

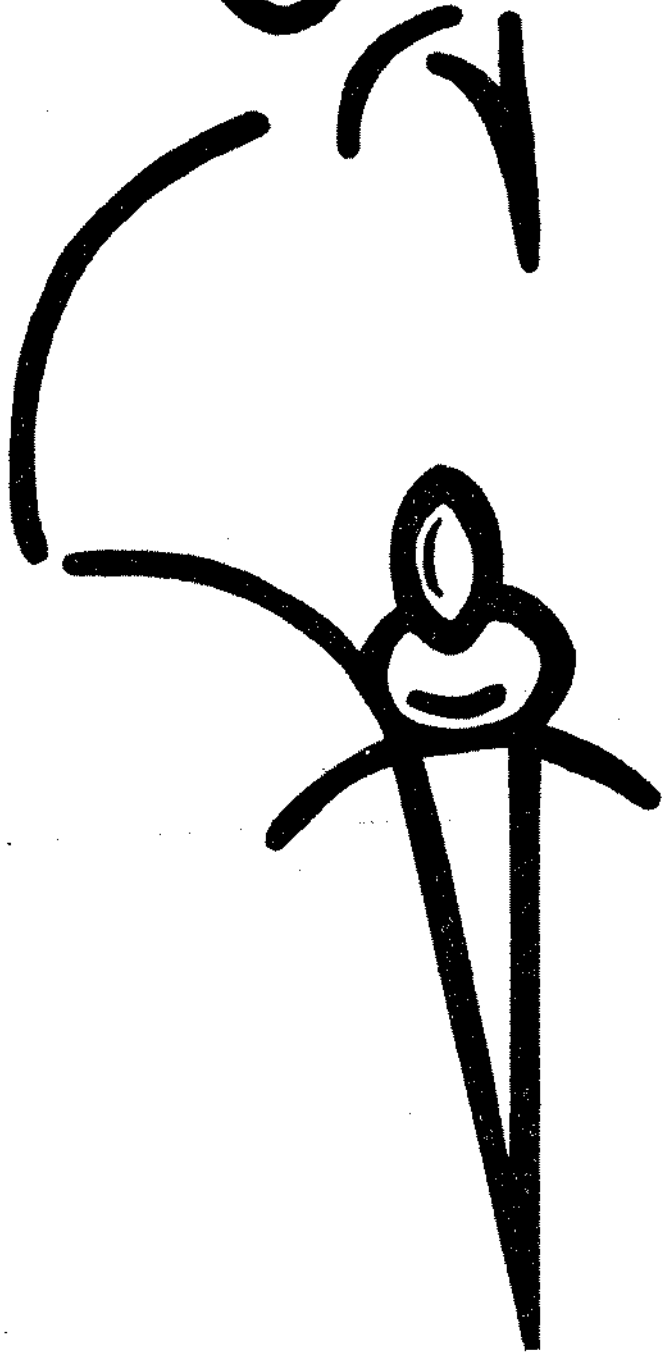

A telephone match between our league and the Commercial Chess League of New York was held on February 29, 1976 at the Amoco Research Center. It had previously been agreed to play 20 boards at this match, but after canvassing both Junior and Senior divisions only 17 players could be found. Despite the scarcity of players, especially top rated players, CICL made a fine showing with a score of 5 to 5 with 7 fairly even matches going to adjudication. 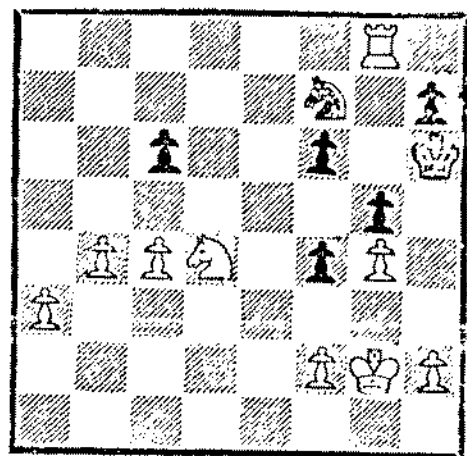

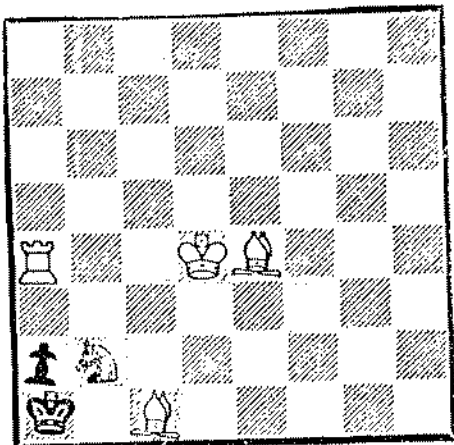

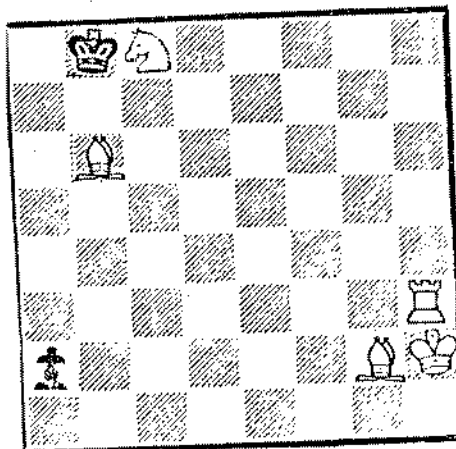
