CICL Banquet - Joe Brozovich

The CICL Banquet will be held on June 20, 1975 at Sharko's located on 1 West Roosevelt Road, Villa Park, Illinois. Guests will arrive between 6:45 and 7:15 and dinner will be served at 7:30. The menu consists of a fresh fruit cup appetizer, tossed salad, all the beef, chicken and mostaccioli you can eat followed by an Elmer's Sundae for dessert. The cost is \$7.25 per person and this includes tax and tip. Drinks will be available at a cash bar in the banquet room. The team captains are requested to collect the money from their team and send checks or money orders (no cash) to J. M. Brozovich, 2417 Stonewall Avenue, Woodridge, Illinois 60515 by June 9. Tickets will be issued at the door before 7:30 to those who have paid for them. There will be entertainment for those not participating in the speed chess tournament.

New York vs. Chicago

The final adjudicated results are now in for the telephone match between the Commercial Chess League of New York and the Chicago Industrial Chess League. Unfinished games were adjudicated by Andy Soltis, a New York International Master. The CICL came out ahead on adjudications, 6-4, but CCLNY won the match 11-9. We won 2-1/2 out of 3 on the top three boards, but New York's depth prevailed. This was certainly a commendable performance by all who participated.

The following quote from Andy Soltis explains his rationale during adjudication:

"The standard I used for adjudications is the one I've used in the past: that is, if there is a direct, demonstrable winning plan, I'll agree to a win. Otherwise, draw. On board 1, for example, I looked at the position with Marc Yoffie for 20 minutes -- I was trying to prove Black was winning and he was trying to prove White was winning. Neither of us succeeded and after some further examination, it appeared clear that a win, if it did exist, was not direct and demonstrable."

Third Annual Tornado Topped by Stewardson - Jim Brotsos

The "Industrial Tornado" Swiss Style Tournament was held on April 13 at the O'Hare Inn. After four tough rounds, the top finishers, with 4 points each, were:

First - Don Stewardson of Lindenhurst, Illinois

Second - Mark Strzelichowski, first board on the Sears B Team

Third - Kurt Stein, a high school boy from Westchester

The field of 59 included 17 CICL members, the most illustrious being Ruben Reyes, the near-master who has led the Sears A team this season. The upset of the tournament occurred in the first round, however, when Reyes was defeated by Steve Karlovics of Zenith, Melrose Park, who has a CICL rating of 1436. Another upset occurred in Round 1 when the fifth-ranked entrant, Doyle Satterlee, lost to Frank Leben (rated 1399) of R. R. Donnelley "B".

Another key upset was registered in the second round when second ranked Harold Winston (1906) of the U. of Chicago was knocked off by Stewardson (1557) who went on to win the top prize. The most noteworthy game was certainly the Sllakowski-Stein set-to. It began in the second round, went through two adjournments, and wound up going 173 moves before Sllakowski resigned at 2am. These two players surely earned our respect for their tenacity and sitzfleisch. The victory catapulted young Stein (who finished 13th last year) into a four way tie at the top.

Two league players who deserve special mention are Irv Rosenfeld, the model of consistency, who finished in the top four places all three years of this tournament and Frank Leben who went from 36th last year to 5th this year.

The tournament once more was a success in accomodations and smooth operation. The only difficulty was the failure to stay on schedule because of prolonged hard fought games in the second and third rounds. Much credit is due Charlie Ward's hard work in planning and pre-registering the tournament. Assisting him in the registration process and trophy procurement were Irv Rosenfeld and Fred Ciba, respectively. The event was ably directed by Jim Brotsos and Jim Warren. A new feature this year was the inclusion of a book-sale concession in the tournament room. A staggering assortment of chess books and some chess clocks were on sale by the American Postal Chess Tournaments organization managed by the Warrens.

Siegbert Tarrasch (1862-1934) used his caustic sense of humor with great effect while ridiculing a "new" style of play that he began to notice back in 1890. Below are his annotations to a game in the future.

"Chess of the Future"

1. N-KB3 ...

Introduced by Zukertort, in honor of whom the opening is named. But since he never hit upon the correct continuation, it is better known as the Four Knights Game.

1. ... N-KB3

Zukertort's opponents used to play 1...P-Q4, showing but a superficial knowledge of chess by moving pawns which they could not retreat. The text move is the only correct one.

2. N-QB3 ...

An excellent move, demonstrating powers of deep strategy. A novice might be tempted to to play P-Q4 instead of the text. It cannot, however, be sufficiently impressed upon the mind of the student that a pawn, once moved, cannot retreat, and it forms a target for attack by the opponent's pieces.

2. ... N-QB3

The opponent also displays great generalship.

3. N-KN1 ...

A masterly conception! Threatening to obtain considerable advantage by also retreating the other Knight and thereby preventing his pieces from being molested by hostile pawns for a long time.

3. ... N-KN1

Perceiving the danger at the right moment. This manuever leads to at least an even position.

4. N-N1! N-N1!!

The spectator sees - doubtless with admiration - two masters of the highest rank thoroughly acquainted with all the most subtle points connected with chess. Both sides are guarding against weak spots created by pushing pawns rashly. In former days experts used to move these pawns to develope pieces. But lately it became obvious that this is a mistake; for once moved these pawns may be attacked and even captured if not properly taken care of.

5. N-KR3 ...

An ingenious attempt to gain an advantage. That the Knights are better placed here than in the center, where they command too many squares, is equally well known.

5. ... N-QR3!!

6. N-R3!! N-R3!!

It would be difficult to imagine play more precise or accurate and entirely in accordance with the accepted rules laid down by the masters of the present day.

7. N-KN1 N-KN1

Never has a chessplayer penetrated so deeply into the theory of the game.

8. N-N1 ...

At this stage Black offered a draw. White has a momentary advantage in having one piece less developed than his opponent. But this, perhaps, is not sufficient to win. The draw was therefore agreed upon.

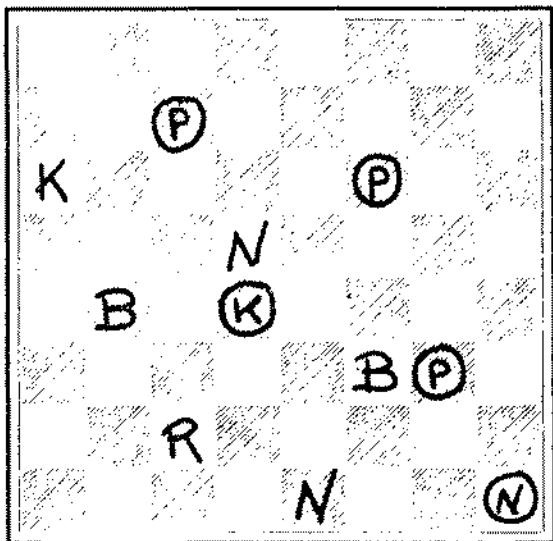

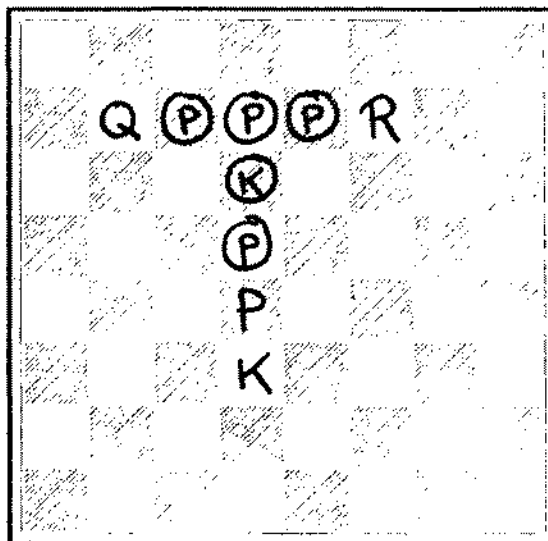

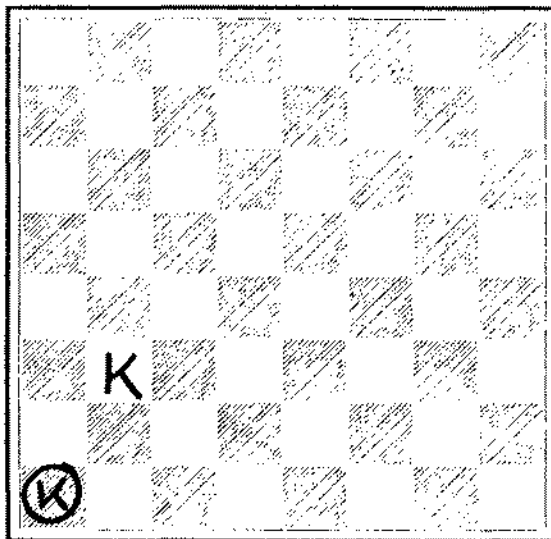
