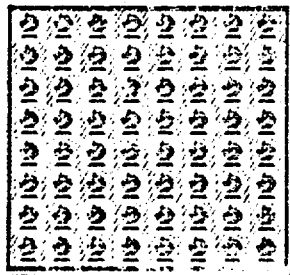

Welcome to the chess players of the 1985-1986 season!

Please note the following changes:

- (1) Dues have been raised. Please be prompt in remitting them.
- (2) Last year forfeits were frequent. Teams with a forfeit problem will be under scrutiny.
- (3) The format of the playoffs will be determined in late April, by a vote of the teams qualifying for the playoffs. The choices are between the format of last year or a 3 round match with one round per week scheduled at the home team's venue on a weeknight.

JOIN THE U.S. CHESS FEDERATION!

CICL members are encouraged to join the U.S. Chess Federation. Because the CICL is a USCF affiliate, our members can join or renew membership at a discount.

Membership in the USCF includes a subscription to Chess Life, one of the world's best chess magazines. It also allows members to play in USCF-rated tournaments and to earn a nationally recognized rating. There is a USCF-rated tournament scheduled almost every week somewhere in the Chicago area, ranging from the Illinois championship down to small local tournaments. USCF members can also purchase books and equipment at discount prices.

One year's USCF membership is \$21.00 for CICL members (this includes the \$4.00 discount). To join, send a check, made out to the U.S. Chess Federation, to: Charles Ward, 615 S. Lincoln St., Hinsdale IL 60521. Be sure to include your full mailing address, including ZIP code. If you are renewing your membership, please also include your membership number and expiration date (printed on the Chess Life mailing label) or, if you are not currently a member, the approximate expiration date of the earlier membership.

I will forward your check to the USCF along with a letter certifying that you qualify for the discount. I will also send you a receipt that will serve as a temporary membership card until your permanent card arrives from the USCF.
