Minutes

- 1. President Ross Siegel called the meeting to order at 7:05pm.
- 2. Secretary Tony Jasaitis read the highlights of the minutes of the April 18, 1989 meeting. No changes were noted.
- 3. Ross Siegel was re-elected President unaminously. Jim Brotsos was re-elected Treasurer unaminously.
- 4. Bill Cooper volunteered to be East Division Chairman. Dan Kumro will continue as Far West Chairman. Ross Siegel will determine whether Irwin Gaines will continue as Far West Chairman. Norm Hughes will be stepping down as North Division Chairman due to health reasons. No replacement was determined at the meeting. Jeff Moles has volunteered to be North Division chairmain.
- 5. Marty Franek volunteered to be Bulletin Editor. It was believed that Skip Kale wished to be Banquet Chairman and Playoff TD, assisted by Manuel Gamez. Ross Siegel will verify this. It was believed that Wes Underwood would continue as Trophy Chairman. Ross Siegel will verify. Marty Franek was applauded for arranging the meeting site, which was acceptable to everyone.
- 6. Treasurer Jim Brotsos presented his report, a copy of which should be in this bulletin. Jim suggested raising the dues by \$1 to \$65 due to inflation in the banquet budget. It was approved unaminously.

- 7. During his report, Jim Brotsos made the following comments, which are not in the report: Speed chess tournament results should be published in the bulletin. The CICL is paying \$15 a year dues to the Illinois Chess Association (ICA), but not getting any publicity. They also still list Bruce McNeil, who now lives out of state, as the CICL contact. The Publicity Director should be submitting reports to the Illinois Chess Bulletin (ICB) for them to publish, as well as posting publicity notices at chess tournaments about the CICL. No one volunteered to be Publicity Director. Tony Jasaitis said he would talk to Al Losoff, a CRT team member who is now ICA president, about ICB publicity.
- 8. Sears was re-admitted to the East Division unaminously. Jim Brotsos will be joining the Alumni East team and will be co-captain with Marvin Cox. Walgreens dropped out of the CICL. Jim Sullivan will be the new Excaliburs team captain. Carl Campbell will be the new Amoco Oil captain. The following players were admitted to alumni teams: Bob Charkovsky; blanket approval for all former Walgreens team members.
- 9. Charlie Ward was presented with questions about the ratings system. The following points were made:
 - a) Ratings for unrated players are not calculated iteratively/retroactively to refine them for other unrated players they may have played that have since developed ratings.
 - b) Concern was expressed by several people that CICL ratings are getting out of line with USCF ratings. Charlie Ward said he would try to figure out how much discrepancy there is between rating systems. A suggestion was made to give bonus points to the top 10 most improved players at the end of the season.
 - c) Tony Jasaitis pointed out that some players are still are unrated after having played many rated games. He pointed to an example from the last rating list, where an unrated player had played 18 total games, 10 of them against rated players. He wondered whether carryover of rated games from prior seasons was occurring for unrated players. Charlie Ward said that carryover does occur, and that he will look into this case. It is possible that this player lost all 10 of the games against rated players. Charlie said that a player must have a non-perfect record (winning or losing) against rated players in order for a meaningful rating to be computed.

10. The time contraints of Playoff Saturday (last 2 rounds) were discussed. The playoffs started at 9am, with the site requiring vacancy by 6pm. This did not allow for a reasonble lunch time and playing two rounds at 50/2 with secondary time controls. Tony Jasaitis proposed:

"To avoid last minute disputes, the league authorizes the playoff director to set reasonable time controls that fit the constraints of the playing site."

The proposal was approved 14 for, 1 against. This means that a possible time control during the playoffs may be 45/90 followed by game/30, as occurred in the last round last season at Amoco Research Center, which is likely to be the playoff site again.

11. Dave O'Dell's smoking proposal was approved: 14 for, 1 against. The League encourages people to be reasonable about the issue. However, if a dispute cannot be resolved, then the following rule will apply:

"Whether smoking is permitted at the board will be determined by the captain of the home team, providing that building rules do not supersede a decision to allow smoking."

12. "Proposal #1," tightening the rating point leeway for provisionally rated players, was discussed. The proposal, rewording Section II.B.1 of the CICL rules, was:

"Team captains will be responsible for making an honest effort to rank their players according to their current relative strength for each match. The home team captain shall present his lineup first on the match result sheet. Players shall be ranked by most recent CICL rating, with no more than a 100 point difference between any and all players ranked out of order. If a player has played less than 10 rated games, a 200 point leeway is allowed for that player. New CICL players with a USCF rating should be ranked at that rating, and it should be provided on the match result sheet for the benefit of the ratings statistician. Exceptions to the ranking rule must be agreed to by the opposing team captain."

Greg Berry objected to using USCF ratings for initial CICL ratings, especially for people who may have not played any serious chess for a decade or more. Tony Jasaitis pointed to his own case of entering the league after a 15 year layoff, and suggested the best action may be to enter as an unrated, as he did.

The proposal was accepted by a vote of 14 for, 1 against.

13. "Proposal #2," shifting responsibility of reporting match results to the home team captain, was discussed. The proposal, rewording part of Section II.B.6, was:

'The winning team's captain is responsible for submitting a legible results sheet signed by both team captains or their representatives to the division chairman within one week of the match date. He must also provide a copy of the results sheet to the other team captain. If the match is a tie, the home team captain will assume this responsibility."

Jim Brotsos felt that problems would result when the team captain was not present at the end of the match. He pointed out that an advantage of home site reporting is that the result sheet can be left behind for the home team captain to find the next day. Various people felt that division chairmen should follow up more strongly on late result submissions, rather than changing the existing rule.

The proposal was rejected by a vote of 2 for, 12 against, 1 abstain.

14. "Proposal #3," allowing for negotiable time controls, was discussed. The proposal, to replace Section II.F, was:

Time controls can be set by individual player agreement. The SLOWEST and DEFAULT time control is 50 moves in 2 hours. The FASTEST allowable time control is 60 moves in 1 hour. If the two players have different preferences, the SLOWER of the two time controls will be used. Time controls will be defined as an even number of moves on a per hour or per 2 hours basis. The secondary time control will be half of the initial one (eg, 60/1 yields 30/.5). If a clock is to be started in the absence of a player, the SLOWEST league time control will be used, unless the team captains agree otherwise."

Several players felt that something like this was already in the rules. Dan Kumro produced a copy of the rules that allowed for negotiable time controls. Tony Jasaitis said that it was not in his copy of the rules. Dan Kumro said that he has never been able to get anyone to agree to a time control other than the standard 50/2 anyway. A motion was made to adopt this proposal just be sure that it is (still) in the rules, and because this proposal is more comprehensive than the old rule anyway.

The proposal passed by a vote of 14 for, 1 against.

15. Secretary Tony Jasaitis said that he is in the process of transcribing the CICL rules to a computer so that they may be more easily updated. He requested Dan Kumro for a copy of his copy of the rules so that he can resolve any discrepancies, such as the one in #14.

16. "Proposal #4," for a tiebreaking system for trophies and league championship eligibility, instead of playoffs, was discussed. The proposal was revised during discussion as follows: (the original paragraph "a" was moved down to "c")

"Ties in the final standings for trophies (including 1st/2nd) and for league championship playoff eligibility, will be determined by the following tie-break methods, applied in the order listed:

- a) "Head-to-head" match score between the two teams during the regular season.
- b) "Head-to-head" game score between the two teams during the regular season, including forfeits.
- c) Game points, including forfeits.
- d) Sum of the match points of the opponents that the team beat, plus half of the match points of the opponents that the team tied. If the two teams played more than once in the season, "beat" and "tied" refer to the net result of the matches.
- e) Formula "d)", substituting "game points (including forfeits)" for "match points."

In the extremely remote case that any teams are still tied after all these tie-break methods, a playoff match will be played between the two teams."

The above proposal was accepted unaminously. It replaces Sections II.H.3 and II.H.4 of the CICL rules.

17. "Proposal #5," regarding player eligibilty for playoffs was discussed. Jim Brotsos objected to the exclusion of ALL "extra board" games. Tony Jasaitis resubmitted the proposal with the following wording:

"To be eligible in any form of playoff match (league championship or tie-breaking), a player must have played in at least one regular season game. Forfeit wins are acceptable, forfeit losses are not. Games as an "extra board" between members of the same team are not acceptable."

The proposal was accepted unaminously. It replaces Section II.H.4. of the CICL rules.

18. Jim Brotsos argued that players who are not present to receive forfeit wins (such as when a team captain notifies the other in advance that he cannot bring a full team) should not receive credit for a win; the game should be recorded as a double forfeit. A number of the captains felt that the practice is OK as a courtesy and convenience. Jim asked what if the "short" team shows up with the whole team after all. The discussion terminated when we recalled that the league expects sportsmanlike conduct.

19. Marty Franck's proposal for an additional playoff trophy was discussed. The proposal was:

"A third place trophy should be awarded in the league championship playoffs."

The rationale is to provide additional incentive for a team which loses in the first round of the playoffs, to play out the remainder of the playoffs. Up to this point, a team that lost the first round could no longer mathematically win a trophy.

The proposal was accepted unaminously.

- 20. The Spring Meeting will be around the middle of April, depending on availablilty of the same site.
- 21. President Ross Siegel closed the meeting at 9:15 pm.

A MESSAGE REGARDING FUTURE LEAGUE PROPOSALS

The August 1990 CICL business meeting handled a large number of proposals (some of them "heavy") very smoothly, despite the large number of people present. We feel that was partly due to the ideas having been submitted in writing in the bulletin in advance of the meeting. This gave everyone a chance to fully think through his position in advance of the meeting. It may have also improved attendance, as people wanted to have their say on important topics. No time was needed for reading the proposal aloud and letting everyone digest it; that all had already ocurred beforehand. The entire proposal processing process was streamlined.

We encourage everyone to publish their proposals in the bulletin, rather than waiting until the business meeting to introduce them. We request that proposals be submitted by March 1, 1991 for the Spring meeting.
