Chicago Industrial Chess League Meeting of August 25, 1989 Continental Bank, Chicago

- 1. President Ross Siegel called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.
- 2. Secretary Fred Ciba read the minutes of the April 12, 1989 business meeting. They were approved unanimously.
- 3. In the absence of our treasurer, Jim Brotsos, president Ross Siegel summarized Jim's previously submitted report. Each item in the 1988-89 income/expense report was examined and discussed. Whereas we made \$134 on the CICL bulletin, we lost \$99 on the CICL awards banquet. Each item in the 1989-90 operating budget was examined and discussed. Russ Rzeszutko commented that we should "keep a lid on it" referring to the trophy budget but others responded by defending these monies as appropriate. Dues will remain at \$64 a year per team. Penalties will continue to be assessed to late payments. Jim Brotsos asked, via a letter, that we consider the following proposal at our Spring 1990 meeting...

"I would like to propose a reward for loyalty and activity. Members reaching the double centurion level should receive a 50% subsidy for all future awards banquets they wish to attend. Members reaching triple centurion status should be invited to be the guest of the league at all subsequent banquets."

The treasurers report was approved unanimously. Brotsos report was passed out to team captains for closer examination by team members if they wish.

- 4. Dave Burian discussed the problems they had in the previous season with one alumni team being unable to field a full 6 members for each match. He suggested that perhaps 5 man alumni teams might be feasible in his division. General discussion followed. It was generally felt that a bad precedent would be set by modifying this rule. Therefore, no exceptions will be made.
- Norm Hughes initiated a discussion of the Fel Pro team. It was felt that because of the assurances of Ron Weitz this team will participate in the 1989-90 season.
- 6. A volunteer was called upon to be our bulletin editor. No one volunteered. President Ross Siegel will call former editor Wes Underwood to see if he will take the job.

- 7. Russ Rzeszutko volunteered to be our 1990 banquet chairman. He will be selecting a sight soon and it will be published in a future bulletin.
- 8. Wayne Brandt volunteered to be a temporary bulletin editor, he will also distribute the ratings at the same time.
- 9. West Underwood (in absentia) was praised in his efforts as trophy chairman. It was generally believed that he would continue to serve in this capacity.
- 10. Frank Suerth was voted onto the Examplar alumni team.
- 11. Russ Rzeszutko volunteered to be our publicist.
- 12. President Ross Siegel called for a volunteer to be our banquet tournament director. There were no candidates. This position should be filled by our Spring meeting on April 6, 1990. (Volunteers for any unfilled position should call President Siegel.)
- 13. It was decided that the playoffs for 1990 should be determined at our Spring meeting.
- 14. Russ Rzeszutko lead a discussion on his proposal to recognize current and past presidents of the USCF. Russ would see these men playing in our league on alumni teams. A general discussion followed on where they would play, what the benefits would be and what the connection to national would be. Russ felt that Harold Winston would participate. Here is the Rzeszutko proposal...

"I propose to make the current and past USCF presidents honorary members of the CICL and eligible to play on any Alumni team of their choice."

The above will be voted on at the Spring meeting.

15. Tony Jasaitis nominated the Chicago Research and Trading team, the "Hedgehogs", to participate in the east division. They have 10 to 12 players but are unable to play at "home". They were voted in unanimously.

- 16. A second alumni team was proposed for the East division, the "second stringers", composed of Russ Rzeszutko, Glenn Beard, J. Michael Smith, Mike Davidson, Ken Lempa and Asher Bromfield. They were voted in unanimously.
- 17. Dave Burian proposed his new team, Northrop, be in the north division. Because of their Department of Defense contract, visiting teams will have to be escorted to their playing sight. Walgreens was discussed and proposed too. They were both voted in unanimously.
- 18. Norm Hughes led a discussion of another All Star match. It was relt that our previous attempt was a success and the 1989-90 match should be in Oak Park. Various date were proposed. July or August was agreed upon. After the spring playoffs all four division chairmen should get together and agree upon the details.
- 19. Ruben Reyes suggested that the speed chess results, held during the awards banquet, be published in the bulletin. He was assured that in the future they will be.
- 20. Russ Rzeszutko protested the fact that team members and/or teams depart from matches and do not advise opponents of the end of the game/match. No further discussion ensued.
- 21. President Ross Siegel closed the meeting at 8:08 p.m.
