MINUTES

President Tony Jasaitis called the meeting to order at 7:04 P.M.

1. OFFICERS REPORTS:

A. President – Tony Jasaitis

Tony said this is a time of growth for the league.

B. Secretary – Jerry Thomas

Jerry said there were no changes to the spring business meeting minutes. The minutes were published in the bulletin and are on the CICL web site. The spring business meeting minutes were unanimously approved.

C. Treasurer – Paul Freidel

Paul Freidel presented the treasurer's report and a draft dues sheet. The 2007-08 year had a \$1,000 surplus due to donations and banquet deposits not claimed, the budget (see the web site) shows the final figures. The banquet had a small surplus and everything else ran close to target.

The proposed 2008-09 Fall Budget is based on 21 teams, \$55 dues, and no donations. We will continue to fund the USAT team and this is in the proposed budget.

The treasurer's report and proposed CICL 2008-09 Fall Budget were unanimously approved later in the meeting after it was decided not to collect deposits for scoresheet penalties. The CICL 2008-09 Fall Budget and the approved dues form are on the CICL web site.

D. Division Chairmen:

North-Jim Thompson, Chairman (not present)

Tony Jasaitis presented Jim's report. Northrop is unable to continue because of company player attrition and their location is a high security plant. All other teams are continuing as is. There will be 6 teams in the North. Walgreens gave Tony their rosters for the Skewers (company team) and Forks (associate team).

East-Adams Muhs, Chairman (not present)

Tony Jasaitis presented Adams Muhs's report. DRW Trading is a new team coming into the league (See New Business). Loyola is another possibility. They played 4 exhibition matches last year without any problems. However, Loyola's school year has not started yet. Tony will contact them after their school year starts to see if they are going to join the league. So, there will be 6 or 7 teams in the East division.

West-Bob Buchner, Chairman

Matt Vail read Bob Buchner's email report. The St. Charles Chess Club will only field one team because playing 2 teams' CICL matches at their home site made normal club meeting functions difficult. A new team, St. Xavier University will join the West (See New Business). BP and Molex are combining into one Associate team.

Bob Buchner is stepping down and Irwin Gaines will be the new West Division Chairman. Irwin was unanimously appointed as the West Division Chairman. Irwin said he has the Downers Grove club roster and needs the other club and associate teams to send him their rosters.

2. OTHER REPORTS:

A. Bulletin, Games Editor Webmaster-Tom Friske

BULLETIN: No news, Tom was able to publish a bulletin each month last season.

GAMES Editor: Tom thanked everyone for the articles and game analysis sent to him. Norm Hughes has analyzed the Warren Junior and New York Internet matches. The next bulletin will include those games and the analysis. WEB Site: Tom took Web classes over the summer and is in the process of rewriting our web site. He developed a match submission form that will port those results to the web site and send the data to the ratings chairman. Tom says it works except for one issue and expects to finish in September. Jeff Wiewel suggested using the Division schedule to choose the match being reported. Tom will work on adding that.

The attendees thanked Tom for his efforts and gave him a round of applause.

B. Rating Chairman-Art Olsen

Rating Chairman's Report:

Art said this season forfeits will count on players' win/loss records. Forfeits do not affect ratings.

Art asked that **captain's emails of results to Art use the Subject CICL Match Result** and include the Date of the Match, the Round Nbr, and who is the Home team.

Art mentioned that the first Performance Rating would be in late November as he needs one result from every team to create it.

C. Publicity Chairman-Matt Vail

Matt said the Chicago Police Department (102nd & Wentworth station) and the Blue Cross/Blue Shield (300 W Randolph) were interested in forming teams. Matt summarized his discussions with them and said they were viable prospective teams.

Matt described the CICL monthly open house held at Computer Associates on the 2^{nd} Tuesday of every month from 6:30 to 10 P.M. as a valuable touch point with prospects and promotes regular play. He is opening it up to anyone who wants to play. He will probably move it to every other month.

Matt said Norm Hughes and Fred Furtner have been a great help on publicity. Publicity's goal is to develop teams to enter the league. Tom Friske described Walgreen's chess club efforts to find players within their company and what worked. Tom said increasing the visibility of chess inside a company was key. Matt agreed to provide chess flyers and other material as a packet to publicize chess at a company.

D. Banquet Chairman-Wayne Ellice

Wayne said that 33 people attended our banquet at the Alpine Inn (Roosevelt and Wolf Rd in Westchester) and enjoyed it. The attendees agreed that this site was excellent and should be used this year. The attendees decided that Alpine Inn would again be the site for this year's banquet.

E. Trophy Chairman-Marty Franek (not present, emailed in)

Marty said there was nothing to report. We were under budget for the trophy/award expense.

3. Old Business – All appointed officers have agreed to continue except for the West Division chairman previously mentioned.

4. New Business

A. Proposals

1. Mandatory submission of score sheets

The attendees decided to drop the fine and dues add-on part of this proposal. Instead the attendees proposed adding "**the collection and mailing/emailing of the score sheets within 2 weeks**" to the home team captain's responsibility in Section V-B 6 of the constitution. This revised proposal was unanimously accepted.

- Alumni status of club players no longer with club
 The proposal is that anyone who played for a club team and is no longer a member of that club will be an
 Alumni. This proposal was accepted with a vote of 11 For and 2 Abstaining. Section IV E 5(c) of the constitution will modified with another bullet.
- 3. Revision of Associate Team Rules After a long and heated discussion both pro and con, the attendees voted to table this proposal until at least the Spring meeting. The vote was 9 For, 2 Opposed, and 1 Abstaining.
- 4. Unrestrained Recruitment and Retention

Similar to proposal #3, the attendees voted to table this proposal until at least the Spring meeting. The vote was 9 For, 2 Opposed, and 1 Abstaining.

B. New teams and Reorganizations

William Shehan (by phone) described **the new St. Xavier University team**. William will be captain of that team and they wish to enter as a new company team. They have 18 members in their chess club with 1 staff member and the rest students. The first Thursday of the month is their usual meeting night. For matches they will play any night of the week and their facility is open until Midnight. This team was unanimously accepted.

Fall Business Meetings - MINUTES

Steve Gorodetskiy said **DRW Trading wishes to enter as an Associate team**. His brother Eugene will be the captain. Their playing site is a conference room at 10 S. Riverside in downtown Chicago and they will buy the required chess equipment. They have 2 people who have played in the CICL before and one Alumni and can get 6 players for each match. If DRW is short, AMARS can provide Alumni players. This team was accepted unanimously.

BP and Molex wish to combine into an Associate team. BP players travel extensively on short notice. Also BP is reorganizing their sites and transferring many people. The team will decide on which company to associate with and will notify Tony Jasaitis before the start of the season. This associate team was accepted unanimously.

C. Discuss USAT re: locations outside Chicago

Jeff Wiewel said the USAT location has not been determined yet. The current budget includes funds to pay the team's entry fees. After the location is determined, the CICL will contact players to see if anyone will participate.

D. Matches vs. Other Cities/Clubs

Norm Hughes recommended expanding the Internet matches to 3 over the summer. He also agreed to manage this again. Since many of the policies and procedures were established for the first match, this should take less effort. The attendees unanimously accepted expanding the Internet matches to 3.

E. CICL Team Recruitment ideas

Norm Hughes, Fred Furtner, and Matt are the Publicity committee. Tom Friske will talk to the Publicity committee about publicity ideas that worked for him.

F. Distribute score sheets and match sheets

Score sheets and match result sheets were distributed to the captains.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:43 P.M.
