

## PROGRESS REPORT ON THE CICL MICROCOMPUTER

In early March, the CICL became the proud owner of a microcomputer, to be used for maintaining the League rating system. The computer is a Radio Shack TRS-80 Model III, with 48K bytes of memory, two double-density disk drives, and an RS-232 port. Also purchased was an Epson MX-80 printer, on which this report is being printed. The total cost of this system, including a printer cable and the shipping charges, was \$1928, within the \$2000 limit set at the recent League meeting at which the purchase was approved.

Work is currently in progress to convert the rating programs to the new computer. The RS-232 port will soon be used to connect to a modem, for transferring the League rating data over telephone lines to the TRS-80.

The Model III computer offers a number of advantages over the less expensive Color Computer originally proposed. An important advantage is its modular, all-in-one construction, including keyboard, video monitor, and disk drives. This will make it easier for the system to be moved as new ratings chairmen are designated each season. The built-in RS-232 port provides a permanent telecommunications capability, as mentioned above. Finally, the Model III has a sculptured typist's keyboard, a video display of 16 lines of 64 characters (versus 32 for the Color Computer), and displays both upper and lower case characters. These features will make the system much easier to use for future word-processing applications than the Color Computer would have been.

#### Proposal for Alumni Championship

#### I. Background

At the Aug.,1982 business meeting it was mandated that more funds be allocated for trophies & awards and that new prize categories be established. It was also decided to hold the last two rounds of the League Playoffs at a common sit. Both these decisions make it possible to expand the play-off program to include the alumni teams-for the first time we have three competingat once.

Alumni teams have been a part of the CICL since 1970. They have paid hundreds of dollars into the league's treasury, they have contributed some excellent talent and strengthened the League in several ways. Today among alumni participants you will find a high proportion of the league's strongest players. You will also find a high incidence of past and present team captains, committee chairmen, and officers, including three past presidents.

Isn't it high time that such an exemplary group of CICL members be given the opportunity to share in the awards program?

#### II. Prizes

Since alumni teams do not have a home base in which to display a team trophy, prizes should consist of individual awards such as medals, certificates, lapel buttons, etc. The total expenditure for these should be scaled down from the primary awards for the top teams. The runner-up should be acknowledged at the banquet-no award.

#### III. Play-off Format

The regular match scheduled for March between Alumni Central and Alumni II should be considered the first round of a round robin tournament. If it can be arranged, the Excaliburs will play at Alumni II. If this is impossible, the last two rounds- Excaliburs vs Alumni II and Excaliburs vs Alumni Central will be played along with the league finals. The team with the best result will play white on odd boards in the third round.

The team with the most match points will be declared 1982-1983 Alumni Team Champion. The primary tie-break will be based on total game points for the three rounds. The secondary tie-break will be based on 3-round results on boards played with the black pieces. The team with the better overall results will win. Results of the matches should be transmitted to the chairmen of the North and Central Divisions.

I propose that the League eliminate the annual CICL Tornado. The purpose of the Tornado is to promote good will and to interest other teams to join the league. I feel that this event no longer accomplishes this purpose.

I suggest instead that the League promote (maybe as a joint effort with the Illinois Chess League) a different kind of event, one more in line with the what the League is all about. A team tourament similiar to the U.S. Amateur Team Championships.

The event would consist of five man teams, four boards and one alternate. A thirty dollar entry fee (roughly six dollars per man) would be charge. The prizes would consist of trophies. Several catagories are possible;

- Best Chicago area Team
- Best Industrial Team
- Best Elementary school Team
- Best High School Team
- Best Chess Club Team
- Best College Team
- Strongest showing by a CICL Team
- Best Illinois Chess League Team

The main problem with the idea is size. If the event draws 20 to 25 teams, that's 100 to 125 people. However, with that kind of showing can perhaps rent a hall. We can also require advance registration to anticipate size.

#### POSSIBLE SIZE OF THE EVENT

- CICL should enter 8 teams. Each Division would enter 1 team plus a possible 4 teams from various companies or alumni teams.
- Chess clubs should enter 5 teams.
- Schools should enter about 10 teams.

If you had last to Hale Chan instead of beating him, our streak would have been over 40 matches as that was the only match that Sears lost that season.
