MINUTES

President Irwin Gaines called the meeting to order at 7:05 P.M.

1. OFFICERS REPORTS: A. President – Irwin Gaines

Irwin said that most of the business for this meeting is relatively routine and normal.

B. Secretary – Jerry Thomas

Jerry said there were no changes to the spring business meeting minutes. The minutes were published in the bulletin. Attendees approved the minutes unanimously. □

C. Treasurer – Paul Freidel

Paul Freidel presented his last treasurer's report. Our new Treasurer will be Andy Mosley. The 2011-12 year had an \$802.56 surplus due to a \$200 donation and many no shows at the banquet. The budget (see the web site) shows the final figures. We have about \$2,000 in the bank and expect to run a small deficit each year to gradually reduce this.

The proposed 2012-13 Fall Budget is based on 23 teams, no change in dues, a scoresheet order, and Publicity instead of Special.

The treasurer's report and modified CICL 2012-13 Fall Budget were unanimously approved. The CICL 2012-13 Fall Budget and the approved dues form are on the CICL web site.

D. Division Chairmen: North-Jim Thompson, Chairman (Jeff Balicki for Jim)

Jeff Balicki said that there will be 4 teams in the North this year. Walgreens dropped out mid-season last year and the two Motorola teams will combine this season. All of the other teams from last year are returning.

East-Tony Jasaitis, Chairman

Tony said the CitUC is dropping out, Chopper Trading is becoming a company team, Enova Financial is a

new team, and TradeLink is becoming the Hedgehogs as an Alumni team associating with TradeLink.

West-Jeff Wiewel, Chairman

Jeff explained that Joliet Junior College is dropping out this year and may be back next year. Attendees asked if their former players could be contacted to see if they were interested in joining another team as Alumni players. Jeff agreed to email John, Joliet's last year captain requesting that John give this option to his players.

2. OTHER REPORTS:

A. Bulletin Editor-Patrice Connelly (by phone)

Patrice said bulletins went really well last year with great submissions. She agreed to assist on the web by uploading the bulletins. Irwin mentioned there are several additional links involved and he will discuss them directly with her. The attendees complimented her work on the bulletins and said people were very pleased with the bulletins.

B. Games Editor-Steve Tennant

Irwin said Steve Tennant was willing to write notes and annotations on game submissions. Irwin said we need to decide on a policy on game submissions. Currently, 60-80% of all played are in the CICL data base. After discussion, attendees agreed that the league's goal should be to obtain as many game submissions as possible. See new business for more on this.

C. Webmaster-(vacant)

Irwin explained that this was multiple tasks and should be divided. He agreed to update the games and email lists. Fred Furtner agreed to be responsible for the Design and Content of the Web Front pages.

D. Rating Chair-Jeff Balicki

Jeff said the CICL completed the second season under the new rating programs and web reports distributed via the CICL Web Page. He mentioned that the online match entry tool and web site rosters got full cooperation from the captains and worked very well. He said there were no summer tournaments. He thanked the division chairmen for maintaining the Division Web pages.

E. Publicity Chairman-Matt Vail (no report)

Irwin will contact Matt and make sure he agrees to continue.

F. Banquet Chairman-Katherine Zak(in absentia)

Irwin said Katherine agreed to continue and said the banquet made a profit because many teams had no representative come ("no shows").

See new business for the new banquet date of the second Friday in June.

F. Trophy Chairman-Chuck Dobrovoly

Chuck said trophies were distributed at the banquet. He thanked Marty and Tony for their help. He said gift

certificates have been distributed. He asked if RTM was paid for this year and were they paid for any funds in arrears. Paul Freidel said yes they were paid and there are no arrears. Chuck asked if Tony and Jeff got their officer plaques they have coming (they are already paid for). Tony and Jeff said no. They are at RTM and will be picked up.

3. ELECTIONS and APPOINTMENTS

A. Election of new Treasury Andy Mosley was unanimously elected as the new Treasurer. Paul Freidel reviewed and turned over the Treasurer documents to him. B. Bulletin Editor Patrice Connelly agreed to continue. C. Games Editor Steve Tennant is the new games editor. See Games Editor report. D. Webmaster see Webmaster report E. Ratings Chair Jeff Balicki agreed to continue F. Publicity Chair Matt Vail agreed to continue G. Banquet Chair Katherine Zack agreed to continue H. Trophy Chair Chuck Dobrovolny agreed to continue

4. OLD BUSINESS

A. New teams/new status

The new Enova Financial team is in the Loop and has 2 USCF players rated 1800 and 8-10 players. They have a home site, equipment, a captain, and a co-captain. The new Enova Financial team was unanimously approved for entry into the league in the East Division.

The Chopper team was a combined team and wants to become a company team. They have 8+ players. The change to a company team was unanimously approved.

The TradeLink company team is becoming the Hedgehogs captained by Tony Jasaitis. They have 12 players on their roster and will be an Alumni team associated with the TradeLink Company. This team was unanimously approved for entry into the league in the East Division.

B. Banquet Date proposal

Chuck Dobrovolny suggested that the banquet be moved to the 2nd Friday in June instead of the first to aid in trophy acquisition following the playoffs, as well as to avoid end-of-school-year graduations and family vacations. Attendees discussed possible reasons for banquet attendance drifting down. They concluded neither the food, cost, nor was the location (central) the cause. This proposal was unanimously approved. The banquet will be the second Friday in June.

C. Top ten list proposal

After some discussion on the difficulty of determining exactly when to drop non-playing players from the top ten list and the effort required implementing this, this proposal was rejected. Ratings chair, Jeff Balicki said the top ten list would be the same as last year with anyone on the roster who hasn't playing dropped at the end of the regular season.

D. Rules clarification for teams dropping out part way through season

1. counting matches in standings 2. count of teams in division

A small subcommittee will be formed to decide this and to create the language. Irwin will work on this with Jim Thomson.

3. Teams dropping out of playoffs

After the first round is scheduled or after the first round is played, a team dropping out needs a replacement. Two methods were suggested that follow the rules for choosing the playoff team. The first involved offering the slot to teams in the same Division as the dropout team if that division would be losing one of its required number of playoff entries. The second would be offer the slot to the next Wild Card team starting with the 9th place.

Attendees said the 1st method would result in offering 4th, 5th, or lower placed teams in a Division a playoff slot ahead of the Wild Card team with a much better record and a better chance of deciding to play.

Vote on "Offer the slot to the next Wild Card team starting with the 9th place". 10 For, 2 Against, 0 Abstain – proposal approved

5. NEW BUSINESS

A. Discussion of tools to allow players/captains to enter their games online

Attendees decided to provide incentives to encourage teams to submit scoresheets and individuals to submit an electronic version (picture or scan of scoresheets or -PGN file). The incentives would be an entry in 2 \$50 drawings at the banquet. One drawing will be for a team and another will be for an individual.

For teams, to be entered in the drawing the home captain must have submitted scoresheets for all of their home matches.

For individuals, the player would receive 1 entry in the drawing if their game was submitted electronically and a second entry in the drawing if their game was submitted as a -PGN file.

This proposal applies to the regular season only. Vote: 12 For, 1 Against, 0 Abstain – proposal approved.

B. Publicity and whether to fund an Amateur team entry

Attendees discussed the publicity gained from funding an amateur team entry and no one could show that any new team(s) came from it. Attendees were unsure what was the best use of additional publicity funds especially since Matt Vail was not present to give ideas on where he could have used funds in previous years' publicity efforts, Attendees decided to use this \$150 for publicity and let Matt Vail, the publicity chair, decide how to use it.

C. Distribute: - Score sheets Tony Jasaitis distributed score sheets to the teams that needed them. - Match result sheets Irwin Gaines distributed match sheets to the teams that needed them. The meeting was adjourned at 9:50 P.M. – one of our shortest meetings ever finishing before Irwin's 10 P.M. promise.
