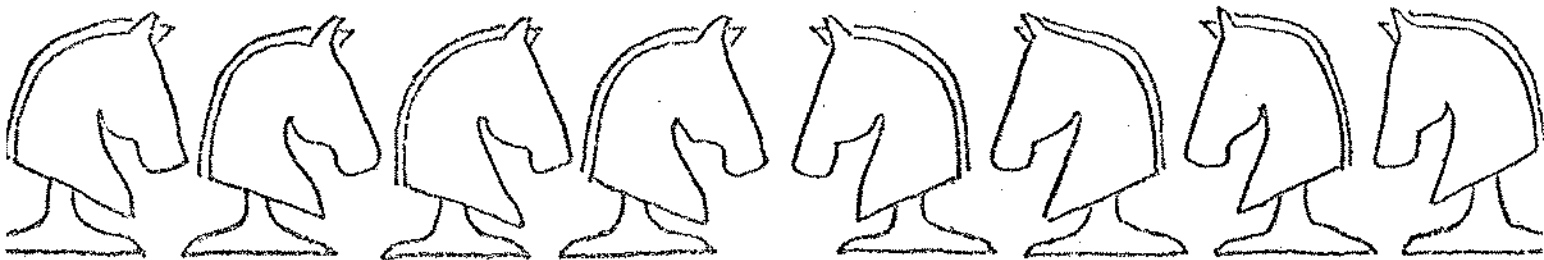

PAIRINGS

Home and Away Policy

QUARTER FINALS: Teams will be ranked 1 through 8 from the 1st and 2nd place finishers in each division to form the playoff slate. The first four teams will be the "Home" team.

SEMI FINALS: The teams that were "Away" in the quarter round will be the "Home" team in the semi round if both teams were "Home" or if both teams were "Away" highest ranked team is the "Home" team.

FINALS: If remaining two teams are the same in home and away matches from the first two playoff rounds the highest ranked team has its choice of being "Home" or "Away."

Special restrictions in pairings may apply in the quarter-final round only. Two teams from the same division cannot meet in the quarter-final round. If the rankings match two teams from the same division, the highest ranked team in the first 4 ranked teams drops down one position and plays the next ranked team in the second four. Examples shown along with the 4th ranked team paired against the 8th ranked team.

RANKINGS

In the quarter final round and all playoff rounds, the four 1st place finishers will be ranked 1 through 4 with the highest performance percentage for the regular season denoting ranked position. The four 2nd place finishers will be ranked 5th through 8th by the same method. After the quarter finals, remaining teams will be ranked by the same method established in the quarter finals.

In the event the match score produces a tie situation for the original rankings, game point percentages will be used to break ties. In the event that a tie still exists, most wins percentage-wise will be used to break ties. In the highly unlikely possibility that a tie still exists, rankings will be determined by lot.

Drawn Matches 3 - 3

Since the playoffs are a "knock-out" tournament tie-breaking becomes a sore spot. In the 1977 season (a Swiss), the 1st National Bank lost out to Sears for the 2nd place trophy by a $\frac{1}{2}$ game point in the play-offs. In the 1978 season, the Argonne Knights lost out to Motorola for at least a 2nd place trophy because a win on the lowest board, 6, was discounted. It seems that to determine a suitable tie-breaking system that doesn't give one or the other team a pre-determined advantage going into the match (example, needing only to play for 3 points instead of $3\frac{1}{2}$) becomes a problem. Last season discounting the results on the lowest board (6), etc. was used. This season a different method will be used so that a team winning on board 6 will still be able to win a drawn match on tie breaking points.

Following reasoning that the higher the board the higher the quality of chess will be played, the following weights will be established per board:

Board 1	8 tie-breaking points
" 2	6
" 3	5
" 4	4
" 5	2
" 6	1

All boards will count in totalling tie-breaking points and a draw will count $\frac{1}{2}$ the value and a loss ZERO. In the event that a tie still exists, board 6 will be discounted, etc. In the event that 6 draws occurs in the final round, the defending champion will be declared the winner, if neither team is the defending champion, the following tie-break will be used if there are 6 draws or if 6 draws occur in either the semi final or quarter final round. The home team will be declared the winner.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Please contact me, Dan Kumro, "Tournament Director" (for '79 Playoffs) as soon as you know your results. My business phone is: 981-~~2220~~²²⁰³ or 981-2277. Also every effort must be made to bring matches to a conclusive result. Every effort should be made to avoid adjourned games that affect the outcome of the match since this is a "Knockout Tournament" and undecided results hold up pairings for the next round. Early starting times for the match should be considered, leaving a possibility to play to the secondary time control, also, an earlier primary time control could be suggested (and this would not have to be for all 6 boards, even 2 or 3 boards would help). However, if an adjourned game is the only possible continuation, a minimal time span is all that is allowed and is as follows:

- Quarter finals: May 17th through May 21st, inclusive.
- Semi finals: June 1st through June 4th, inclusive.
- Finals: June 15th through June 18th, inclusive.

Also, the above schedule allows for the match to be played on the last day of the round, every effort should be made to play in the earliest time slot possible of any given round allowing greater flexibility for adjourned games. Home team captains must take the initiative in setting up matches. Also, any problems in scheduling will be resolved by the League President, Jim Sobun.

DIVISIONAL CHAIRMEN

Please push your captains to complete their schedules on time. All basic and supplementary pairings (Swiss tournaments, etc.) should be completed by April 20th to resolve any ties involving trophies.
