 Meeting Of August 24, 1984
 First National Bank, Chicago

1. The meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by acting president Fred Ciba II. Fred immediately called for the election of a new CICL president. Tim Kras nominated Russ Rzeszutko; Ray Fabijonas seconded the motion. Russ was elected unanimously. Fred continued to run the meeting with Russ help.
2. Secretary Fred Ciba II passed out job description forms that were inadvertently not distributed at the awards banquet. Any member of the CICL may volunteer for a number of available positions. In light of Russ Rzeszutko's election to the presidency, it would be most beneficial to the CICL if his old job of publicity chairman was filled by a new man. A volunteer is needed.
3. Treasurer Jim Brotsos gave a detailed report on the state of our CICL finances. It was pointed out that we did better in 1983-84 than 1982-83 because we didn't have a costly computer expense and our dues brought in more money to the treasury. Marty Franek was congratulated on keeping the cost of the bulletin down during his tenure as bulletin editor. Jim also mentioned that the banquet was "a bit of a bust" because fewer teams than predicted attended (we lost \$92.65). Jim's four page summary is available through your team's captain. However, here is a breakdown of this years dues.....

basic dues per team	\$33
banquet meal guarantee	17

Remember the payment deadline is 12/1/84. If you pay afterwards there is a \$5 penalty; after 1/1/85 there is a \$10 penalty.

Charley Ward made a motion that the report be approved as is. Dan Kumro seconded. The motion passed 17 in favor, 3 opposed.

4. The minutes of the spring 1984 meeting were referred to. (Distributed to all teams in the May, 1984 bulletin). Jim Brotsos made a motion that the minutes be approved as is; seconded by Dan Kumro. Passed unanimously.
5. During old business Wes Underwood of the far west division passed out a written proposal that would change the ruling on player eligibility. Wes was seeking to liberalize the requirements for CICL membership. A lengthy discussion followed. While it was generally agreed that a change in the current wording was necessary, no one definition of what an eligible player should be was agreed upon until Tom Gaffigan suggested the following....

"IB2(A) Each team member must be on the payroll of the organization which they will represent, or must have a normal daily work routine that finds him primarily on the site of the organization which they will represent, or must work primarily based out of the organization which they will represent, or must be a former team member retired or laid off after a minimum of one year of service."

....The above was also discussed at length. So much discussion took place, in fact, that Wes Underwood made a motion that the discussion's should formally end and the matter be voted on. Charley Ward seconded. That passed unanimously. The proposal itself was then voted on and passed 18 in favor, 1 opposed.

Wes Underwood's "Proposal B" was voted on to be tabled and studied unanimously.

Wes Underwood's "Proposal C" was voted on and passed unanimously. It reads thusly....

"IC2(B) Division chairmen are responsible for acting as arbitrator in handling disputes or protests. He may rule on any disputable matter within his division in any way he sees fit that may then stand until the matter is settled by the league vote at the next business meeting."

6. During new business Jim Brotsos suggested that we should consider paying our tornado tournament director's a fee. In the past we've utilized the talents of Ray Fabijonas without rewarding him financially. Wes Underwood made a motion that we study the matter and Frank Micklich seconded it. It was voted upon in favor unanimously. Charley Ward will do the study.

The possibility of some new teams in our league was discussed. Publicity chairman Russ Rzeszutko reported that the Loop College, Roosevelt University and the University of Illinois, Chicago Circle might be joining the CICL. Russ will confirm their interest.

Ray Fabijonas lead an open discussion on the possibility of merging teams that might co-exist in a single building. (In the event that one company could not field a full six man team). Jim Brotos quashed further discussions by pointing out that this was tried years ago and failed. The matter was dismissed unanimously.

Dave O'Dell made a motion that the meeting be closed. Thad Soprych second it and it was passed unanimously.

Fred Ciba II and Russ Rzeszutko closed the meeting at 9:23 p.m.
