#### ILLINOIS OPEN

The Illinois State Open, held at Chicago's YMCA Hotel over Labor Day weekend, was won by Greg Defotis with a score of 6-1. 140 players participated in the event, with 56 in the Premier Section (open to all) and 84 in the Booster Section (open to players rated below 1800 only).

In the Premier Section, finishing with 6-1 also, but second on tie-breaking, was Andrew Karkins. Eric Karlins, Morris Giles, and Norbert Leopoldi were 3rd-5th at  $5\frac{1}{2}$ - $1\frac{1}{2}$ , and 4th-9th at 5-2 were Richard Verber, Gary DeFotis, Craig Chellstorp and Jim Warren. The Class "A" prize of \$100 went to Jim Warren (fortunately, the September USCF ratings were late, otherwise Jim would have been ineligible for the Class "A" prize, since he would have had his Expert rating back).

Ramon Rosales, an unrated player, swept the Booster Section, 7-0. Richard Edahl finished tied for second with 6-1. Frank Tegel was 4th and Bob Marcowca 5th, at  $5\frac{1}{2}-1\frac{1}{2}$ .

#### RATING PROCEDURES FOR 1971-1972

Subsequent rating lists in 1971-72 will include only players who have played in at least one match during the 1971-1972 League season. This has always been the case each season, except for &-rated players, whose ratings are recalculated each month. These are recalculated even though some are now inactive, since they can affect other &-rated players ratings.

Also, players for the "Big Ten" lists will only be listed if they have played in 30% of the matches in which they were eligible. This is new - actually it was started last season. It prevents a player from playing in 1 or 2 matches and as a result staying in the "Big Ten" inactively. Really it becomes an "active Big Ten", but at the same time does not require a player in too high a percentage of games. One out of three qualifies, one out of four does not, etc.

#### PROBLEM SOLVING CONTEST

The problem solving contest will be conducted like last year's. A solver receives point credits equal to the length of solution -- 2 for mates-in-2, 3 for mates-in-3. Unless otherwise directed, he need send me only the key move -- the first white move.


I will generally increase the difficulty of the problems as the season goes on. Beginners and others who want more practice might well tackle the problems appearing in the Chicago Sun Times Thursdays and Sundays.

While I will strive to present sound problems accurately; if a problem is significantly misdiagrammed or is cooked. I will withdraw it from competition.

I will set a postmark deadline enabling most solvers to have two weekends to work on solutions. Since my deadline for the coming issue is about the 25th of each month, it may be that the solution deadline will not permit the published solvers' scores to be current. Solvers are welcome to call me to check on scores and discuss the problems.
