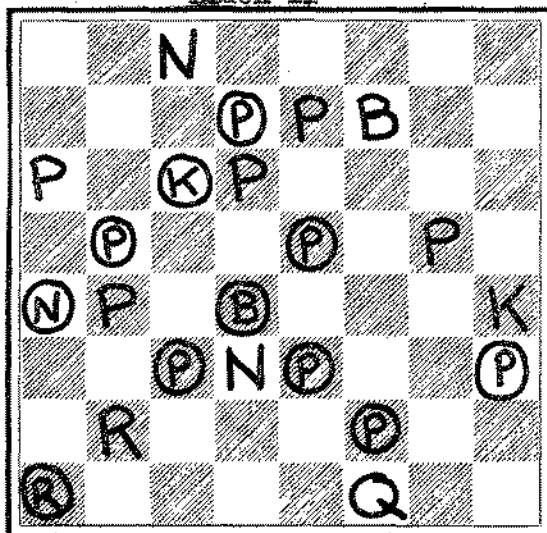
NEW PROBLEMS

Black 11

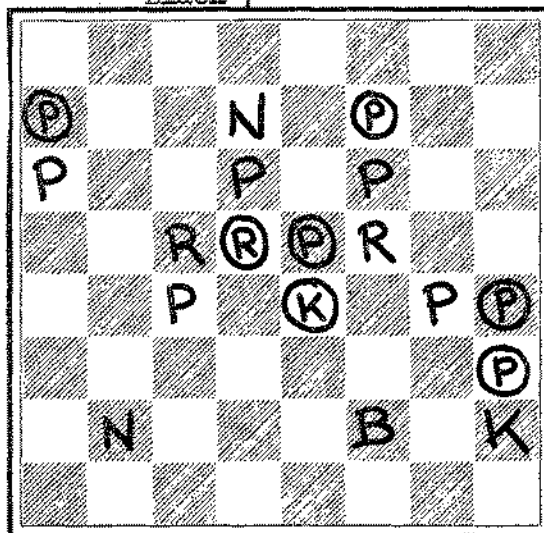


White 11
