Chicago Industrial Chess League
Meeting of April 15, 1986
Amoco Labs., Naperville

1. The meeting was called to order by CIGL president Bruce McNeil at 7:12 p.m.
2. Secretary Fred Ciba read the minutes from the September, 1985 meeting. They were approved as written.
3. In Jim Brotsos, our treasurers absence, Bruce McNeil read a brief report on our financial state of affairs. We have \$2,554 in savings and \$98 in checking. Our computer sinking fund is \$900.
4. Bruce McNeil questioned the status of the computerization of the Rules and Regulations of the CIGL that was to be formulated by Fred Ciba and Frank Tegel. He was advised that it is still in the preparatory stages.
5. There was a short discussion on the need for CIGL publicity. Russ Rzeszutko is our Publicity Chairman. In his absence, members had suggestions that Bruce McNeil was to pass on to Russ. They are - a special mailing to USCF members, hand bills at tournaments, posters on company bulletin boards, advertising in the ICB and USCF magazines. It was generally agreed that we need more teams in the CIGL, especially the East division.
6. Wes Underwood, bulletin editor, announced that the bulletin was costing less to produce because he is using a smaller type size and he is printing back-to-back (thereby reducing the number of pages necessary). Wes expressed concern that only a few people are contributing chess articles or interesting games. If he is to continue as bulletin editor he would like to see more participation.
7. Dan Kumro pointed out that the Centurian Chairman's job remains vacant since he retired from it last year. He agreed to return to the position until a replacement is found. (Call Bruce McNeil if interested).
8. Wes Underwood spoke of the simultaneous exhibition chess match with Arthur Bisguier. 24 players paid to play, 23 played. 18 lost, 3 drew, 2 won. Wes collected \$309 as entry fees but had to pay \$325 to Bisguier. A motion was made to reimburse Wes for the \$16 difference. It was seconded and, passed unanimously. Everyone agreed the match was a success.

9. In Jim Warren's absence, Bruce McNeil spoke of the banquet to be held on June 13, 1986. More information will be following in the form of a personal invitation from Jim and a notice in the bulletin.

10. Bruce McNeil announced that the next CIGL business meeting will be August 15th.

11. New business discussions revealed the following... Jim Brotsos is resigning as CIGL treasurer. A replacement is needed for the 1986-87 season... Dave Baurec is resigning as near west chairman, replacement needed... Wes Underwood is resigning as far west chairman, replacement needed... Steve Healy is to develop a CIGL Tornado; mid - July is being considered as a play date.

12. The next order of business was the determination of the CIGL playoffs for the 1985-86 season. Dan Kumro gave a verbal history of playoffs going back to when a central location and one date was originally proposed, defeated, re-evaluated, then passed. Prior to that time all playoffs had been weekday evenings. Discussions followed concerning the merits of the one evening, one day playoff for three rounds versus the three evening procedure. Bruce McNeil called for a preference vote; of the 8 eligible teams here is the tabulation...

one evening, one Saturday = 6 teams in favor
three evenings = 1 team in favor
1 team was unrepresented

By a unanimous vote it was declared that the first round would be played between May 1st and May 16th. The 2nd and 3rd rounds would be played on May 17th. Amoco Labs in Naperville will be approached to be our host again. Dave Burian and Bob Stoltz will direct the playoffs.

13. The following alumni players were voted into the CIGL - Lynn Crewse, Ned Corron, Paul Peterson, Russ Rzeszutko, Dave Wirtschafter and Gene Ashanka.

14. President Bruce McNeil adjourned the meeting at 8:30 p.m.

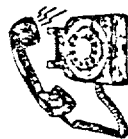

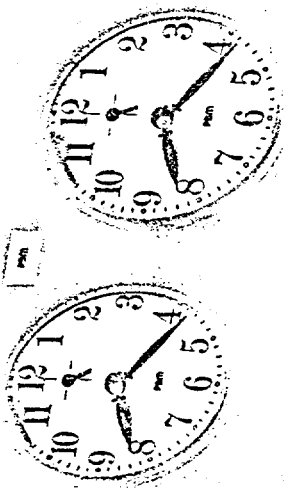
