Chess Match: Champion Sleepwalks

Anatoly Karpov sleepwalked his way to a loss in the 47th game of his world chess championship match with Gary Kasparov in Moscow on Wednesday. The 33-year-old titleholder saw his lead in the series cut back to 5-2.

Since Nov. 24, when he won the 27th game, Karpov has needed one more victory to retain his championship. However, his 21-year-old challenger has refused to collapse, taking the 32d game and now this 47th.

This second victory does not put Kasparov back in contention — his opponent can afford to lose three more games in the quest for the single decision he requires. Yet, if it is fatigue that has overtaken the champion, then Kasparov's task can no longer be considered out of reach.

2 Unheralded Twists

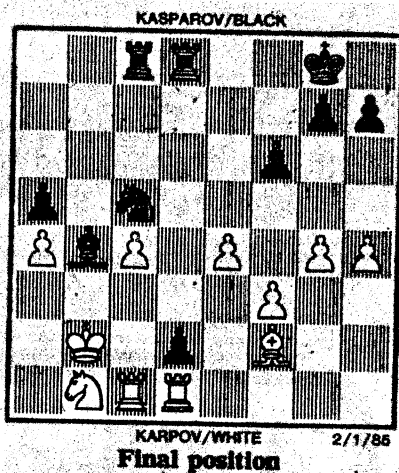
The opening play of this 47th encounter featured two unheralded twists. Whereas Karpov had used the solid 5 P-K3 in the 29th and 33d encounters — as he has throughout his career — he shifted here to the aggressive Anti-Meran Gambit with 5 B-N5. The mind boggles at the amount of quick cramming and heavy analysis such a change required. At any rate, this obscure adventure was quite out of character, but by now one may imagine that he would attempt anything that offered a remote promise of winning.

And it all went for naught — Kasparov slyly steered the game into the Cambridge Springs Defense with 6 ... Q-R4. Such a turn must have come as an enormous surprise to Karpov; not only had Kasparov never shown any interest in this defense, he demolished it several times in his final candidates match with Vasily Smyslov in Vilnius, in the Soviet Lithuanian Republic, last April.

Of course, Smyslov had relied on 8 ... B-N5?! instead of the superior 8 ... N/2-N3 that Kasparov used in this game. Karpov seemed to have been totally unprepared for it, for otherwise it would be difficult to account for his timid 9 NxN, QxQch; 10 NxQ, which indicated that he did not care for the way things were going and intended to take the day off.

Playing 12 P-QR4?! meant White would never be able to set in motion the minority attack that required, albeit after long preparation, P-QR3, P-QN4, and P-QN5. Besides — and much more serious — the move left weak squares in the white queenside.

After 18 ... KR-K1, the white king was placed where it could easily be molested, and the white knight was ineffectual and difficult to relocate.



Kasparov's opening of the center with 19 ... P-QB4! brought White's sufferings to light. This was not a true pawn sacrifice since 20 PxP, N-Q2; 21 P-B6, PxP; 22 RxP? is refuted by 22 ... N-K4ch.

Karpov made sure, with 22 P-B6, PxP, to close the QB file so he could use his king to defend his QNP after 23 KR-Q1, N-B4ch; 24 K-B2.

Perhaps Karpov should have tried 27 R-Q3 to meet 27 ... P-QB4 by 28 R/1-Q1.

After 27 ... P-QB4, the champion should have tried to sap some of the strength of the black center by 28 P-K4. Instead, he played 28 N-Q2?! as though unaware of the danger.

Kasparov's breakthrough with 28 ... P-B5!; 29 PxP, N-B4! caught the white pieces awkwardly situated. Karpov could not capture with 30 PxP? because of 30 ... N-K5ch.

Had he played 30 N-N1 — which might have been his best — then 30 ... PxP; 31 RxRch, RxR; 32 R-Q1, RxR; 33 KxR, NxP thrusts White into a pawn-down ending.

However, his 30 P-K4?! let Kasparov use his QP for attack with 30 ... P-Q5! Now Karpov had to try 31 R-QR1, but he blundered with 31 N-N1? and after 31 ... P-Q6ch; 32 K-N2, P-Q7! discovered that he had to drop a rook. For example, 33 R-B3 (or 33 R-B2, N-Q6ch; 34 K-N3, NxR), NxPch; 34 K-N3, NxR; 35 NxN, R-Q6. The champion gave up.

The 48th game is set for 5 P.M. today in Moscow.
