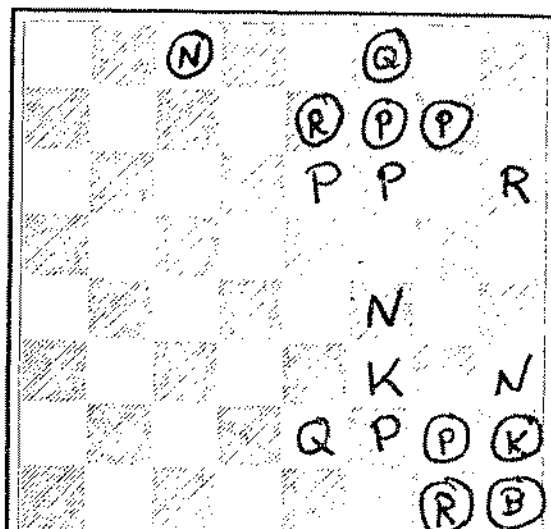
