Time ran out before all ideas were presented and discussed. Some proposals arrived by mail. I have condensed all proposed changes that were submitted in writing under SOUNDING BOARD which hopefully will provide issues to consider before voting on them at the next Business Meeting.

2. Change in Policy I.B.2(a) Requirements for Team Membership:

from: Each team member must be on the payroll
to: Each team member should-be either on the company

well there will only be seven teams in the Far West this year. The Western Electric team from Montgomery dropped out and at one time there was a chance that Argonne would form another team but that fell through so the Far West division will abide by the first schedule sent to the team captains which was the double round robin.

Finally, I have a scouting report on the Far West division teams for the 1979-1980 year.

The Wheaton Crusaders, last year's champions, will probably be somewhat weaker than they were last year because three of the starters graduated last June. However, Beryl Price is out looking for some promising freshman so its still possible that they may come up with another championship team.

The second place finishers, the Argonne Pawns, look about the same as last year with most of their starting lineup returning for another year. They may pick up some strong players on the lower boards as a result of the demise of the fourth Argonne team this year.

The Argonne Rooks will be strengthened by the acquisition of the perennial expert Jim Jackson from their former Near West team. The Rooks tied for second place last year and it looks like they will be a lot tougher this year with the addition of some of the players from their former Near West team.

The Amoco team surprised a lot of teams last year on route to posting their first winning season in a long time. Unfortunately for Amoco, their 1978-79 most valuable player, Dave Dyck no longer works for Amoco and so they will have to groom a new MVP to take his place. I nominate that sneaky old ringer, Dr. Richard Lee.

The Western Electric Kingsmen struggled to a 3 - 4 - 3 record last year but things should improve for the Kingsmen in 1979-80. The Kingsmen acquired some of the starters from the former Montgomery team and also hired some new chess-playing employees in the past year. The Kingsmen may surprise more than a few people this year.

The BTL Royals did not have one of their better years in 1978-79. However, they can still field one of the toughest teams in the division if they get all their top players out. Peter Hoppner is their new captain this year and I'll bet he gets his best players out when he needs them this year.

Fermi Labs looks about the same as last year although its difficult to contact all those guys when they're chasing quarks and gluons around their accelerator all the time. I'll bet they're secretly planning for this year in the CICL.

For the first time in my career as division chairman I am going to go out on a limb and predict the new champion of the Far west Division for the 1979-1980 season....The Western Electric Kingsmen. Good luck to all and may the best team win.

# East Division Report by Tom Gaffigan

The East Division has lost two teams and added three teams for the 1979-80 season. Unfortunately, GATX Corporation is unable to field a team this year. Also, Sears has elected to have only one team. However, these losses have been offset by the addition of a second team from Harza Engineering, the defending league champion, and two other new teams, Combustion Engineering, Inc. and Swift & Co.

# Near West Division Report by Dan Kumro\*

Unfortunately, the Near West has dropped from 9 teams to 7. Our division has lost the Argonne Bishops and also Zenith-Rauland. However, the Argonne Chess Club could easily go from three back to four teams next year as the club has fluctuated in team strength before. Zenith-Rauland is hoping to return next year and a strong recruitment drive could accomplish a comeback. As we take the summer dust off the chess pieces, we don't have very much data on other \*\*sexxiboskxxbasbaspersonnel changes in the league or if we have any new strong players in our division. However, after a couple of rounds are completed, more information should be available to spot strong contenders in our division. Also, there may be a schedule change for rounds 8,m9, and 10. If there is, it will appear before the end of the calendar year.

#### Chicago Industrial Chess League Meeting of August 23, 1979 Minutes

- The meeting was called to order at Albright Gymnasium of Western Bleetric by president Gee Leong. The minutes of the Spring business meeting were approved as published in the CICL Bulletin.
- 2. A financial report covering the 1978-1979 season, as well as a proposed budget for the forthcoming 1979-1980 season, were presented by outgoing treasurer Doug Anderson. The League showed a profit of \$83 for the last season, after covering anticipated deficits for the USCP Tornado and the annual awards banquet. The budget for the coming year was based on Anderson's recommendation of no changes in the League dues structure. After some discussion it was agreed that this recommendation would be accepted, withhonly one field fication: that the banquet assessment be increased from \$7.00 to \$10.00 per team. (This assessment is credited toward purchases of tickets to the annual awards banquet.) Team dues would then remain at \$20.00 per team, and the bulletin subscriptions at \$7.00 per company for the first, required copy and \$3.00 each for additional copies.
- 3. New team memberships were then considered. Dave Haley of Combustion Engineering appeared to request approval of a new team located in the Loop area. This request was approved. Frank Tegel requested approval of a second team from Teletype, to be captained by Harry Sue. This was also approved. Finally, Miro Stevanovic requested approval of a second team from Harza Engineering, for which a captain will be named later. This request was also approved. In the cases of both the Teletype and Harza second teams, the new teams would be relatively weak romoafed to the existing teams.
- 4. Ken Kellogg of Argonne presented a request that three individuals who are Argonne consultants but not employees be allowed to play on an Argonne team during the oming season. These consultants have worked a majority of their time over the past several years, and approval of their playing status would be the only way that the fourth Argonne team could continue in the League. After some discussion, this request was agreed to unanimously, but continue that these individuals could play only if a fourth Argonne team could in fact be organized.
- 5. Frank Tegel requested that Hugh Wheeler be allowed to play on the Teletype teams. Hugh has been working full time at Teletype for the last six months, and this situation will continue indefinitely. It was agreed to approve Wheeler's participation on Teletype's teams as long as his work assignment there continues.
- 6. It was announced that the Western Electric-Montgomery team would be dropping out of the Far West Division. Other ouestionable teams were I.T.T. and the fourth Argonne team.

- 7. Lee Stensaker requested approval for alumni participation of three former CICL players: Jim Sullivan, Joe Ampulski, and George Dobbins. This was approved unanimously.
- 8. Joe Brozovich reminded team captains that the CICL rules require that the rosters of multiple-team company teams be provided to the League prosident and the division chairman prior to the first match of the season. However, no more than six names per team need be specified at this time.
- 9. Tom Gaffigan presented several proposals for conducting the post-season championship playoffs. After considerable discussion, it was agreed to adopt a three-round Swiss system playoff involving the top two finishers from each division. The details of this proposal (denoted Proposal #1) as amended during the discussion are attached to these minutes.
- 10. Tom also presented severa: proposals for resolving drawn divisional playoff matches. (These result from ties in the final divisional standings involving trochies, which are resolved by special playoff matches.) The final proposal which was accepted was as follows: "In the event that a divisional playoff match ends in a tie, the winner will be the team which had accumulated the most game points during regular season play. If these points are equal, the tie will be resolved by the result of the regular season meeting(s) between the two teams. If these were drawn on the basis of team match points, the tie will be broken on the basis of game points scored in the head-to-head match(es). If still tied, the tie will be resolved by a coin flip."
- 11. The problem of teams failing to provide an adequate number of chess sets for home matches was discussed. It was agreed that team captains should report occurrences of this on the protest portion of the match results sheet. Division chairmen were to award forfeits at their discretion in the case of repeated failures to provide sets as provided in the CICL Policies and Rules. Requesting the opposition team to bring sets was not an adequate manner of fulfilling the home team's responsibility under the rules.
- 12. It was proposed that three League championship trophies be awarded. This was defeated by a vote of 11-10.
- 13. The question of charging for advertising in the CICL Bulletin was discussed again. It was agreed that the issue was unimportant, and there was no further discussion of it.
- 14. Gee Leong asked whether the League was in favor of repeating the simultaneous match with the Church's Fried Chicken touring master, similar to last year's simul with Larry Christiansen. The response of the meeting was positive, and Gee will look into making the arrangements.

- -5. It was agreed that no player could participate in the League championship playoffs unless he had participated in at least one regular-season match with his team.
- 16. Frank Tegel suggested that the method of selecting each division's most valuable player be altered for the coming season, but in view of the lateness of the hour it was agreed to defer discussion of this until a later time, perhaps at the spring business meeting.
- 17. As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

Addendum to minutes of 8/23/79 meeting re. pars. #9

Playoff Proposal #1 as amended and officially passed.

That the League Championship Playoff be a three round Swiss system tournament in which the participating teams will be the two trophy winning teams form each Division.

The team ratings for pairing purposes will be based upon their match points during the regular season playing achedule. weighted to take into consideration differences in the number of matches played. In the event of a tie in match points, the tim will be resolved by same points during the regular season playing schedule, weighted to take into consideration differences in the number of matches played. In the event a tie still exists, it will be resolved by an appropriate chance or lot method as determined by the League President or his delegate responsible for supervising the playoff tournament.

Pairings will be based upon team ratings, except that matching of teams from the same division in the first round will be avoided.

The home team in the playoffs will be the higher rated team if both teams have had an equal number of chances to be the home team in the playoff tournament. Otherwise the team with the fewer number of home team matches will be the home team.

It is mandatory that all teams complete the three round schedule unless, in the third round, both teams playing each other in a match have been mathematically eliminated from contention for a trophy.

League Championship trophy winning teams will be determined by match points in the championship Swiss tournament. In the event of a tie in match points, the tie will be resolved by game points in the championship Swiss tournament. If still tied, the tie will be resolved by the result of the headto -- head match between the two teams during the playoff rounds, if any. In the event of a tie still existing, duplicate awards will be given.
