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CICL ALL-STAR MATCH

The first (in a long while at least) CICL All-Star Match will take place in November and December. The matches will be contested using 10 counting boards, with many of the strongest players in each division taking part.

Round 1 will pit the Far West Division against the Near West Division at Wheaton College on Wednesday, November 12th, at 7 PM. The East and North Divisions will also compete on November 12th, at a site yet to be determined.

Round 2 will match up the two surviving teams in a battle for the championship during the first week of December.

There will be opportunity for extra boards to play if desired. Players of any rating strength are welcome to come and play an exhibition rated game during the match. Spectators are also welcome.

10 years ago the Argonne Knights defeated Zenith-Rauland 4 to 2 (in Rd. one) and eventually won the N.W. Division Championship and then went on to defeat the 1st National Bank $3\frac{1}{2}$ - $2\frac{1}{2}$ to capture the CICL League Championship. This was the first year ('76-77) of the concept of the 6-man teams comprised of 4 divisions. That team consisted of C. Young, G. Berry, C. Ward (now BTL), B. Nelson, G. Kinsella and B. Keig.

20 years ago Jim Warren started the CICL rating system that is still in use today.

Also, the Argonne Knights won the 8-man team League Championship with a perfect match score - 11 wins NO losses and NO DRAWS. Undefeated & Untied!!

- (1) Not only has black allowed white's 11th move, but even the simple 11. Bxd4 wins a pawn. 11. ... Qxd4 fails to 12. Bxh7+!, winning the black queen.
- (2) 20. Rfe1 is probably better. The next series of moves by black give him a position with chances!
- (3) Not 23. Qxd4 Bc5!
- (4) Black is gaining compensation for his material minus.
- (5) Black has done very well to generate this position!
- (6) Here begins an endgame analysis that could be pretty complex!
- (7) White wins a pawn, but has allowed the black king to gain a superior position in the center.
- (8) Oops!
