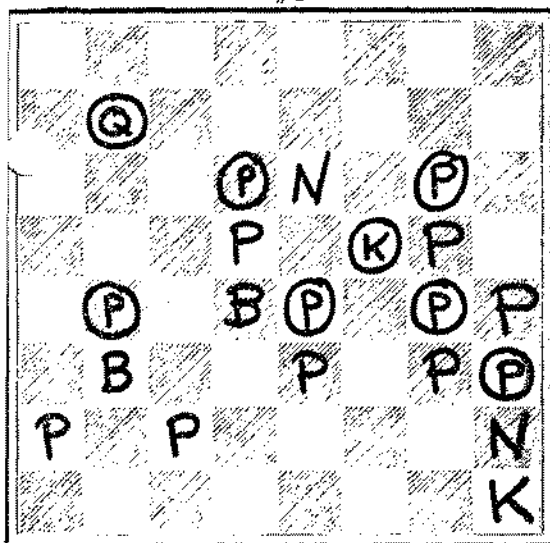

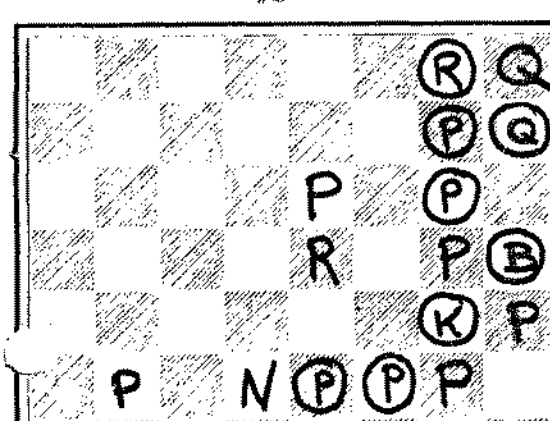

The black Q has to try to hold the fort herself.

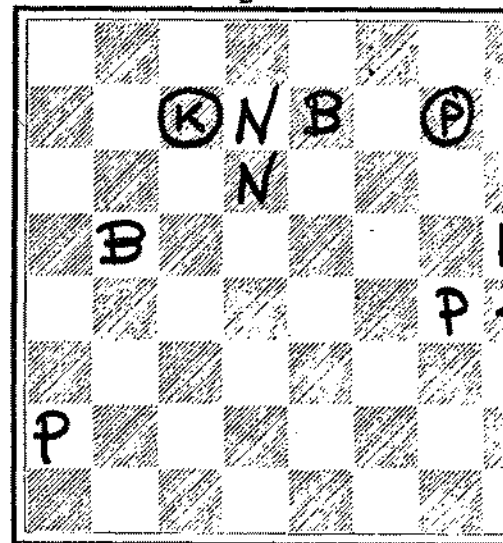

Some readers may have noticed the last diagram in Evan's column in the Dec., 1973 issue of Chess Life & Review, shown here as "E". It is an attempt to satisfy a challenge by my friend P.L. Rothenberg in his book with Horowitz,

"The Complete Book of Chess" (originally under the better title "The Personality of Chess" -- I recommend the book to chess players of any level), to wit: set a 5-move helpmate in which both black's and white's moves consist of pawn moves from original rank to promotional rank, ending promotions to knights. (In the helpmate, black helps white mate black and has the first move.) From the diagram, the challenge is seemingly met by this play: 1 Pg5 Pa4; 2 PxP Pa5; 3 Ph3 Pa6; 4 Ph2 Pa7; 5 Ph1(N) pa8(N) mate. The black pawn must play as shown -- 1 Pg6 is a check forcing the K to move; the promotion must be to N since B or Q would guard a8 and R or Q would check. What is wrong? Cooks galore. It took me hardly a glance to find a mate in 3: 1 Pg5 Nc8; 2 Kh7 various by white; 3 Ka8 Rc6 mate. How m
