White: B. McNeil, Motorola (CICL 2124)  
Black: M. Siwek, Kemper (CICL 1866)

The Captain of our chess team at Kemper, Norm Hughes, asked for a copy of the following game and suggested that we send it in for publication. While I don't claim to know all the moves, I thought it might be helpful and perhaps instructive if I annotated it by documenting my thoughts during the game. After all, it's not very often that you beat the third-ranked player in the whole CICL. Bruce McNeil is a very fine player, a fact he amply demonstrated to me during our first encounter last year, and perhaps the best way to describe this game is to say that I was fortunate.

### 1 P-K4, P-QB3

I don't usually play the Caro-Kahn, but I have adopted it on occasion, and I figured that this was as good an opportunity as any to trot it out. Black gets a solid, though somewhat drawish position, and against a much higher-rated player, that'll do just fine.

### 2 P-Q4, P-Q4 3 PXP

A surprise. I didn't know if McNeil was going to follow this up with the Exchange Variation (3... PXP 4 B-Q3, N-QB3 5 P-QB3, N-B3 6 B-KB4, etc.) or the Panov-Botvinnik Attack. After a slight transposition, he chooses the latter.

### 3... PXP 4 N-KB3, N-KB3 5 P-B4, N-B3 6 N-B3, P-K3

Tartakower opines that this is the "most level-headed course," and no less an authority than Bobby Fischer agrees with him. The main alternative is 6... B-N5 7 PXP, KNXP when 8 B-QN5, R-QB1 9 P-KR3, BxN 10 QxB, P-K3 seems fine for Black, but 8 Q-N3, BxN 9 PxB is a little tougher to meet; Fischer's already demonstrated (against Euwe in the 1960 Leipzig Olympic) that 9... P-K3 10 QxP, NXP 11 B-N5ch, NxB 12 Q-B6ch, K-K2 13 QxQN isn't exactly appealing, and 9... N-N3 10 P-Q5, N-Q5 11 Q-Q1, N-B4 12 B-N5ch, N-Q2 doesn't strike my fancy either. However, besides the text, 6... P-KN3 also seems playable.

### 7 P-B5

Though this is a "book" move (see Modern Chess Openings), I don't care for it. White's idea is to apparently set up a Queen-side majority, when as Fine puts it, "Black must break up or weaken the White Pawn formation with ... P-QN3. If White can hold his Pawns in such cases without allowing the crippling break ... P-K4 or cramping himself so much that Black gets adequate counterplay, he gets the better of it. However, unless White plays very precisely, I don't believe he can maintain his Pawn structure: if P-QN4 (after ... P-QN3), Black can strike back with ... P-QR4, and of course ... P-K4 is also always a threat. Watch how both ideas surface during the game.

As for White alternatives, I expected 7 B-N5, to which I intended 7... B-K2 8 B-Q3, PXP 9 BxBP, O-O with about equal chances. Since White doesn't want to develop his King Bishop just yet (e.g. 7 B-Q3, PXP 8 BxBP, P-QR3 9 O-O, B-K2 10 B-B4, O-O leading into what appears to be an acceptable variation of the Queen's Gambit Accepted), the other alternative seems to be 7 PXP, KNXP 8 B-Q3, B-K2 9 O-O, O-O 10 R-K1, B-B3 with play against the isolated QP.

### 7... B-K2

7... N-K5 is also an option, with play continuing 8 B-QN5, Q-R4 9 Q-N3, B-Q2 10 O-O, B-K2.

8 B-Q3

A new move? Usual is 8 B-QN5, B-Q2 (8... O-O 9 BxN, PxB 10 B-N5, N-K5 11 BxB, Qx3 12 O-O, NxN 13 PxN leads to White's advantage) > O-O, O-O when 10 P-QR3 is probably best, though most opening tomes cover 10 R-K1, P-QR3 11 B-Q3.

8... O-O > P-QR3, Q-B2 10 Q-K2

To prevent ... P-K4, but now ... P-QR4 will be played. See the note to White's seventh move. Interesting, but probably a waste of time, is 10 N-QN5.

10... P-QR4 11 N-QR4

This, however, is a waste of time. The threat of N-N6 is easily parried, and not only that, but by withdrawing his King Knight to Q2, Black puts even more emphasis on the freeing ... P-K4, not to mention ... P-QN3. Better are 7 O-O and 7 B-KN5.

11... N-Q2 12 B-KN5

Either McNeil overlooked my reply, or else underestimated its strength. 12 O-O is indicated.

12... NxQP 13 BxPch, K-R1 14 NxN, BxB 15 P-R4, B-R3 16 B-N1

Apparently angling for the cheap mate at KR7, but the Calvary (the Black Knight; comes to the rescue just in time. I think 16 B-B2 is better.

16... NxP 17 Q-B2

White gets better drawing chances with 17 N-N5, Q-B5 18 NxN, Q-B8ch 19 Q-Q1, QxN 20 Q-B2, QxQ 21 BxQ, etc.

17... Q-K4ch 18 K-B1, N-K5 19 N-KB3, Q-Q3 20 N-N5, B-Q2 21 N-QB3

21 BxN, PxN 22 QxP?, Q-Q8ch 23 Q-K1, B-N4ch 24 K-N1, QxQch and Mate is unavoidable on KB3; e.g. 25 K-R2, B-B5ch 26 P-N3, QxPch 27 K-R3, QxP or 26 K-R3, QxP and Mate next move.

21... Q-B5 22 N3xN, PxN 23 NxKP, QR-B1 24 N-B3, Q-B8ch

Though material is momentarily even, the awkward placement of White's pieces will soon change that. I thought the text was more than sufficient.

25 QxQ, BxQ 26 N-K2

26 R-R2, BxP 27 RxB, RxN.

26... B-QN4

The attack continues, eventually winning material and forcing exchanges.

27 K-K1, KR-Q1 28 B-R2

More active is 28 B-K4, BxP 29 R-QN1, BxN 30 KxB, BxP 31 RxP.

28... BxNP 29 R-Q1, RxRch 30 KxR, BxNch 31 KxB, R-B7ch 32 K-B3, B-Q5 33 K-K4, BxB

34 KxB, RxRP 35 R-QN1

I overlooked this move, or else I would have played 31... BxP or 32... BxP. After all, two connected passed pawns are better than one! However, in fairness to both players, McNeil was in a little bit of time trouble, and I was trying to help him out by playing "blitz." That might explain some of the last few moves and also

some of those that follow.

35... R-R7 36 P-B3, RXP 37 RXP, P-B3 38 R-R7, R-QR7 39 K-B5, P-K1 40 K-Q6, P-R5  
41 K-K6, R-R8 42 K-B7, P-R6 43 K-B8, P-R7 44 RXP, R-QN8 45 R-N8ch, K-R2 46 R-N7ch,  
46... K-R3 47 Resigns

White has run out of checks.

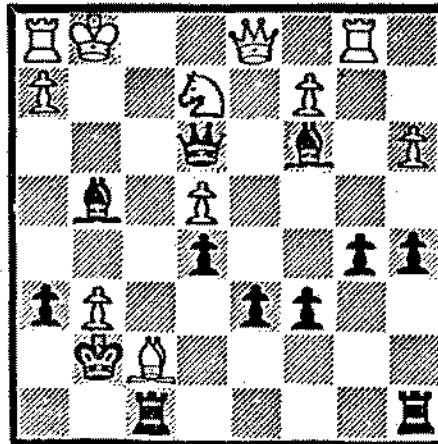
