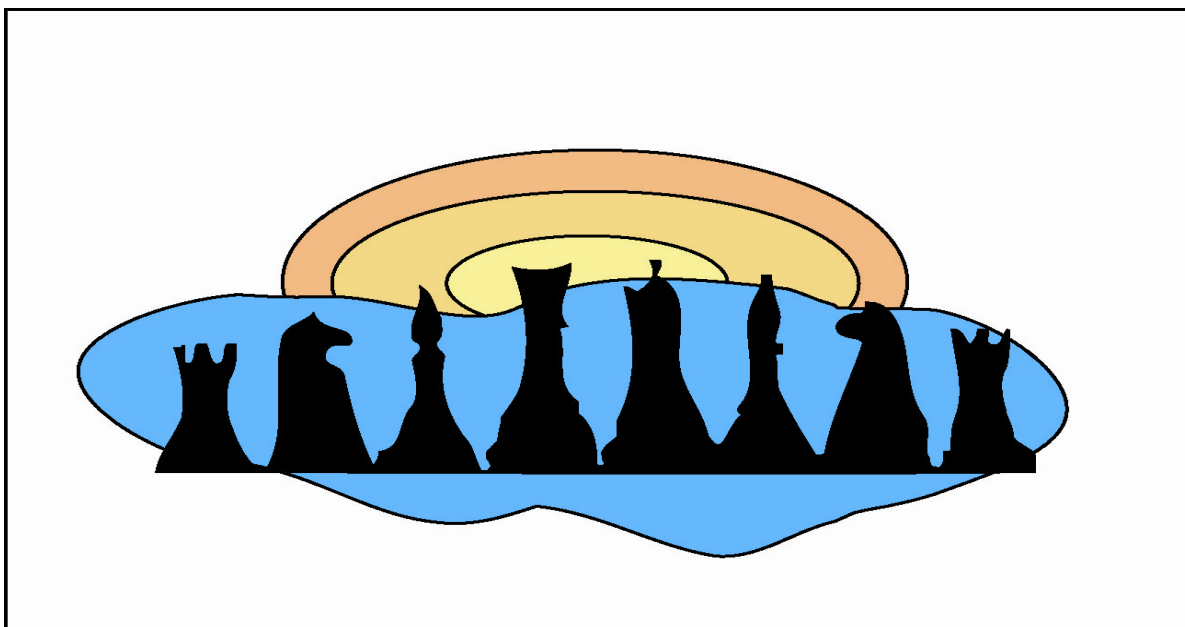

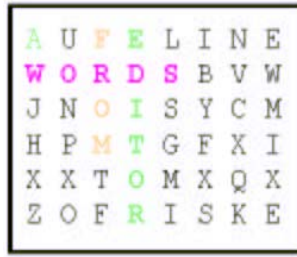

MINUTES

1. President Jim Thomson called the meeting to order at 7:15 P.M. He remarked that this was very large turnout, which he was glad to see.

2. OFFICERS REPORTS:**A. President – Jim Thomson**

B. Bulletin, Games Editor Webmaster-Tom Friske (Not Present, no report)

Jim expressed the league's thanks to Tom for his continuing excellent work on the bulletin and our web site chicagochessleague.org.

C. Publicity Chairman-Brian Smith (Not Present, Emailed report)

Brian emailed a summary of his publicity efforts (see link on Web site). Four new teams are joining: Walgreens, a 2nd team from St. Charles Chess Club (BAKER), AMA, and the Renaissance Knights Chess Club.

Brian focused on company recruiting and known new clubs or colleges. He sent 130 direct marketing mails to large chicagoland companies and 25 mails to large unions. So far, no new teams from those efforts.

Brian distributed fliers at large chess tournaments and events. He placed an article in the Jul/Aug Illinois Chess Bulletin.

Brian resigned as publicity chairman as of 8/24/2005 and will forward computer data files to the new chairman.

D. Banquet Chairman-Bert Gazmen (not present)

CASE, after the meeting, asked to be associated with UPS.

Leo Burnett, after the meeting, will probably ask to be associated with MWRD (Metropolitan Water Reclamation District).

Jay Lechnick asked that UOP become an Associated team associated with UOP and be renamed to United Oil Products.

CASE, Alumni Aces, and Leo Burnett are associated teams who are not associated with anyone.

7. NEW BUSINESS:

A. New Teams

AMA asked to join the league. They have 15-20 players and meet daily for chess in their company's cafeteria, in addition to Friday club meetings in a conference room. They have a nice playing site. Their team captain discovered the CICL by accident, after doing a Web search for area chess clubs. They were unanimously accepted into the league. They will be playing in the East division.

BAKER, a splitoff of the current St. Charles chess club team, asked to join the league. They will share the St. Charles site. They were unanimously accepted into the league. They will be playing in the Far West division.

Renaissance Knights asked to join the league. They are a chess club in Northbrook. Currently, they meet on Sunday at 3 P.M. at the Renaissance Hotel. They are looking for a weekday site in Northbrook. They have plenty of players. They were unanimously accepted into the league. They will be playing in the North division.

Following the meeting, Loyola and Walgreens asked to join the league. Walgreens would be an associated team (Associated with Walgreens) and Loyola would be a company/education team. In September after the meeting, Tony Jasaitis held an email vote on whether to accept them into the league. They were both accepted and will be playing in the North division.

B. Divisional Alignment

West Division - Bob Buchner described a combined Far West and West division with 11 teams and a schedule minimizing travel (farthest away teams do not play each other). It is the current 10 teams plus the new BAKER team. He said the team captains expressed the need for this combined division to have 4 trophies and 4 playoff slots. West – 11 teams

East – current 4 teams plus AMA and Northwest (6)

North – Motorola Kings, Motorola Knights, UOP, Northrop, Excaliburs, Renaissance Chess Club (6) with possible new team of Walgreens

C. Playoff Slot Proposal

There was not a consensus on what the rules should be at the meeting. Art Olsen, Tony Jasaitis, Bob Buchner, Jim Thomson, Jim Duffy, and Matt Vail volunteered to form a task force to look at this issue and come up with a proposal.

D. Tiebreak Proposal (see web for proposal)

This proposal was that a series of tiebreaks would be used to decide final team standings in a division. This was approved by a unanimous vote.

E. Performance Rating Proposal

After much discussion of the Game and Match performance ratings, a compromise of averaging of Game and Match performance ratings was suggested. This average was accepted with a vote of 6 For and 4 Opposed. Art Olsen agreed to calculate this average and it will be published in the bulletins.

F. Recording of Forfeits Proposal (see web for proposal)

This proposal was for every expected player's name to be written on the scoresheet even if a forfeit occurs. This was approved by a unanimous vote.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:37 P.M.

Lots of changes are happening in the CIGL this season. Have you kept up with them?

Here's a quiz to help refresh your memory. In order to mention each team, a few trivia questions are also included.

All questions refer only to the new 2005-2006 season. When the phrase "**company(etc)**" is used here, it includes all organizations affiliated with a team: companies; companies that associate teams are associated with; colleges; government agencies; and chess clubs. Answers are found on next page.

1. The CIGL has three divisions this season: East, North, and West (since the Near West and Far West Divisions combined). Which division does the team from **North-West**ern University play in? What other team name has a direction within it?
2. This is Northwestern's sophomore season in the CIGL. This is the freshman season in the CIGL for which college team? A new company(etc) team is the third government agency team now in the CIGL, along with Fermi and Argonne. Name both new teams.
3. Among the suburban teams (excluding the East Division), which teams' home playing sites are located the farthest north, south, east, and west? Hint, for four of the five correct answers, that team did not play home matches at that location last season.
4. Rule change. Twelve of the CIGL's 25 teams adhere to the rating cap of 1900. When calculating this, what is the minimum ratings that is used for the 5th and 6th (i.e. two lowest) ratings in the lineup?

 - b) Which two team names include (non-human) creature names? And a third team name is a (non-human) creature's name, if you leave off the team name's last letter.
 - c) List five first names (given names) of people, like "Robert", that are words found in team or company(etc) names.
8. USA and Chicago
 - a) Although we have no "States", name three teams or companies(etc) that have "United" or "America" included within their complete names.
Which three companies(etc) or team's full name include "Chicago" within them?

Answers to 'New CIGL Season Quiz'

1. Northwestern University is playing their home matches at their downtown Chicago campus this season, in the East Division. And Northrup.
2. Loyola Univ. is the CIGL's new college team. MWRD (whose initials stand for Metropolitan Water Reclamation District) is a company that has been associated with by team Leo Burnett. MWRD is a government agency, created in 1889.
3. Again, Loyola for east. North: Walgreens (a new team); south: Pawns (who changed their home site); and west: STCCC and Baker (a new team split from St. Charles Chess Club who plays at the same site as STCCC).
4. 1400 and 1600
5. Associates
 - a) Hedgehogs (who were called Getco last season) associated with Harrison Trading, a new associate company.
 - b) Walgreens associated with Walgreens, a new associate team and new associate company. (Computer Associates also associated with itself.)
 - c) The Pawns associated with Grace Davison, where they formerly played their home matches.
 - d) Case associated with UPS, a new associate company.
6. Associates, part two.
 - a) Excaliburs associated with the Law Offices of David L. Lee, a new associate company.
 - b) Alumni Aces associated with "no company"
 - c) UOP associated with UOP. (Many players from the disbanded Kemper team are playing for UOP as alumni players.)
 - d) Leo Burnett associated with MWRD, a new associate company.
7. Pieces, Creatures and People
 - a) New chess club team, the Renaissance Knights Community Chess Club, might have been hard to recall. Returning teams include the Pawns, Motorola Knights, Argonne Rooks, and Motorola Kings. Citadel is a synonym for castle. Tyro, as in Lucent Tyros, means 'squire' in Medieval Latin and 'beginner' in English.

8. USA and Chicago
 - a) United Oil Products (UOP); United Parcel Service (UPS), a new associate company, and American Medical Association (AMA), a new company team.
 - b) BP Chicagoland is BP's official team name. MWRD's full name is Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago. And Loyola is properly referred to as Loyola University Chicago.
