
All-Star Update

Several days before the East and North divisions were to play their all-star match at the Oak Park Village Hall on February 28, East division chairman Ross Siegel was advised by North division chairman Norm Hughes that the North division would not have a sufficient number of players available to play in the scheduled match. The North division agreed to forfeit the match rather than attempt to reschedule it at this late date. The East division now awaits a result of a confrontation between the Near West and Far West divisions.

In addition to the two games sent in by Jim Brotsos and Jim Sullivan, I would like to direct attention to the explanation of possible delays in rating matches supplied by ratings chairman Charlie Ward. This report immediately precedes the league standings page. Remember, if just one team in a division is behind schedule, an entire division could be effected.


Squares d8,e8 and f5 are under attack by white's rook and two pawns. Those same squares are defended by Black's pawn on g6 and rook. Note the Black bishop does not count as a defender because it occupies one of the squares under attack. Total of three White attackers and two Black defenders.

2. P - e6

Now we have two squares, d8 and e8, under attack by two White pawns and guarded by a Black rook. Total of two White attackers and one Black defender. Black can not stop a pawn from Queening.

My uncle claimed combinations are easy, but getting to a position having a combination is the difficult thing.

[Editor's note: Marv, most experienced players would view this combination as an example of the axiom "two connected pawns on the sixth beat a Rook (usually)."]

Squares a6, h6 and g6 are under attack by White's bishop and two pawns. Those same squares are defended by Black's pawn on h7 and bishop. Total of three White attackers and two Black defenders.

2. P - h7

Now we have two squares, a8 and h8, under attack by two White pawns and guarded by a Black bishop. Total of two White attackers and one Black defender. Black can not stop a White pawn from Queening.

My uncle once told me a bishop can not defend both of its diagonal lines at the same time. He also told me a bishop on one color square can not defend against a bishop on the other color square so during a combination the defender is essentially a piece down.

Jim and I agree that it is best for Black to accept the gambit pawn with 9.... cd! True, White will have a big lead in development, but after 10. N:d4 Nd:e5 11. Nb5 Qb1, once Black kicks the White knight with a6, he develops his King's bishop to d6, forcing White to rescue his h pawn, and then develops his Queen's bishop to d7 with masked pressure on White's other Knight. These resources should enable Black to at least equalize.

10. c3 b5 11. N:c5 B:c5

12. d:c5 Nd:e5

13. Nd4 Nc4

14. b3!

White invites Black to trade his good Knight for a bishop that is not doing very much, and open the f file in the process.

14. ... N:e3

15. f:e3 Ne5



Absolutely necessary was 22.... B:f5. After 23. Q:f5 Q:c6 24. Q:e5 White's pieces are more active, but this line was still, as they say, Black's best practical chance. The move played loses immediately, if not sooner.

Editor's note: When Jim Brotsos sent this game in to me, he mentioned that his team, the Excaliburs, while down to just seven players altogether, have six players that played first board for another team at some point in time. These players are centurians Gee Leong, Ed Buerger, Jim Sullivan, Steve Karlovics, Ned Anderson and James Brotsos. He also mentioned that the exception is Hale Chan.

Well, Jim, I am sure you discussed this with your team, and perhaps Hale has forgotten that in his debut as a member of Alumni Central in the CICL East division, he played board one against Ray Dixon of the Chicago Board of Options Exchange back in September, 1986. Remember that, Hale?

Yes, Jim, you have seven current or former first board players on your team, not six.





FORFEITS

The Amoco Research Lab team has incurred its second forfeit on an upper board, and has thus forfeited the privilege of starting a clock in the absence of a player, as provided in the CICL Rules of Team Competition, Section I. Three teams have now forfeited this privilege:

In future matches this season, if any of these teams does not have all of its team members present by the end of the 15-minute grace period, the players present must shift board assignments upward, with forfeit losses recorded on the bottom board(s).

WHY WASN'T OUR MATCH RATED?

If you don't find the results of your team's match in this issue of the bulletin although you expected to, one of two things may have occurred. First, the match results sheet has to reach the Ratings Chairman. It is the responsibility of the home team captain to send the results sheet to the division chairman, who in turn must send it to the Ratings Chairman. A delay by either will slow down the rating of a match.

A second possibility results from the need to rate all matches in the order that they are played in order to preserve the accuracy of the ratings. In the absence of any other information, the Ratings Chairman assumes that matches are played in the order shown in each division's schedule. If an earlier round's result sheet has not been received, then matches in later rounds may not be able to be rated. This month, for example, there were four Round 6 and Round 7 matches in the North Division which could not be rated due to missing results for the UOF-FelPro (round 5) and Excaliburs-FelPro (round 6) matches. This emphasizes the importance of sending match results in in a timely fashion. If a team will be playing its matches out of the order shown in the schedule, this information should be transmitted to the Ratings Chairman so that it can be taken into account.
