FOUR MAN DIVISION NOTES

Well guys, it only took me a half a season, but I've finally put together the information you've been waiting for with bated breath. The playoff structure and schedule. This year there will be six teams eligible and five trophies awarded. The first two eligible teams in each section shall go to the playoffs. ArgonneX and the Alumni team are ineligible, if Donnelley teams are eligible from two sections, there will be a one game playoff to determine eligibility. If two teams are tied in match points for playoff position, the following tie breaking methods shall be used: (1) Game Points, (2) Head-To-Head Record, (3) Most Matches Won, (4) Least Amount of Games Forfeited, (5) Most Games Won, (6) Away Record (7) Home Record, (8) Best Record on Boards one and Four combined, (9) Best Record on Boards Two and Three Combined, and, if they're still tied (10) Coin flip. The playoffs will begin April 17, 1972, this means all regular League matches must be completed by April 14, 1972 and the results phoned in no later than noon April 17, 1972. If they are not completed or I am not notified, a double forfeit will be declared. The scheduling for the playoffs is tight, so there can be no grace period. The schedule is as follows: Round One, April 17, 1972 to May 5, 1972; Round Two, May 8, 1972 to May 26, 1972; and Round Three, May 29, 1972 to June 9, 1972. This schedule allows a minimum of one week to engrave the trophy. If a match is drawn in Rounds One or Two, the teams will change colors and play a 30/30 Match. If that is drawn, the teams will change colors and play another 30/30. If that match is drawn, a winner shall be declared by weighing the boards in the first match as follows: Board One - 5 points, Board Two - 4 points, Board Three - 3 points, and Board Four - 1 point. If all four boards draw, a coin flip will decide the winner. If the match is drawn in Round Three, the teams will be declared co-champions. The structure of the playoffs will consist of: Round One, A) North Second at South First and B) Central Second hosting South Second; (North First and Central First drew byes by lot); in Round Two, winner of Round One A) will visit Central First and the winner of Round One B) will visit North First. 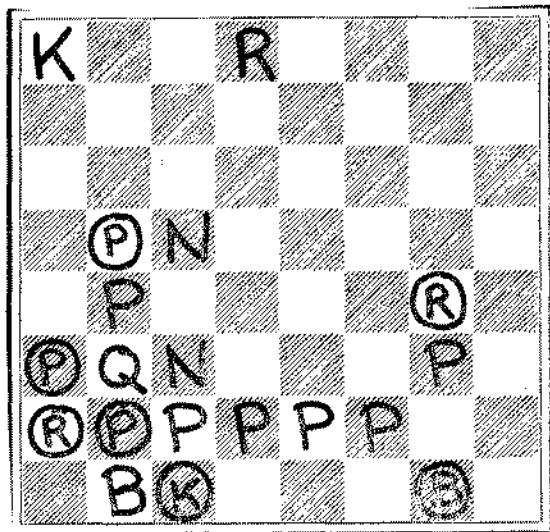

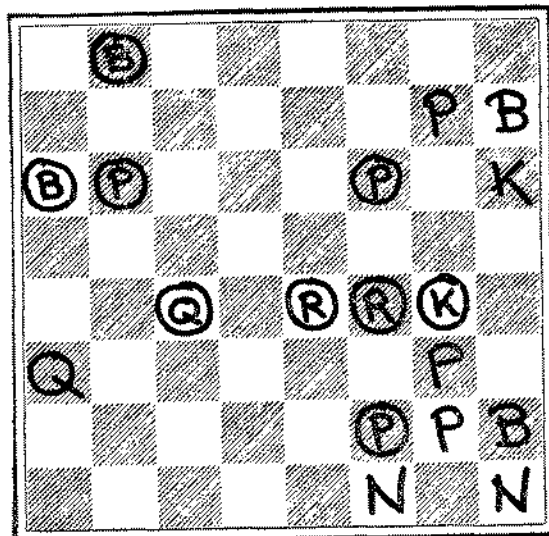
