Summer Business Meeting - June 24th.

The first business meeting of the 1976/77 season will be held in June this year to allow the league officers and individual teams sufficient time to plan for a six man team league (in the event that the league accepts the six man team alignment). Since this proposal has an important affect upon the league's future, I would like to urge every team to send at least one representative to this meeting.

Amoco has again graciously agreed to host our annual summer business meeting. The meeting will be held at 7:00pm on Thursday, June 24th at the Amoco Research Center, Naperville, Ill.

In addition to discussing and voting on the six man team proposal, we will also continue discussions on the proposals Jim Brotsos presented at the spring meeting (see Bulletin #6). Hopefully, we can reach some discussions on his proposals.

As in the past a number of committee appointments are necessary for the successful functioning of the league. These include:

CICL "Policies & Rules" - Proposed Amendments

Vested Rights Proposal

- I.C.2. Change wording of
"...must be a former employee retired by that company." To the following:
"... must be a former employee with vested rights in that company's re-
tirement pension fund."

Six Man Team Proposal

- I.B.1. Change wording to read: "1. The league will consist of one division. It will be comprised of 6-man teams and will hereafter be called the league."
I.B.5. Remove the following sentence: "In these and officers' elections, representatives of 8-man teams will be allowed 2 votes each; representatives of small teams will be assigned a single vote each."
I.D.1. Remove the first paragraph and replace as follows: "Dues - The treasurer will present a bill to all teams at the fall business meeting, with the dues clearly represented."
I.E.1. Remove item 1 and change item 2 to read: "1. Any team which forfeits an average of 1.0 games or more per match during a season will be subject to review at the next league business meeting. An entire forfeited match will not be counted for this purpose."
II.F.2. Change wording of "... it wins $4\frac{1}{2}$ - $3\frac{1}{2}$ or 8 - 0." To the following:
"... it wins $3\frac{1}{2}$ - $2\frac{1}{2}$ or 6 - 0."
II.F.4. Change wording to read: "The playoffs schedule for CICL Champion will be determined by the division chairmen each season before the start of that season."

The Senior Division was soundly trounced at the All Star Match on April 15th. Perhaps a misjudgement on my part was the reason so few of the top rated players accepted invitations. Income tax and Easter were not on my mind when the date was selected last December. Those who played enjoyed the fine hospitality of the 1st National Bank. We all wish to thank Mr. Gastelu and the 1st. National Bank for their generous help. The Junior Division came out with an average rating near 1800; for the Seniors the average was 172 less.

The match was very nearly AT&T vs. the Junior Division, as all but one of the Senior Division players were Western Electric or Bell Labs employees: Half the teams in the Senior section sent no representatives.

The cost is \$8.00 per person and this includes tax and tip. Drinks will be available at a cash bar in the banquet room. Except for one adjourned game and one under protest, the season is over in the Senior Division. The Dragons need a win from Cas Brenda (who is a pawn up) in order to remain undefeated and untied. The Rooks came out that night with every intention of spoiling the Dragon's record. The Indians and Kingsmen were both surprised in the last round by Motorola and Amoco. IBT passed up the Knights in the final round and matched records with the Indians.

At the beginning of the year the Rooks, Dragons and Chargers looked good. They were the teams to beat, but it wasn't done often enough. Next year (depending on team size), there may be additional teams from Amoco, Argonne and IBT (at Lisle). Also, there is a high probability that strengths will be equalized within company teams. If this all happens, then Motorola, the Chargers and IBT (loop) would be in other sections and perhaps 1 or 2 ANL teams also. For the betterment of the League and for continued growth, I hope the CIGL does form into a single (six-man team) league of four sections.
