Planned is a spectacular 100 board Simultaneous Chess Demonstration in the Grand Ballroom of the LaSalle Hotel starting at 7:30 PM -- there will also be a short question and answer period (Paul Keres speaks fluent English, and will act as translator for Petrosian). 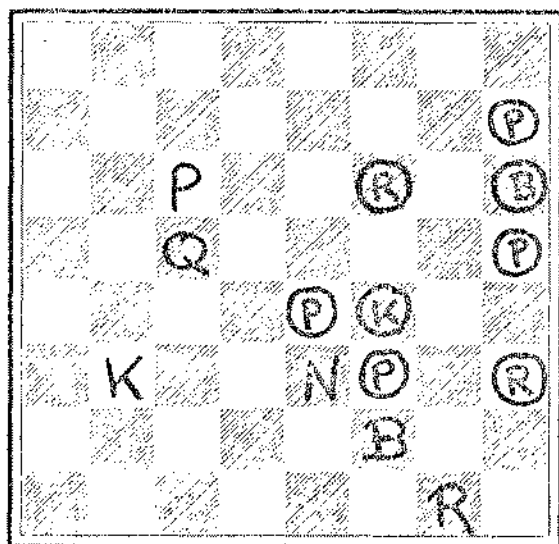

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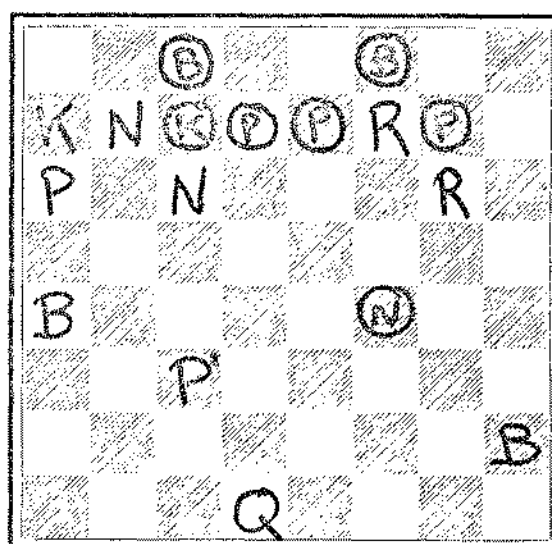


WHITE 6
