A compromise plan, to tide the league over for another year, was adopted at the meeting. This called for the addition of the "B" teams and a one-time round robin match to beplayed for the 1961-62 season. Admittedly this is a temporization and the committee that studied this problem has indicated that it has a further report to make and that another meeting of the league should be held to discuss this one problem.
