Congratulations to our 1998/1999 champions, the Exemplars. Captain Tom Friske led this strong team to a sweep of the post season tournament with a 3-0-0 record. This is the first alumni team to win the CICL team title. The Lucent Tyros gave Exemplars a tough match in the final round, but fell just short by a 3.5 to 2.5 match score. 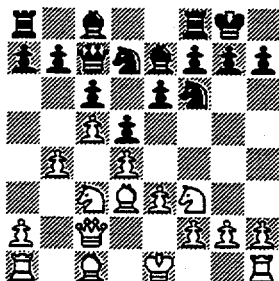
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The finishing touch

Carl Reid (1400) of Lucent Technologies' Chargers won this nice game on board 6 last April 26, 1999 vs. a 1498.

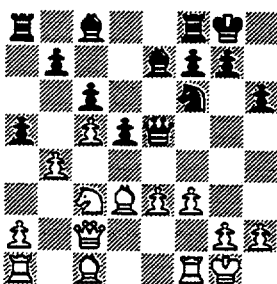
Let's take a glimpse of the action after 8...Qc7 9.Qc2 (see diagram below)



9...e5

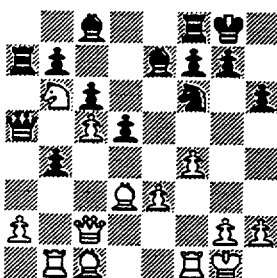
The pawn at c5 is supported by the pawns at d4 and b4. Black's last move tries to take the legs from under the pawn at c5.

10.dxe5 Nxe5 11.Nxe5 Qxe5 12.0-0 h6 13.f3 a5



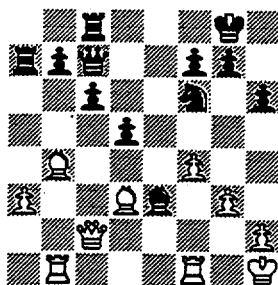
Now Black topples down the last support to the White pawn at c5.

14.f4 Qc7 15.Na4 axb4 16.Rb1 Qa5 17.Nb6 Ra7



With the fall of the pawn at c5 imminent, the breaking up of White's pawn wall is now complete.

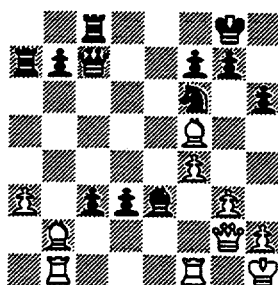

Excellent play.

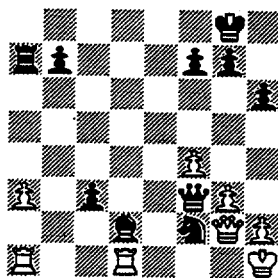
24.Bc3 d4 25.Bb2 c4 26.Bf5 d3 27.Qg2 c3

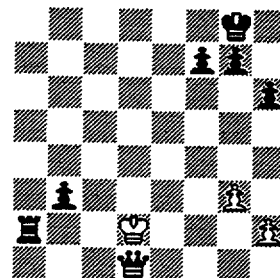

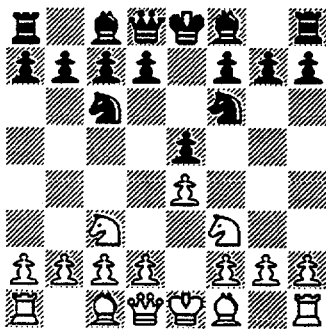

Four Knights Opening

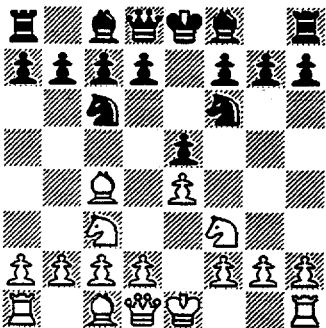
One of the popular openings among CICL players is the Four Knights. The choice is logical as this opening starts out; conservative and uncomplicated; solid and sound. The Four Knights begins as follows:

1.e4 e5 2.Nf3 Nc3 3.Nc3 Nf6 (see diagram below)



What we'll discuss are what White's 4th move are in CICL games: (A) 4. Bc4 and (B) 4.d4.

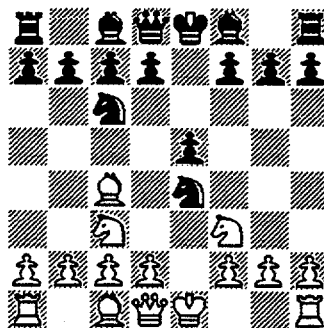
A. 4.Bc4, the Italian variation (see diagram below) can also be reached



from the Two Knights Defense: 1. e4 e5 2.Nf3 Nc6 3.Bc4 Nf6 when White replies 4.Nc6 instead of 4.Ng5.

A.1: 4...Nxe4

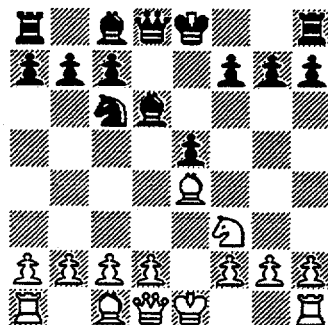
After 4. Bc4, the reply 4... Nxe4 (see diagram 3 below) is a no-nonsense at-



tempt at obtaining equality. The idea behind this move is that after 5.Nxe4, Black recovers the piece while at the same time immediately gets to play the freeing move 5...d5.

A.1.a: 5.Nxe4

Black's continuation after this response by White seems forced: 5...d5 6.Bd3 dxe4 7. Bxd4 Bd6 (see diagram below)



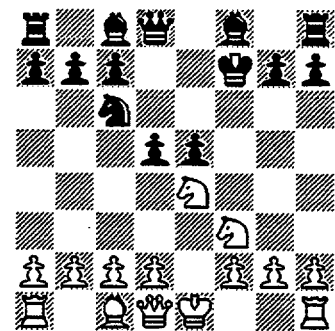
Black has equalized.

A.1.b: 5.Bxf7+

This is a *desperado* type reaction to Black's N sacrifice: Since, after 5.Nxe4 d5, White's going to lose back the piece anyway, White may as well cause Black to forfeit castling privilege by giving up a piece now rather than losing one later.

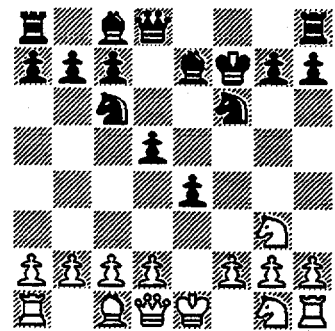
