From The President Desk

The CICL summer business meeting held last August decided that the League should change the way that the Playoffs were held.

Dave Baurac of the Argonne Rooks presented a proposal that the league Championship matches all be played on a single designated day in Spring. After considerable discussion, it was agreed that the first round of the playoffs would be played by arrangement between the two teams during the first two weeks of May. The final two round of the playoffs would be played on the third Saturday of May at a common location. This proposal was passed with only one dissenting vote.

Ruben Reyes of the Sears Roebuck (East Division) team has written me to voice some objections. Ruben has stated that he will not be able to field a team for any match that is played on a Saturday. Ruben has indicated that he feels very strongly on the matter and that if the league insists on playing the matches on Saturday, they may withdraw from the League.

The league decided to play matches on Saturday for the following reasons.

- To increase the possibility of getting some kind of press coverage.
- To make it easier for non-participants to see the CICL playoffs.
- Complete the season a little earlier so that the awards dinner can be held in early June rather than late June.

I find it hard to agree with Ruben's contention that an older person would get tired playing two games of chess in one day. Is it easier to work an eight hour day and then play chess?.

Ruben Reyes's letter is printed on the next two pages. I have decided that this question of how the playoffs are run should be put to the entire league.

I am asking that the team captains call your division chairman to let them know if you are for playoff matches being held on a Saturday or if the old format of arranging matches is more desirable. I will call the Division Chairmen on the 20th of November to collect the votes. Remember, only votes that are called in to the Division Chairmen will be counted.

I will let you know the final decision in the next Bulletin.

Dear Mr. Gee Leong:

By scheduling the 2nd and 3rd round of the CIGL playoffs in a single day and on a Saturday, the CIGL is, by the result of its action, kicking Sears out of the playoffs.

It seems to me that it is unfair to indirectly prevent a team in good standing and which has been in the CIGL for a long time such as Sears from participation in the playoffs even if such team qualify for one of two seats to this important event in the East Division.

The CIGL is indirectly preventing Sears from competing in this important event because Sears finds that it cannot field more than one or two players in a whole day and a Saturday event.

The two characteristics - whole day and Saturday - of the playoff schedule for the 2nd and 3rd round combine together to prevent myself and my teammates from participation in the CIGL finale.

It seems to me that the basis for the participation of many teams in the CIGL regular rounds is the flexibility of the CIGL schedule. By removing the flexibility inherent in the CIGL playing schedule for the playoffs, the CIGL is tantamount to discriminating against:

- \* Non-christian players who cannot play on any and all Saturdays.
- \* Older players who cannot compete on equal footing based on physical/mental stamina requirements of a marathon chess event. (Ages 50 - 65)
- \* Married chess players, particularly those with children and whose wives work on Saturdays.
- \* CIGL members who have prior commitments for Saturday. For example doing humanitarian or volunteer work on Saturdays.
- \* CIGL members who have activities of much higher priority than chess.

The CIGL, it seems to me, is negating the very basis upon which many teams are able to participate in the regular rounds: flexibility of the playing schedule. What the CIGL is actually telling some teams is this: LOOK, YOU CAN PLAY IN THE REGULAR ROUNDS. BUT YOU CANNOT PLAY IN THE PLAYOFFS.


THE PLAYOFFS IS RESERVED ONLY FOR Christians, professional weekend USCF tournament players, single players, etc. IF you are not a Christian, etc. YOU CANNOT PLAY IN THE PLAYOFFS.

And this, it seems to me, is deplorable.

Rule I(A) of the C.I.C.L. Rules and Policies says in part:

"The policy of the C.I.C.L. is to encourage (not discourage) employees of such concern to enter teams in League competition and to promote maximum (not minimum) participation in chess by members of these teams (such as Sears).# - parenthesis are my comments.

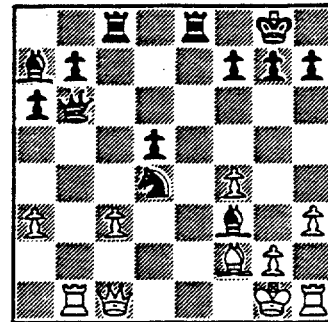

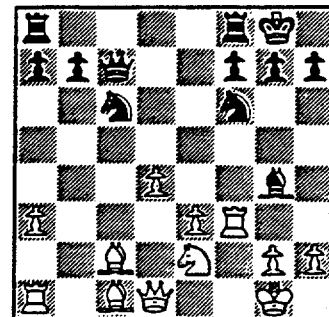

In the 1920s, '30s and '40s, the Dragon Variation was one of the most highly regarded lines of the Sicilian Defence. But in the 1950s, Yugoslav players subjected to close analysis a line introduced in 1936 by Rauser, and produced an anti-Dragon attack that was so strong it could be played almost mechanically. The Yugoslav Attack nearly put the Dragon out of business. In recent years, however, a few grandmasters have revived the Dragon, and with their improvements, it is once again devouring opponents. Here are two games by Ken Miles of England that feature two of the improvements that have given the Dragon new teeth:
