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A RESPONSE

The following question was raised concerning the legality of publishing positions and analysis discussed in Irving Chernev's Winning Chess Traps:

"Publication in the CIGL bulletin of material lifted from a chess book invites a copyright infringement suit unless prior permission has been obtained."

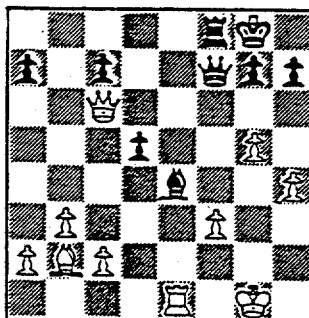
After consultation with the CIGL publicity director, Russ Rzeszutko, and his legal counsel, I have been advised that the CIGL is not at any legal risk as a result of publishing such material. The CIGL is a non-profit organization and the CIGL bulletin is a not-for-profit publication. Therefore, should any author or publisher object to our "lifting" of their material, the worst possible result would be a 'cease and desist' letter. (Of course, should I receive such a letter, I would indeed cease and desist). However, our legal expert advises us that, especially since the CIGL is a non-profit organization and providing free exposure for their publication, it is improbable that any legal action would be taken.

The question of possible copyright infringement was brought up by a league member who is not currently a league officer. If any of the league officers have a reaction to either his question or my response, I am very interested in hearing from you.

Analysis of Suerth-Cox (played 5-18-87, published Oct. 1988) by Ruben Reyes:



After 25...Q-KB2!! in the game F. Suerth-Marvin Cox there seems no way for White to save himself. In the actual game White tried 26. R-KB1 and lost.

But after 25...Q-KB2!! White had a surprising and resourceful key move which gave him a very strong fighting chance.

The key move is 26. B-KB6!?

The question mark after the exclamation point is my way of saying that the move may not be fool-proof.

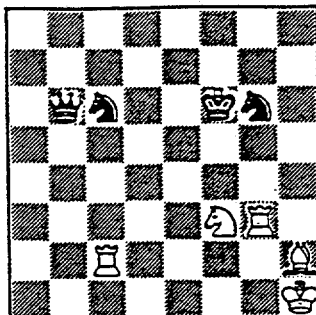
Here's some of the things that justify the "!" - I gave 26.B-KB6.

- 1> 26....BxKBP 27.R-K7 Q-N3 28.Q-K6ch K-R1 29.P-4-R5! is a killer.
- 2> 26...PxB 27..PxB Q-R4 28.Q-K6ch K-R1 29.Q-B5 ZxRP 30.R-KB1 and White is in good shape despite the seemingly exposed King. Black's Rook and Queen can't coordinate because the Rook is tied to the defense of the KBP (i.e. .30...R-KN1 31.QxPch and mate in three 31.Q-Q8ch 32.Q-Q4ch 33.R-B8 mate or four 31.Q-Q8ch 32.QxQ 33.Q-K5ch 34.R-B8 mate> while the Queen is unable to do perpetual check.
- 3> 26...PxB 27.PxB PxP 28.QxP QxP QxQ 29.PxQ PXP 30.R-K7 R-B2 31.RxR KxR 32.P-B4 and White has a big plus in the 2-pawn majority in the Q-side.

The 2 Squares Column

Marv Cox

"If two squares are attacked more times than they are defended they may fall."



Square c6 and g6 are under 3 attacks by the 2 White Rooks and the White Knight via e5. These 2 squares c6 and g6 are defended by only two Black pieces, namely the Black Queen and the Black King. The Black Knights are not defenders because they occupy the squares under attack. Since there are 3 attackers and only 2 defenders we look for a sequence of moves and/or captures to give White an advantage.

1. R(c) x n(c6) check q x R

This reduces the position to one square g6 subject to 2 attacks and 1 defender.

2. R(g3) x n(g6) check k x R

3. N to e5 check wins the queen and White has a won B + N end game. My uncle quibbles the above is really a three squares problem not a two squares problem. The 3 squares are g3, g6, and e5 having 3 attacks and 2 defenders. OK, so it is. And we learned something from having that pointed out. So lets expand the original theorem to "If two or more squares or lines are attacked more times than they are defended they may fall."

BEST UPSET VICTORY CANDIDATE

January 16, 1989

White: Larry Gavin (1195)
 Black: Marvin Cox (1911)
 (Annotated by M. Franek)

1. e4 e5
2. Nf3 Nc6
3. d4 ed
4. N:d4 N:d4?!

More common are 4. ... Bc5 and 4... Nc6. A more provocative way to obtain winning chances in 4. ... Qa4!? which wins a pawn but allows White to gain tempi and an attack.

5. Q:d4 d6
6. Be2!

6. Bd3 restricts a possible retreat for the queen and 6 Bc4 is met by 6. ... Be6! Larry's move is flexible and prepares castling.

6. ... Qf6
7. Be3!

The correct answer to Black's sixth move. Black's King Knight really belongs on f6, and there is no need to help him out with 7.QxQ.

7. ... Q:d4
8. B:d4 f6
9. Nc3 Be6
10. Nd5 B:d5?

I cannot agree with this move. Black trades his only developed piece for a Knight that has already moved twice. Now that the Queens are off the board, Black should consider 10. ... Kd7, followed by Ne7.

11. e:d5 Ne7
12. Bf3 Nf5
13. 0-0-0?

If White is playing for the whole point, allowing Black to achieve opposite-colored bishops isn't the way to do it.

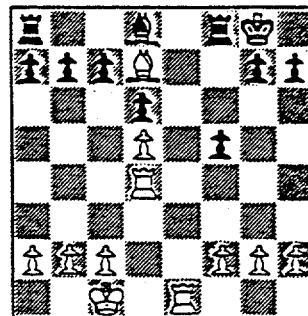
13. ... Be7

But Black declines the opportunity for now.

14. Bg4

14. Bc3, maintaining the two bishops, is better, but the move chosen is not bad. White means to occupy the gaping hole at e6.

14. ... N:d4
15. R:d4 0-0
16. Re1 Bd8
17. Bd7 f5!



Black's game is quite cramped but if he can get in Bf6 with a gain of time, g6, Rd8 dislodging the bishop so that he can contest control of the e file from either e8 or f7, he can get back into the game (or at least enhance his chances to reach a drawn opposite-colored bishops end game). However

18. h4 B:h4???

No, Marv, your pawn is on f5, not f4. So much for the opposite-colored bishop endgame.

- 19. R:h4 Ra-d8
- 20. Re7! Kh8
- 21. Rh5 f4
- 22. Bf5 h6
- 23. Bg6?

The bishop exerts a more cramping influence on Black's game from e6, where it closes the e file from the Black rooks and guards the d pawn. I would have just played R:c7.

- 23. ... Rf6
- 24. Bf5 Rdf8
- 25. Bd3?

White is confused. Again 25. Be6! is the move, and the Black queenside pawns must fall.

- 25. ... R/6-f7
- 26. Re6?

After 26. R:f7 R:f7 27. Rf5! and Black must trade rooks or lose another pawn.

- 26. ... Rd7
- 27. Rf5 Rc8
- 28. R:f5 c6
- 29. Rf-e4 Rf8
- 30. Re8 Rd8
- 31. Rd8 R:d8
- 32. dc?

32. Re7! should be considered. If White was afraid of 32. ... cd, then 33 r:b7 a5 34. Ra7 when, after the a pawn falls, White's a and b pawns flow like lava down the queenside while Black's doubled pawns are going nowhere. Incidentally, after R:b7, if Black decides to try to hold the a pawn with Ra8, then 34. Rd7 wins both d pawns.

- 32. ... bc
- 33. a4

(33. Re7 Ra8 34. Rc7 c5 35. Rd7 make things a lot easier.)

- 33. ... a5
- 34. Re6 Kg8

- 35. Bg6 Kf8
- 36. f4 c5
- 37. c4 Rb8
- 38. Kc2 Rd8
- 39. Kc3 Kg8?
- 40. g4?

40. Re8ch wins outright. In fact, after 40. ... RxR 41. BxR Kf8 White doesn't even need to save the bishop - 42. Kd3 KxB 43. Ke4 Ke7 44. Kd5 g6 45. g3 Kd7 46. b3 and Black has a chronic case of zugzwang!

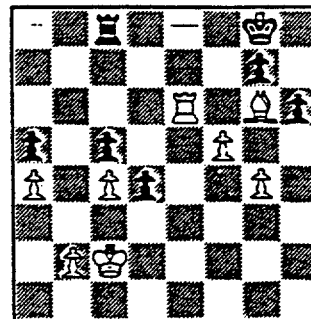
- 40. ... Kf8
- 41. Kd3 d5
- 42. Kc3

42. cd R:d5ch 43 Kc4 Rd8 (forced) 44. K:c5 Rb8 45. Re8 ch R:R 46. B:R K:B 47.b5 ab 48. a5 Kd8 49. K:b4 g6 50. Kc4 h5 51. gh gh 52. Kd4 and the White wins. Sometimes winning a won game is harder than obtaining one.

- 42. ... d4ch
- 43. Kd3 Rb8
- 44. f5 Rb3ch
- 45. Kc2?

The King has got to get into the act sooner or later. Now is the time for 45. Ke4. If 45. ... Rb8 46. Rc6 Rd8 47. Kd3! The c pawn falls, and so will the d pawn eventually.

- 45. Kc1 Rc8
- 47. Kc2 Kg8



White has been given another chance to trade rooks, but White should not go into the line unless he's worked out:
