

Your Thoughts: Alternate Time Controls in CICL Matches

Last month a few chess players shared their thoughts and experience with alternate time controls in this year's matches, which prompted some other players to ask, what are the current time control and adjournment rules, anyway? Here's a recap:

The current rules on Time Controls, from Section V of the CICL Constitution:

F. Time Controls

1. Time controls can be set by individual player agreement. Except that for all games reported on a match results sheet (counting or extra board), a time control of game in 30 minutes ("G/30") or slower must be used.

2. The default time control is 45 moves in 90 minutes without a delay, followed by a secondary time control of 30 moves per hour without a delay. This default will apply in the absence of agreement to a different time control between the two players.

3. If a clock must be started in the absence of a player, the default time control will apply, unless the team captains agree otherwise.

The current role on Adjournments from Section V of the Constitution:

H. Adjournments

1. When an Adjournment May Occur

After the secondary time control, either player may demand an adjournment. Adjournment at any other time may occur only if both players agree to it, except when the playing site has a fixed closing time (see next section).

2. Sites With a Fixed Closing Time

a) If a playing site has a fixed closing time, the home team captain must announce the closing time before the match. If the site's closing time does not allow play to continue through the end of the second default time control, the following rules then apply for adjourning games after the first time control is completed. But these rules do no apply, if both players have agreed to a sudden-death time control that will be completed before the closing time.

b) After the first time control is completed, and it is within 30 minutes of closing, either player may require an adjournment. This can be without the agreement of his opponent, even if it is not one's turn to move. Whoever is on move must then seal their current (unplayed) move before the announced site closing time. Captains will announce when it is 30 minutes before the announced closing time.

c) When it is 15 minutes before closing time, the game must be adjourned. As of that time, no further moves on the board are allowed. Whoever is on move must seal their current (unplayed) move before the announced site closing time. Captains will announce when it is 15 minutes before the announced closing time.

CICL Constitution (August 2011 Rev) P. 22 of 28

d) The home team player (whose site doesn't allow the normal five hours of play) is to travel to the other team's home site to resume the game, unless both players agree otherwise. When a non-voluntary adjournment occurs at a neutral playing site with limited playing time due to time restrictions, the adjournment should be played off at some site that is mutually agreeable to the two players involved. Once a game reaches move 76, it is often necessary to adjourn. Otherwise, the playing session could last well beyond 5 hours.

Last Month's Comments:

Greg Bungo, DDCC:

Now that the CICL season is half over, I'm curious about people's experiences with alternate time controls in league matches. I hope most of you have had the opportunity to try a different time control, such as { 45 moves / 90 minutes, Sudden Death (SD) / 60 minutes, 5 second delay }.

My team, Downers Grove Chess Club, has played 5 matches, and in 4 of those matches, every game was played with an alternate time control. In one game in one match, the players did not have a digital clock, so they couldn't use the 5 second delay, but they still played 45/90, SD/60, since adjournments are annoying, and are fertile ground for cheating in the computer age. We won, lost, and twice drew matches with the alternate time control.

In a fifth match (not in the 5th round), only two of our opponents agreed to use the alternate { 45/90, SD/60, 5 sec. delay } time control. We won that match.


There are multiple benefits to the alternate control, and I no longer think that avoiding adjournments is the primary benefit, although it is important. The 5 second delay helps to prevent time pressure from becoming purely an act of manual dexterity. With the standard CICL time control, if a player is very short of time a few moves prior to a time control (usually shortly before move 45), he is in great danger of losing on time, unless he is a highly skilled blitz player. I don't know about the rest of you, but I make a lot of mistakes in blitz play, and the extra 5 seconds per move is enormously reassuring.

I would love to read the impressions of people who have played with an alternate sudden death time control in a CICL league match.

Tony Jasaitis of Hedgehogs:

As far as I know, the East Division is 100% on a de facto standard of 45/90, then SD/60, 5 sec delay (if digital clock; for mechanical clocks some people might add a few minutes to the clock). I believe we're all happy with that. Some individual boards agree to faster, like G/90.

Prize limits: 1) If any post-event rating posted 5/22/13-5/22/14 was more than 30 points over section maximum, prize limit \$1500. 2) Players with under 10 lifetime games rated as of 5/14 official list cannot win over \$1000 in U1300, \$1500 U1500, \$2000 U1700, or \$2500 U1900. 3) Balance of any limited prize goes to next player(s) in line.

Mixed Doubles Bonus Prizes: best male/female combined 2-player "team" score: \$2000-1000-500-400-300-200. Open Section points count 80% to compensate for Open having more rounds than other sections. Team average must be under 2200; teammates may play in different sections; teams must register (no extra fee) before both players begin round 2; teammate pairings avoided but possible.

NOTE CORRECTIONS:

1) Foreign GM minimum prize added, if completing all games with no byes in rounds 6-9.

2) No prize limit for under 10 games in Under 1000/Unr Section. There is still a \$500 limit for unrated in this section.
