sounding board

During the Argonne Rooks' first five matches of the 1979-80 season, two incidents have occurred that should be aired to ensure that they do not recurr. Both incidents involve rules violations.

The first incident occurred during the October 24, 1979, match between the Rooks and Wheaton College. On board five, Steve Decman of the Rooks faced Tim Leonard of Wheaton. A few Wheaton players were watching late in the game when Decman moved his king, released it, saw that the move dropped a pawn, and quickly moved the king to a better square. Some of the Wheaton observers immediately announced that Decman had to leave the king on the square where he had first released it. As Decman reports the incident, the spectators spoke immediately, giving his opponent no chance to make the objection himself. There is no question that Decman had made a move and then taken it back and that his opponent was legally entitled to demand that he make the first move. But there is also no question that the spectators were interfering in the game, a clear violation of the rules. Article 19.1(a) of the Official Rules of Chess, second edition (page 51) states:

During play the players are forbidden to make use of handwritten or printed matter or to analyze the game on another chessboard; they are also forbidden to have resource to the advice or opinion of a third party, whether solicited or not.

The point of writing about the incident is not to protest the game; Decman ought to have been required to stay with his initial move. On the other hand, he says, the interference so upset his concentration that he blundered away a piece on the following move. League players need to keep in mind that their teammates are on their own during the course of their games. A third party's comment that a piece has been touched is as much a violation of the rules as his recommending a move.

The incident is serious, but forgiveable. It is easily resolved by calling attention to it, educating the offenders and making a simple announcement before a match. Following the incident, I discussed it with Wheaton captain Beryl Price. He understood and agreed to explain the matter to his team members. Issue noted and closed.

The second incident, however, is not so easily forgiven. It occurred during the December 12, 1979, match at Argonne between the Rooks and Amoco. It involves a violation of CICL Policies and Rules by a team captain, resulting from his apparent ignorance of the Rules of Chess. On board four, Steve Decman faced Mike Dee, Amoco's team captain. Decman's time had expired by some six or seven minutes before Dee noticed that the flag had fallen and claimed the win on time. Decman then asked Dee to verify the failure to complete 45 moves by reproducing the game from his scoresheet, a request Decman is entitled to make under the rules. USCF Tournament Rule 17.1 (6) (Official Rules of Chess, second edition, page 42) states in part:

- ... a player loses the game by time-forfeit and his opponent is ruled the winner if the following provisions are satisfied.
- (a) The opponent must have a complete score of the game. (The director may permit up to three incomplete move-pairs if written and also, where possible, oral announcement is made in advance ...) ...
- (b) The opponent must have a scoresheet which is playable (reasonably legible and accurate) in the opinion of the director under his discretionary powers. Individual unplayable moves recorded are counted against the completeness of the move-pair involved. ...
- (c) The opponent's scoresheet, after verification if necessary, must prove that the player whose flag fell had not completed the given number of moves. The player may volunteer his own scoresheet to disprove the opponent's claim. ...

In other words, you can't claim a win on time unless you can prove it with a valid scoresheet.

CICL Policies and Rules, Article II.d.5 states:

The Team Captains are expected to encourage good sportsmanship and proper chess etiquette among their team members. They are responsible for their team members observing the CICL rules and the Laws of Chess.

The matter needs to be discussed openly and dealt with at the next league meeting.

NEAR WEST DIVISION - Dan Kumro

After four rounds, the Argonne Knights is the team to beat! The Knights remain as the only undefeated team (3 - 0) in the Division. The Knights stopped the Chargers in a close match by the score of $3\frac{1}{2}$ - $2\frac{1}{2}$ to take over the lead in the Near-West Division. The Knights were the first team in 18 matches to score $3\frac{1}{2}$ points against the Chargers. (Even the 1978-79 League Champions, Harza Engineering, managed to score only a 3 - 3 tie against the Chargers but won the match on tie-breaking points.)

The Chargers started their undefeated string when they won their three play-off matches to secure the League Title in 1977-78. This was preceded by nine straight wins and a loss to the Argonne Pawns in that season. So, in retrospect, until the night of November 14, 1979, then they lost to the Knights in actual board play, the Chargers ran up a record of 24 wins, 2 draws, and only 1 loss--an enviable record over 2-1/3 seasons.

Also a further explanation about the tie-break system I wrote about in the November Bulletin (#3). I would like to state that a loss, even a playing loss, can never result in scoring more tie-breaking points than a draw. For example, in Section A, if the match result is a 3 - 3 tie then a win counts for 10 tie-break points, and a playing loss two tie-break points, a forfeit loss one tie break point, etc. Also, no negative values will be assigned. After seeing my article in print, I could see that my tie-breaking system wasn't that clear and needed more clarification. Sorry!
