Karpov-Kotchnoi Match - John Greczek

The December 1 (Sunday) Chicago Tribune published all of the 24 Karpov-Korchnoi games (without annotations). There were 19 draws in the match which was held in Moscow. Karpov won by 3-to-2, draws not counting, and demonstrated that his highly analytical and cautious defensive strategy was apparently marginally better than Korchnoi's aggressive, bold play.

Karpov may already be the new world champion. Bobby Fischer resigned his title in a dispute with F.I.D.E. over the rules for the challenge match. If Bobby does not rescind his resignation by April 1, 1975, Karpov will be crowned champion. Incidentally, your President thinks Bobby Fischer's position deserves our support. Without going into F.I.D.E.'s ruling and Bobby's objections to it, suffice to say that many reports underscore that F.I.D.E.'s desire to assert its authority is the underlying cause of the dissension. That would be O.K. if what Fischer is asking is unreasonable. However, a strong argument can be made that it is not and that, in fact, it would be much more conducive to an exciting and decisive match. I hope to be able to discuss this some more within our ranks to determine whether collectively we feel we should support Fischer. If so, then one way would be by means of a letter - using our new letterhead stationery - to U.S.C.F. or perhaps even to F.I.D.E., with a copy to Fischer.

The shortest game in the Karpov-Korchnoi match was game 21 in which Karpov resigned after move 18. The score is given in this issue of the Bulletin.

Have You Ever Wondered ... - Lee Sheridan

... how the ratings are calculated? Jim Warren originated the CICL rating procedure in 1968 along the lines of the U.S.C.F. procedure. This year we have a completely computerized rating program. This will make the rating of games between rated players easier. It also means that CICL members will benefit by more versatile and timely listings of rating information.

Just entering game results and previously unlisted players each month is still a large job. I am being assisted by Jim Warren who is handling games involving unrated players.

The rating procedure involves the use of equations that consider difference in rating, game result and number of rated games played by each player. The basic equations are:

$$\Delta R = k(W - W_e)$$

$$W_e = \left[1 / \left(1 + 10^{\frac{-D}{400}} \right) \right]$$

where ΔR = Change in rating

D = Rating difference before game

W = 1 when higher rated player wins

= 0 when lower rated player wins

= $\frac{1}{2}$ for draws

k = 45 for 5-99 rated games played

= 30 for 100-299 rated games played

= 20 for 300 or more

The correct algebraic sign (+ or -) for ΔR is based on the game result. The procedure is modified slightly when a player rated under 1200 beats or draws a player over 1200.

How do you get a rating? By playing five or more games against rated opponents. When you have played five such games (without winning or losing all of them), your opponents' ratings are averaged. Then, based on your percentage result against all five opponents, a correction factor is added or subtracted from the average. This becomes your initial rating.

In the past, we have used ampers and (&) ratings for 4-man division players with less than five games against rated opponents. This was done because when the junior division was started it was almost impossible to play five rated players in a season (or even longer). Thus these people would have no guide to how well they were doing. The need for this special provisional rating has now passed and (&) ratings are being phased out. This is the last year that such ratings will be carried on the records. Jim Warren will handle games involving (&) ratings, and they will be published in a separate list in the Bulletin.

You may not have noticed, but rated players are not affected by results against non-rated or (&)-rated players. Historical results are used for initial ratings, but the initial rating is not retroactive for the non-rated games.

Each month, the games reported in the previous Bulletin are rated. The players' Player Numbers and the game result are entered into the computer program. The program rates the game, alters the players' statistics accordingly, and prints out the monthly rating lists.

Player numbers are assigned by a set procedure. If anyone can describe the full procedure for the first player through the last, I will send him a sneak preview rating list each month of this season prior to Bulletin publication. One winner only - in writing - first postmark wins - no fair if you talked to Jim Warren, John Greczek or Lee Sheridan about this. Player numbers appear in the tables following the ratings in this issue.

Team captains should start including player numbers on all result sheets. This will help me do the ratings correctly. It also helps your division chairmen if your spellings or writing are bad. Eventually, games reported without player numbers will not be rated. (Don't get up in arms yet - but near future.) Players without numbers can be reported with a zero for player number. This will mean that this is the first game played by this player since we started using this system.

I sincerely hope that errors do not occur in the ratings. We all know that this is impossible for a full season. Whenever an error is found in a game result in the Bulletin or in the rating list, please call me immediately. Team captains can keep their players happy by sending me typed lists of their players with correct spellings and initials.

After the proper time check, an individual can request adjournment, upon resuming it has been indicated that play would progress for 1 hour or 23 moves and again be adjourned.

The ruling is that if sufficient time has elapsed 3 hours or more along with proper time checks, an additional adjournment could be requested.

Hopefully, all games should be completed before that occurrence.

Play without a clock after 1 hour of elapsed time.

A clock cannot be forced during the first meeting of across the board if both parties are not in agreement. However, an adjournment can be called for after 3-1/2 hours of elapsed time.

Upon resuming play, a clock is available and must be used until game completion.

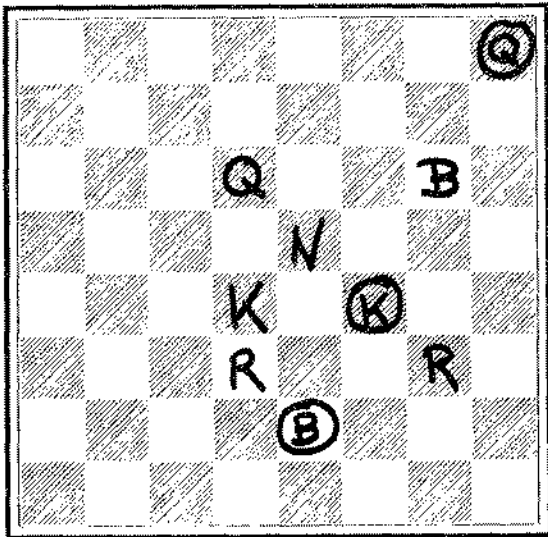

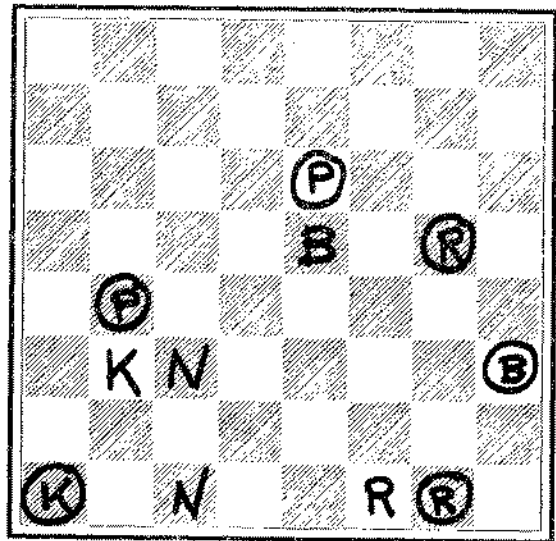
