With the emotional tensions that accompany any highly competitive game, guidelines and orderly procedures are needed. CICL Rules of Team Competition should spell out rights of involved players and team captains in case of alleged rule violation during a match. May only the opponent across the board call attention to a rule violation? What is the step by step procedure for on the spot arbitration preliminary to formal protest? Captains Dave Baurac and Michael Dee have each called for help in the last two letters to SOUNDING BOARD.

Ratings Chairman, Paul Weston, has again asked that team captains cooperate in two ways: (1) mail your match results in promptly to your Division Chairman; (2) enter players' names on scoresheets exactly as they are spelled on the computer print-out, even if spelled incorrectly. Corrections must wait until next year.

Here is my answer to the statement made by Dave Baurac, team captain of "Argonne Rooks", which are in part published in C.I.C.L. bulletin #4. I wish that readers of both statements have a chance to make their own impartial judgement in this matter.

As team captain of Amoco C.C. eyewitness and participant in this event, I declare as follows:

On December 12, 1979, playing at Argonne, I faced on board #4 Steve Decman in chess game, the scoresheet of which can be obtained from me upon your request. The game ended in a loss for Decman, who overstepped the time clock after both sides have made 37 moves.

- A. As a team captain he has no right, UNTIL ASKED BY HIS TEAM MEMBER, to enter in any dispute or discussion between two opposing players.
- B. If a player is considered qualified to be a team member he is also qualified to act in his name whenever is necessary. Team captain has a duty to give all instructions to his players before the game, but never to interfere during or after the game as Baurac did. Verification of scoresheets can be done even if Dave Baurac stays at his board, plays his game and says no word.
- C. In last 8 years as C.I.C.L. member and during 2 years as Near West Division Chairman, I never came in conflict with anybody except Dave Baurac and Greg Berry on Dec. 12, 1979.

FAR WEST DIVISION REPORT - J. M. Brozovich

All the results for rounds 6 and 7 are shown elsewhere in the Bulletin with the exception of the ANL Rooks/Kingsmen match. The Kingsmen are on the short end of a $2\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{2}$ score with two games adjourned. It seems extremely unlikely that the Kingsmen will win both of these games.

When this match is completed, the first half of the season will be over and the second half of the round robin will start. Then everyone will have another shot at each other. If the Rooks hold on against the Kingsmen, the division championship will go right down to the wire with the Rooks, Royals, Crusaders and Kingsmen all fighting for play-off berths.

C.I.C.L. RATING PROGRAM NEWS - J. M. Brozovich

In regard to the C.I.C.L. ratings program, the following things have been done since the last Bulletin was published:

1. Brian Smith of the Western Electric Kingsmen was given his USCF rating of 1510 and all his results from the beginning of the year were recalculated. This will only affect Mr. Smith and the people he played and the people who played the people he played, etc.
2. There was a bug in the rating program which resulted in not updating the players' status correctly. This has been corrected. All players should now pass through the stages of # and * correctly.
3. The program that prints out all players in alphabetical order has been corrected to indicate the # and * correctly. This error became apparent in the December Bulletin when there were no players with the # sign after their rating.
4. Finally, players with less than ten games played were eliminated from the top ten in their division. People in the top ten with less than twenty-five games played will now have an asterisk after their rating.
5. The division standings are now calculated along with the ratings so that they are now generated automatically along with all of the other reports. This is one of the reasons that the format of the standings printout has changed with this issue of the Bulletin.

One last comment and suggestion is to inform the League that there are two players in the C.I.C.L. with over two hundred games played. They are Nik Goncharoff (232) and Jim Warren (204). I suggest that the C.I.C.L. establish another award to recognize this amazing achievement. The following list shows all the players who have over 140 games played in the C.I.C.L. and may be eligible for this award in the next five years:

I STRONGLY URGE THE OFFICERS OF THE LEAGUE TO ESTABLISH THIS NEW AWARD CATEGORY TO ACKNOWLEDGE THESE FINE PLAYERS.

The first 2/3 of our schedule, or the easy part, is winding down to a close. We are forced into playing a few extra matches at the end of the season because of the short quantity of teams - seven (7). This will be accomplished with a short 3-round Swiss Team Tournament. Therefore, keeping pace with the schedule is a "must" situation, and I'm hoping we can better the schedule in rounds 8, 9, & 10; that is, try and finish round 7 as early as possible. If we finish a week early, I can revise rounds 8, 9 & 10. In running a Swiss, an odd number of entries always creates a BYE but this is something we must live with and do the best we can with. Please phone me as soon as round 7 results are completed; preferably, the next day. I can be reached at work on 981-2203 or 981-2224; at home my number is 259-4981. Remember we can't start round 8 until I know the results of round 7. After round 7, to start the Swiss, the teams will be ranked as follows: 1st most match points if there is a tie, then the most game points will break the tie. If game points are tied, head-to-head competition will be next in line to break the tie. If after the first three considerations a tie still exists, then the most game points scored will be compared to the teams finishing higher in the standings as follows: tie for 6th & 7th results against teams finishing 1, 2, & 3; this will be the same for teams finishing as high as 4th. If there is a two or more way tie for 3rd, then best results against teams 1 & 2; if a tie for 2nd exists, then results against team 1 will determine the ranking. If a tie still exists, then the system to break play-off ties in the 1978-79 League Championship will prevail. If you have any questions, call me.

As you know, our Swiss will create 3 teams that receive Byes in rounds 8, 9, & 10. These teams will play a special 9 board match in round 11. If all 3 teams wish to participate, (this is to protect all players for the M. V. P. Award). Details in the next Bulletin or so will explain the policies for this match but since 3 teams may be involved, the team with the least number of home matches in head-to-head competition (of the 3 teams involved) will be the home team. Since all the teams could have a home and away against the other two, the team which scores the most game points in both the regular and Swiss rounds will be the home team. If there is a tie involved, the Division Chairman will use other tie breaks to establish the home team (match points, etc.).

At the half-way mark, it looks like a 3-way horse race between the Knights, Chargers & Gambiteers. These three teams are leading the race for the top two spots with a 4-0, 4-1, 2½-1½, respectively. In the remainder of the division, all teams have the equivalent of 3 or more points in the loss column and tabs these teams as dark horses for one of the top two spots. With the entire Swiss portion of our schedule remaining, plus a couple more matches, no team has clinched a play-off spot or been mathematically eliminated from the race since all teams should play 9 matches minimum. Please let me know if you think you have a front-runner from your team that is in the running for the M. V. P. Award.

NORTH DIVISION REPORT - Gee Leong

Excaliburs extended their string to three matches without a loss or a draw! They beat Zenith-Glenview 6-0 and retained the first place in the North Division.

Felpro finally won their first match against Sara Lee after losing fourteen straight. They now have about ten players. I suspect that they will win more than one this year. Remember Seattle and Tampa Bay?

Kemper moved into second place with their win over Teletype I. I honestly cannot say that they deserve it. In their fifth round match against Teletype I they obtained 3.5 points. Of the 3.5 points one was a forfeit and another a gift. In a lost position, the Teletype player gave away a Rook. I guess God favors fools and Patzers.

CHESS LIFE (beginning and highlights):

1. Learned to play chess at age of 10 from schoolmates.
2. Played for 25 years repeating the same mistakes, before learned how to record moves, analyze my own games and utilize chess literature.
3. Have played in CICL continuously since 1958. Recently became first CICL double-centurion (200 games.)
4. Played in first USCF rated tournament in 1960. (One of my opponents in that tournament was Dan Kumro!)
5. Participated in all three U.S. open which were held in Chicago. (1963, 1973 and 1979.)
6. Beat Bobby Fischer (in simultaneous) in 1964.
7. Became Class B Illinois Champion in 1967 and Greater Chicago Class B Champion in 1971.

WHAT I LIKE (don't like, or would change) about the CICL and the Bulletin:

1. I like Bulletin's cover page, people profiles, match results and new rating system, which shows lost or won points after each game.
2. I don't like the play-off system between four divisions. I strongly feel that play-off matches should be played at the same date and place for all finalists. The date and place should be announced three months ahead. Such event could be publicized and it could be an attraction for press and television.

Family: Wife- Adeline; Children- Bart (24), Holly (20)

Hobbies & Special Interests: Chess, collecting chessmen; music, art, film history, watching pro football, hockey, and amateur wrestling; travel; eating in fine restaurants

Chess Life: Took up chess after reading Dr. Ernest Jones' psychological case history of Paul Morphy while living in the New York area in 1954. Early experiences that sparked my interest were watching the U. S. Championship held in the Marshall C.C. in Greenwich Village and witnessing the opening of the team match between the U. S. and the U.S.S.R. at the Roosevelt Hotel in 1954.

Formed my first chess club in 1955 at the Naval Station in Argentia, Newfoundland, and took 2nd place in the base championship tournament. Later served as President of industrial clubs at R. R. Donnelley & Sons, International Minerals & Chemicals (won 2nd place trophy), Sherwin-Williams (won the club championship), DeSoto, and Curtiss Candy. Captained teams from all of these clubs except IMC. Also was a member of the Gompers Park C.C.

Helped organize the Illinois Chess Association and served as its first President in 1961. Elected Vice Pres. in 1962 and served as Treasurer of the ICA in 1975-'76. Created the precursor to the Ill. Chess Bulletin (called it En Passant) in 1961. In 1962, organized (with Arpad Elo) an Illinois vs Wisconsin team match of 35 boards. It was won by Ill., 24½-10½, and K. A. Czerniecki of Alumni Central played third board behind former U. S. Open champion, Al Sandrin, and John Tums.

Acted as Director or Delegate from Ill. in the U. S. Chess Federation (currently Alternate Voting Member) almost every year since 1973. Attended annual U.S.C.F. delegates' meetings at Lincoln, Neb. in 1975 and in Columbus, O. in 1977. Served on the Amateur Affairs Committee of the Federation in 1976. Also participated in Regional meetings held in Milwaukee.

Aside from club and League competition, competed in the Illinois Open Championships of 1961 and 1967 and in the U. S. Open of 1973.

2. Chairman of the League, 1959-'61
3. First League President, 1970; also Pres. in 1973
4. Originator and first Editor of the League Bulletin, 1959

15. Originator of the James E. Warren Awards, 1974
