WELCOME TO OUR THREE ADDED TEAMS !!

At the Fall Business Meeting we were happy to meet the leaders of three teams wanting to join the CIGL. For those not present, quick introductions are in order. Two of the teams were specific results of the recent amendment to invite area clubs to participate. All represent a small fraction of the potential additions which our Publicity Chairman is in contact.

First, was the St. Charles Chess Club. All area tournament players are aware of its history and the great events sponsored by them. With such a strong base, it wasn't surprising to hear their initial roster sporting Expert-rated players. Indeed, they immediately earned a draw in their first match versus Fermilab !

A similar encouragement was received from the application of Northwestern University. Even with the heavy schedule of college students, they informed us that actually two chess groups exist in which they can draw chessplayers! Hopefully, our joint efforts will insure their health for many years to come.

The final team was from Computer Associates. Their captain, Matt Vail, was previously a player on the North Division Kemper team and took the initiative to round up players from his company instead of continuing with a former team as others have. Kudos go to his effort. It was one group that earlier publicity contacts did not secure!

CIGL SHAKE-UP !!

So where to put three new teams? Well, unfortunately, even as we gained, two other teams were not able to continue. And then both were in the same division; the Near West. The Chargers could not field a complete team, leaving those interested to move to one of the other Lucent teams. The Cook County Department of Corrections team had changes in their work hours making it impossible for them to be available evenings.

The St Charles club is furthest West of all teams, so it would be geographically tough to place them anywhere other than in the Far West. Similarly, Northwestern University so far North (and East for that matter), it was logical to place them in the North. So that would leave Associates to be placed and only two teams in the Near West. To balance the divisions, then, the Argonne Rooks amiably agreed to move into the Near West and join the Associates, Pawns, and Case.

HAS YOUR TEAM DESERTED YOU ??

Once a CIGL member, always a CIGL member. If your team has disbanded, you are still eligible to play for another team ! There are Alumni teams in each division, so you have somewhere close to join. Contact the appropriate Division Chairman (see Contact List on page two) for approval and placement.

In addition, there are non-Alumni teams struggling to survive. The President has the authority to place individual players in such a situation (see "the player pool" in the Constitution on the website). Two teams need you in the Near East and one in the downtown East. Contact him if you are so interested.

Anything chess-related is offered here: they sell books and equipment, acquire chess book collections and sets for resale, and publish their own chess titles. If you get on their mailing lists, you will receive regular news and offerings of out-of-press books. What's really impressive is that, since they are so close to Chicago, if you call in your order in the morning, chances are strong it will be on your doorstep the next day! (Although the website ordering is considerably less quick). Highly recommended.

A typical Internet venture, Chesscafe has been a favorite site for educational and general chess reading of its website content. This popularity spawned a booming new-book business and so has an incredible stock which includes foreign-language books as well. Last Spring they were able to take over the US Chess Federation sales and their selling area is now named www.USBsales.com. They are a little more pricey in both stock and shipping. Probably due to their increased base, I recently had major problems resolving a few shipping problems. They appear to be the preferred US source with the publishers.

This guy is a little sales, and a lot of chess for this southern area. The fun part is that his speciality is chess supplies and has aggressively made deals directly with the manufacturers. This results in unbelievable prices for clocks and sets. I was able to purchase brand new Excalibur digital clocks, includes 95 preset controls and time-delay, for \$29 each!! He is so sure of his contacts, he guarantees that he will match any lower price! Although my order came quickly, the couple times I've tried to call were unsuccessful. I don't know his life story, but I have ordered more clocks from him.

My name is Gordan Lesic and I'm a chess master from Bosnia and Herzegovina. I'm very happy that you issued an article about my old friend IM Osman Palos. I would also ask you if you could announce this letter in your next magazine issue.

We are trying to organize a tournament in Bosnia; however, we are lacking funds to make this happen. If you read this letter you will exactly know what I'm talking about. Thank you for your help!

Osman Palos Memorial Tournament

August seventh, in Chicago, was the six-month anniversary since the international chess master Osman Palos passed away. Two days ago, I received a letter from the Tuzla Chess Club which stated they were trying to set up a first memorial tournament in honor of the legendary Tuzla Chess player. Due to the war, the Tuzla Chess Club is in the midst of a financial crisis, therefore the Club is asking for donations from friends of chess throughout the United States.

The tournament would be held in the **month of October** in which Osman Palos was born.

I'd like to say that the legendary IM won over 150 tournaments, and he was best known for his ability to "devour" grand masters. Osman was the winner of the Arena Turist Pula tournament with 10 out of 11 points leaving behind 10 grand masters. Also placed first in Pleven (Bulgaria) in front of better ranked: Ninov, Bogdan Lalic, Kirov, and Molov. He won the tournament in Genoa (Italy) in 1989, where he in the last round had beaten the Belgrade grand master Vladimir Raicevic who was in the top of his form, I was there to witness it my self. Here in America: he was the champion of the Midwest, and the champion of Illinois, beating: Gurevic, Goldin, Ipishin, Kudrin, Judasin, etc. etc. He was known for his great coaching skills. From Vienna to Malaysia to Arabic Emirates ending up in Chicago he taught the youth spreading the chess culture throughout the world.

Bad health, over ten years of diabetes, and at the end lung cancer discontinued his capability to deliver how much he was capable to give to chess. The dreamer, the humanist, a boy-like soul he had stayed to the last moment of his life. Standing tall and honorably he had endured the last hit of his destiny. A few days before his passing he told me: "Let's see what this feels like."

In the name of the **Tuzla Chess Club** and mine we're asking for your support to organize the tournament and keep the spirits alive of the legendary Bosnian/American chess player Osman Palos. I'm hoping that the Tuzla government will have some sense and for example name one of the streets with the name of their renowned son. With that act the spirit of Osman Palos would be returned to the city to which he truly belonged.

1. **President Jim Thomson called the meeting to order at 7:03 P.M.**

2. OFFICERS REPORTS:**President:**

Jim welcomed all attendees, reviewed the agenda, and asked for the officers' reports.

Secretary:

The minutes of the spring business meeting held April 7th and reported in the Bulletin were approved as written.

Treasurer:

Several teams no longer have current employees, have several loaner players, and do not play at their company's site. These hybrid teams need some official rules on eligibility. There was not a consensus on what the rules should be at the meeting. Jim Thomson will form a task force to look at this issue and the Alumni teams. He will advertise in the August bulletin for volunteers. Discussion centered on how to keep lower rated Alumni players in the league and to prevent Alumni teams from stockpiling just high rated players. Some sort of oversight and approval was suggested.

D. Player Classification

After much discussion, Isidro Tamez was approved as an Alumni player (Alumni Aces) by a vote 4-2 with 2 abstentions.

All current CASE players were approved as Alumni players by a unanimous vote.

Loaner pool players Krsto Sitar, Tim Kras, and Mike Marsh for Leo Burnett were approved by a unanimous vote.

Loaner pool players Kaz Jakstas, Ray Fabijonas, and Marty Franek for the PAWNS were approved by a unanimous vote.

E. Rating Change Proposals

Art Olsen requested changing the rating system to rate all players using rating table 1 (under 100 rated games) and discontinuing ratings tables 2 and 3. Since this change was emailed only the day before the meeting, the attendees felt more time was needed for everyone to review this proposed change. Art agreed to email this change to all players and seek comment. It will be voted on in the spring meeting.

Art also asked that other ratings be used for initial ratings. Whether to use Internet or other non-over the board ratings was discussed. The consensus was that only over the boarding ratings should be used. Art asked that FIDE convertible ratings (there is a conversion table for foreign ratings) be used for initial ratings. This was approved by a unanimous vote. The Secretary will change the rating Sections of the Constitution to reflect this.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:50 P.M.
